## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From each of Fabrics A, B and F, cut:**

one 6" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
three 6" squares

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

one 6" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
four 6" squares

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

one 6" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
six 6" squares

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

one 6" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
five 6" squares

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

one 6" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
six 6" squares

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to make:  
two 4-1/2" x 52" top/bottom outer borders  
two 4-1/2" x 70" side outer borders

### **From Fabric H, cut:**

twenty-four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
sixty 2" x 6" side block borders  
sixty 2" x 9" top/bottom block borders

### **From Fabric I, cut:**

eighteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty-four 2" x 9" block sashing strips  
Sew the remaining twelve strips together, end-to-end, then trim to make:  
seven 2" x 49" row sashing strips  
two 2" x 62" side sashing strips

### **From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Blocks

**Step 1:** Sew a 2" x 6" Fabric H strip to the left and right edges of a Fabric A square. Press toward the strips. Sew a 2" x 9" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom edges of a the block. Press toward the strips. The resulting block should measure 9" square.

**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 with all Fabric A-G squares, for a total of thirty 9" blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 3:** Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, in rows of five blocks. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make six block rows.

**Step 4:** Sew the Fabric I row sashing strips and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

**Step 5:** Sew the Fabric I side sashing strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 6:** Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center, noting the orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center, again noting the orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press toward the borders.



Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
