Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40 " wide.


## Pattern Notes

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40 " wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

fifteen 9-1/2 x 11 " rectangles, centering on images from the fabric
From Fabric B, cut:
fifteen of Template 1, noting the orientation of the print in the sample quilt


## From Fabric C, cut:

four 6-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- thirty 5-3/8" $\times 6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
- Cut half along one diagonal to form two triangles each. Cut the remaining fifteen along the opposite diagonal, to form two triangles each. Yield a total of thirty triangles.


From Fabric D, cut:
six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

- two 5-1/2" x 73-1/2" side inner borders
- two 5-1/2" x 45-1/2" top/bottom inner borders


## From Fabric E , cut:

seven $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew three together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

- two 5-1/2" x 55-1/2" top/bottom inner borders
- Sew the remaining strips together in pairs, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
+ two 5-1/2" $\times 83-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders
From the binding fabric, cut:
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips


## Assemble the Blocks

Lay out a Fabric B piece and two of each Fabric C triangle orientation. Sew the long side of a Fabric $C$ triangle to each side of a Fabric $B$ piece. Press toward the triangle. Repeat for all sides of the Fabric B piece. Repeat to make fifteen Blocks. Trim to 9-1/2" x 11 " if needed, centering the diamond and leaving 1/4" seam allowance beyond each point.


## Assemble the Quilt Center



Arrange the Fabric A rectangles and the pieced blocks in six rows of five blocks each, alternating blocks as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams together. Press the row seams open.

## Add the Borders

Sew the $45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Sew the $73-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Sew the $55-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Sew the $83-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is now complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
