

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

fifteen 4-3/4" squares, cut on point, for the A Blocks

From Fabric B, cut:

fifteen 4-3/4" squares, cut on point, for the B Blocks

From Fabric C, cut:

five 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-eight 4-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, creating four triangles each. Discard two triangles. Set aside the remaining one hundred fifty for the A Blocks.

From Fabric D, cut:

five 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-eight 4-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, creating four triangles each. Discard two triangles. Set aside the remaining one hundred fifty for the B Blocks.

From Fabric E, cut:

nine 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-five 4-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, creating four triangles each. Set aside for the A and B Blocks.

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3-1/2" x 51-1/2" top and bottom outer borders

two 3-1/2" x 68" side outer borders

thirteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2" x 9-1/2" block sashing strips

Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

five 2" x 51-1/2" row sashing strips

From Fabric F, cut:

six 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:


sixty 3-7/8" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal, creating two triangles each. Set aside for the A and B Blocks.

From Binding Fabric, cut:


seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

Assemble the A Blocks


Step 1: Pair one Fabric C and E triangle right sides together along the longest edge. Sew together, then press the seam to the darker fabric. Repeat to make one hundred-twenty C/E half-square triangles (HSTs).



Step 2: Sew two C/E HSTs together as shown. Repeat to make thirty pairs in this orientation. Press the seam toward the darker fabric.




Step 3: Sew two C/E HSTs together as shown, noting the difference between this pair and the pair made in Step 2. Repeat to make thirty pairs in this orientation. Press the seam toward the darker fabric.



Step 4: Sew one Step 2 unit to the upper right and lower left edges of a Fabric A square, as shown. Press toward the center square.



Step 5: Sew one Fabric C triangle and one Fabric E triangle to opposite ends of a completed Step 3 unit, as shown, noting the fabric placement and orientation. Press toward the triangles. Repeat to make thirty units like this.



Step 6: Sew one completed Step 5 unit to each of the remaining edges of the center square. Press the seams toward the center square.




Step 7: Sew one Fabric F triangle to each of the four corners of the block. Press the seams toward the corner triangles. Trim to 9-1/2" square.




Repeat Steps 1-7 to create a total of fifteen 9-1/2" square A Blocks.

Assemble the B Blocks


Step 8: Pair one Fabric D and E triangle right sides together along the longest edge. Sew together, then press the seam to the darker fabric. Repeat to make one hundred-twenty D/E half-square triangles (HSTs).



Step 9: Sew two D/E HSTs together as shown. Repeat to make thirty pairs in this orientation. Press the seam toward the darker fabric.




Step 10: Sew two D/E HSTs together as shown, noting the difference between this pair and the pair made in Step 9. Repeat to make thirty pairs in this orientation. Press the seam toward the darker fabric.



Step 11: Sew one Step 9 unit to the upper right and lower left edges of a Fabric B square, as shown. Press toward the center square.



Step 12: Sew one Fabric D triangle and one Fabric E triangle to opposite ends of a completed Step 10 unit, as shown, noting the fabric placement and orientation. Press toward the triangles. Repeat to make thirty units like this.




Step 13: Sew one completed Step 12 unit to each of the remaining edges of the center square. Press the seams toward the center square.



Step 14: Sew one Fabric F triangle to each of the four corners of the block. Press the seams toward the corner triangles. Trim to 9-1/2" square.

Repeat Steps 8-14 to create a total of fifteen 9-1/2" square B Blocks.

Assemble the Quilt




Step 15: Arrange the A and B Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using Fabric E block sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make six block rows.

Step 16: Sew the row sashing strips and block rows together, using Fabric E row sashing strips between each row. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 17: Sew the Fabric E top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric E side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
