## Ten Square Friendly!

## Supplies Needed

-1 Kona Ten Squares Summer ' 13 palette (TEN-141-42)
$-5 / 8$ yard fabric or 1 fat quarter for backing

1/4 yard fabric for binding $-15^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$ piece of batting

Pattern Level: Experienced Intermediate

Finished quilt measures $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$

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## Before You Begin

-Print 4 copies of the templates (found below) at $100 \%$, add $1 / 4$ " seam allowance and cut out. There are 2 templates per page ( $\mathrm{A} \& B$ ), so you will have 8 templates. You can use a lightweight paper such as newsprint, tracing paper, or use regular printer paper (it will just be a little more effort to tear the papers off).

- Remember to measure twice, cut once!


## Tips For Paper-piecing

- Place your fabric on the unprinted side of the template and sew on the printed side.
- You can transfer lines to the opposite side of the paper with a tracing wheel, or by folding and creasing your paper.
- Use a short stitch length (about a 1.5).
- Backstitch in the seam allowance at the beginning and ending of each seam.
- Trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ " after each seam and press flat with a dry iron. This will keep your seams crisp and your quilt flat.


## Cutting Instructions

From the Ten Squares pack, choose 2 squares for the background and 2 squares for the center of the star. Select 10 squares for the star strips and separate them into 2 groups of 5 squares each.

## -From the two background squares:

Cut 4 squares 5 " $\times 5$ " from each fabric, then cut the 5 " squares diagonally to make triangles.

## -From the two center star squares:

Cut 2 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ from each fabric, then cut into rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ ".

## -From the 10 star strip squares:

Cut 4 strips 1 " $\times 10$ " from each fabic, then cut each strip in half so they measure 1 " $\times 5$ ".

## Piecing Instructions

## Step 1: Paper Piece Templates

-Piece template A in numerical order, beginning in the middle and working your way out.
-Trim excess fabric, making sure to leave a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance around the template. -Repeat to create 8 paper pieced sections ( 4 template A and 4 template B).

Step 2: Assemble Quilt


Sew A to B, matching seams, and press seam allowance open. Remove papers.

Repeat to make 4 blocks.

Sew blocks together as pictured.
Press seams open.


Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy your quilt!


Print 4 copies
Stitch in numerical order
Be sure to add 1/4" seam allowance before cutting
