## Supplies Needed

2/3 yards ACY-14528-7  
1/4 yard ACY-14526-2  
3/4 yards Kona Lipstick  
6" piece of ribbon  
24" x 24" batting (or 2 pieces 12" x 22")

## Pattern Level: Confident Beginner


## Notes Before You Begin

- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!
- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.

## Printing the Pattern

- Print out pattern pieces on pages 5-8 at 100% and tape together so that the gray triangles match up to form a square.
- Cut paper pattern out along gray seam allowance line and you are ready to cut your fabric pieces.

Tip: Before cutting your fabrics, measure the 1" square on your paper pattern to make sure you printed your pieces the correct size.



## Cutting Instructions

### ACY-14528-7

- With fabric folded, trace the stocking pattern and cut two **Exterior Stocking** pieces.

### ACY-14526-2

- Cut 1 strip 4-1/4" x 34" for the **Cuff** of the stocking, then subcut into 2 rectangles 4-1/2" x 17".

### Kona Lipstick

- Cut 1 strip 2" x 17" for the **Trim** of the cuff.

- With fabric folded, trace the stocking pattern and cut two **Lining** pieces.

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## Sewing Instructions

### Sew the Lining and Exterior Stocking

1. With right sides together, sew the 2 Lining pieces together from front top corner to back top corner with a 5/8" seam, leaving the top open. Do not flip or press, as it's not necessary. Set aside.
2. Place each piece of the Exterior Stocking onto a piece of batting and baste with spray or pins. Quilt each piece as desired (without backing), then trim the batting to fit the stocking.
3. With right sides together, sew the two quilted Exterior Stocking pieces together with 1/2" seam. Trim seams to a generous 1/4" and clip curves so the seams lay flat. Flip and press. Set aside.

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### Make the Cuff

1. Sew the cuff pieces to the long sides of the trim piece as shown.

2. Fold the trim piece in half along the long side and press.

3. Open up the piece you just pressed. Sew the entire strip into a circle with a generous 1/4" seam, matching where the folds and seams are. Now fold it back in half with the right sides out.

## Assemble Stocking

1. Place the wrong side out Stocking Lining inside the right side out Stocking Exterior. Smooth out and line up seams around the top opening.
2. Place your cuff inside the lining and pin all of the pieces together so that the raw edges are aligned and the seam of the cuff is in the back of the stocking.
3. Now place the 6" piece of ribbon, folded in half (into a loop), in between the cuff and the lining with the raw edges also sticking out at the back of the stocking.
4. Sew 1/2" seam around the raw edges of the stocking, making sure to sew through all layers. Flip the cuff to the outside and press.

Hang it on your mantle and wait for Santa,  
because this is a big stocking that will hold lots of goodies!

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## Alternate Colorways

### Patchwork A Variation

#### Supplies Needed

1 Yard ACY-14528-3  
3/8 Yard ACY-14526-7  
3/8 yard Kona White  
1/8 yard Kona Lipstick  
6" piece of ribbon  
24" x 24" batting (or 2 pieces 12" x 22")

#### Cutting Instructions:

##### ACY-14526-7

-Cut 4 strips 3" x WOF and then subcut into 8 strips 3" x 19".

##### Kona White

-Cut 5 strips 2-1/2" x WOF and then subcut into 10 strips 2-1/2" x 19".

1. Lay out the fabrics and sew them together in two groups, both of which are like this:  
A-B-A-B-A-B-A-B-A
2. Press seams open on both pieces and line them up with wrong sides together. Pin them with the seams matching up exactly before you lay the pattern of the stocking onto them and cut it out.

## Patchwork B Variation

### Supplies Needed

1 Yard ACY-14528-3  
3/8 Yard ACY-14526-7  
3/8 yard Kona White  
1/8 yard Kona Lipstick  
6" piece of ribbon  
24" x 24" batting (or 2 pieces 12" x 22")

### Cutting Instructions:

#### ACY-14526-7

Cut 3 strips 3" x WOF and then subcut into 6 strips 3" x 19".

#### Kona White

Cut 6 strips 2-1/2" x WOF and then subcut into 12 strips 2-1/2" x 19".

#### Kona Lipstick

Cut 1 strip 1" x WOF and then subcut into 2 strips 1" x 19".

1. Lay out the fabrics and sew them together in two groups, both of which are like this:  
A-B-A-C-A-B-A-C-A-B-A.
2. Press seams open on both pieces and line them up with wrong sides together. Pin them with the seams matching up exactly before you lay the pattern of the stocking onto them and cut it out.

## Stocking 'Stache


Template 1 of 4
