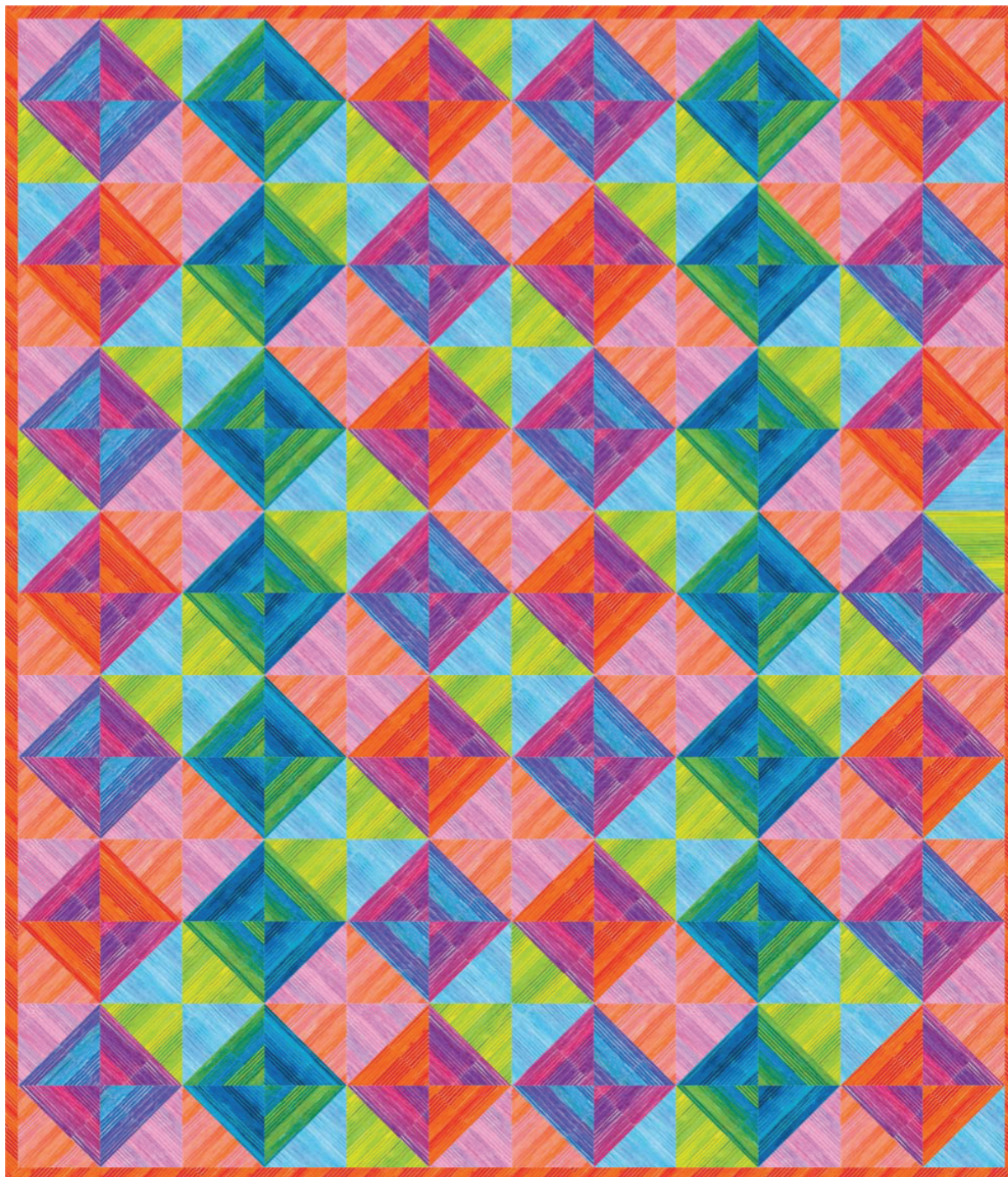








Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From **Fabric A**, cut:

- Three 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut twelve 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of forty-seven triangles.

From **Fabric B**, cut:

- Three 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut eleven 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of forty-three triangles.

From **Fabric C**, cut:

- Three 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut ten 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of thirty-seven triangles.

From **Fabric D**, cut:

- Three 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut eleven 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of forty-one triangles.

From **Fabric E**, cut:

- Two 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut seven 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of twenty-eight triangles.
- Nine 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.

From **Fabric F**, cut:

- Four 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut fourteen 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of fifty-six triangles.

From **Fabric G**, cut:

- Two 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut seven 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of twenty-eight triangles.

From **Fabric H**, cut:

- Two 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut seven 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of twenty-eight triangles.

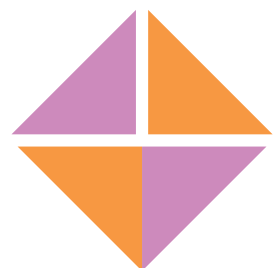
From **Fabric I**, cut:

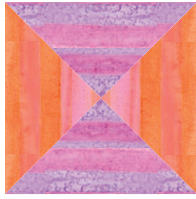
- Two 10-1/4" WOF strips. Subcut seven 10-1/4" squares.
 - Cut each square on both diagonals, creating four triangles. Cut a total of twenty-eight triangles.

Create the Blocks

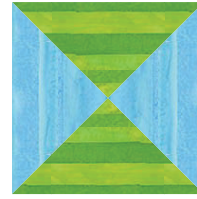
Tip: A variety of fabric combinations are used in this quilt. Organize your fabrics for sewing by stacking the appropriate number of each color in labeled block piles first, then sew.

To create the block, sew two triangles together along a short side. Press to the darker fabric. Repeat, then sew the two half-triangles together. Press the seam open.

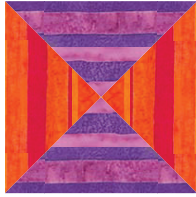




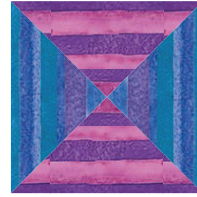
Fabric A/B - make fifteen blocks



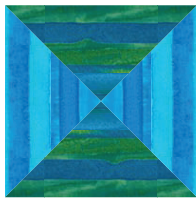
Fabric C/D - make fifteen blocks



Fabric E/F - make fourteen blocks



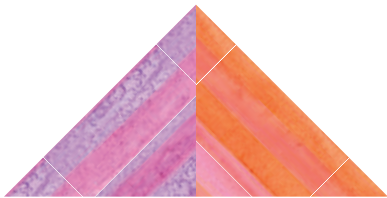
Fabric F/I - make fourteen blocks



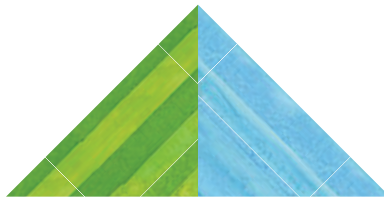
Fabric G/H - make fourteen blocks

Create the Setting Triangles

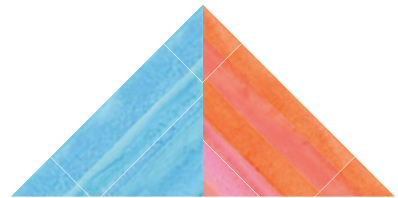
Sew two triangles together along one short side to create setting triangles. Create the following quantities:



Fabric A/B -
make twelve



Fabric C/D -
make seven



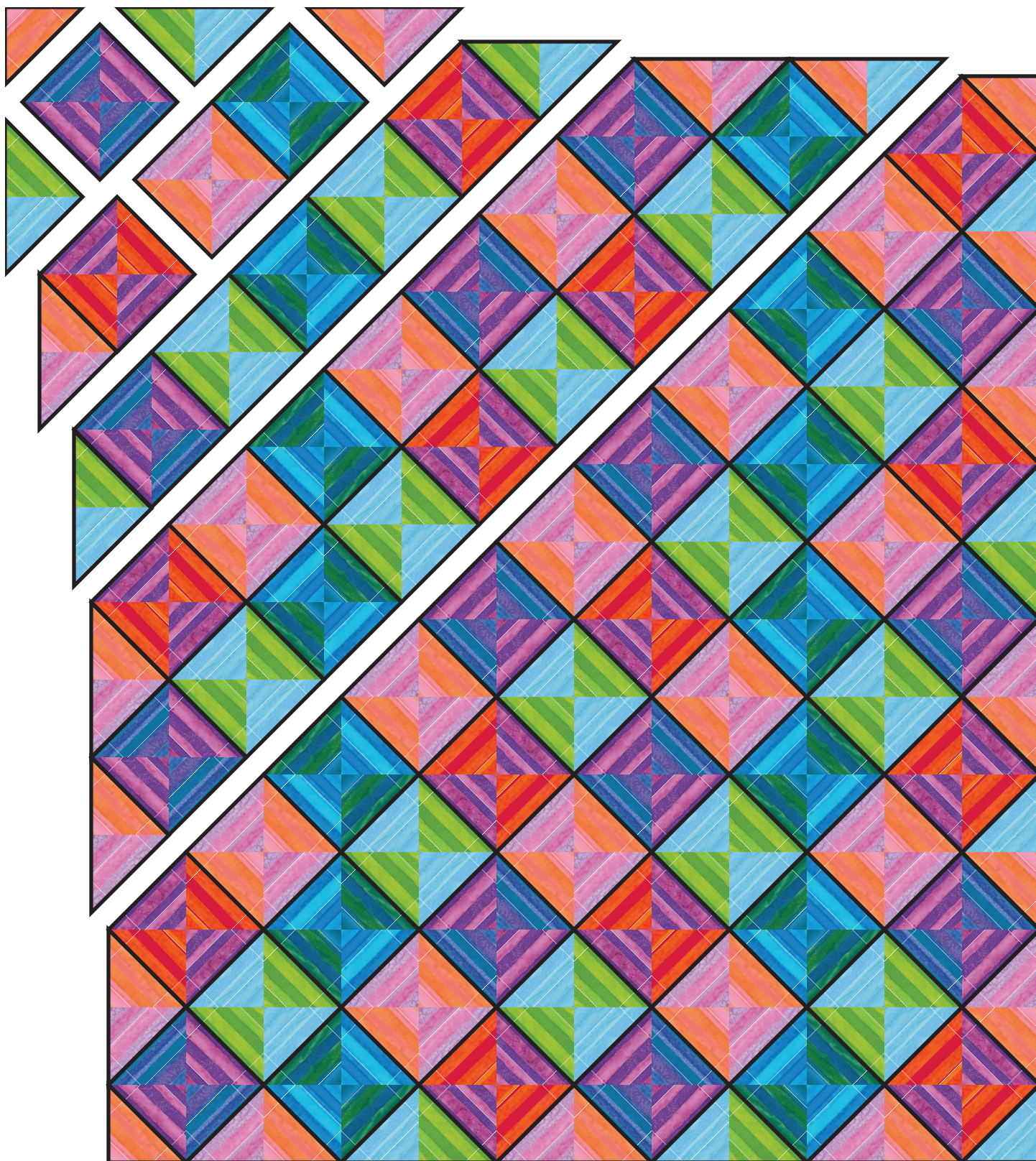
Fabric A/D -
make three

Assemble the Quilt

Assemble the quilt in diagonal rows. Alternate pressing block seams to the left and right for every other row so that row seams will nest.

Sew rows together, pressing seams open.

Sew one of the remaining triangles to each of the four corners.



Quilt Assembly Diagram










Your quilt is now complete. Baste, bind, quilt and enjoy!
