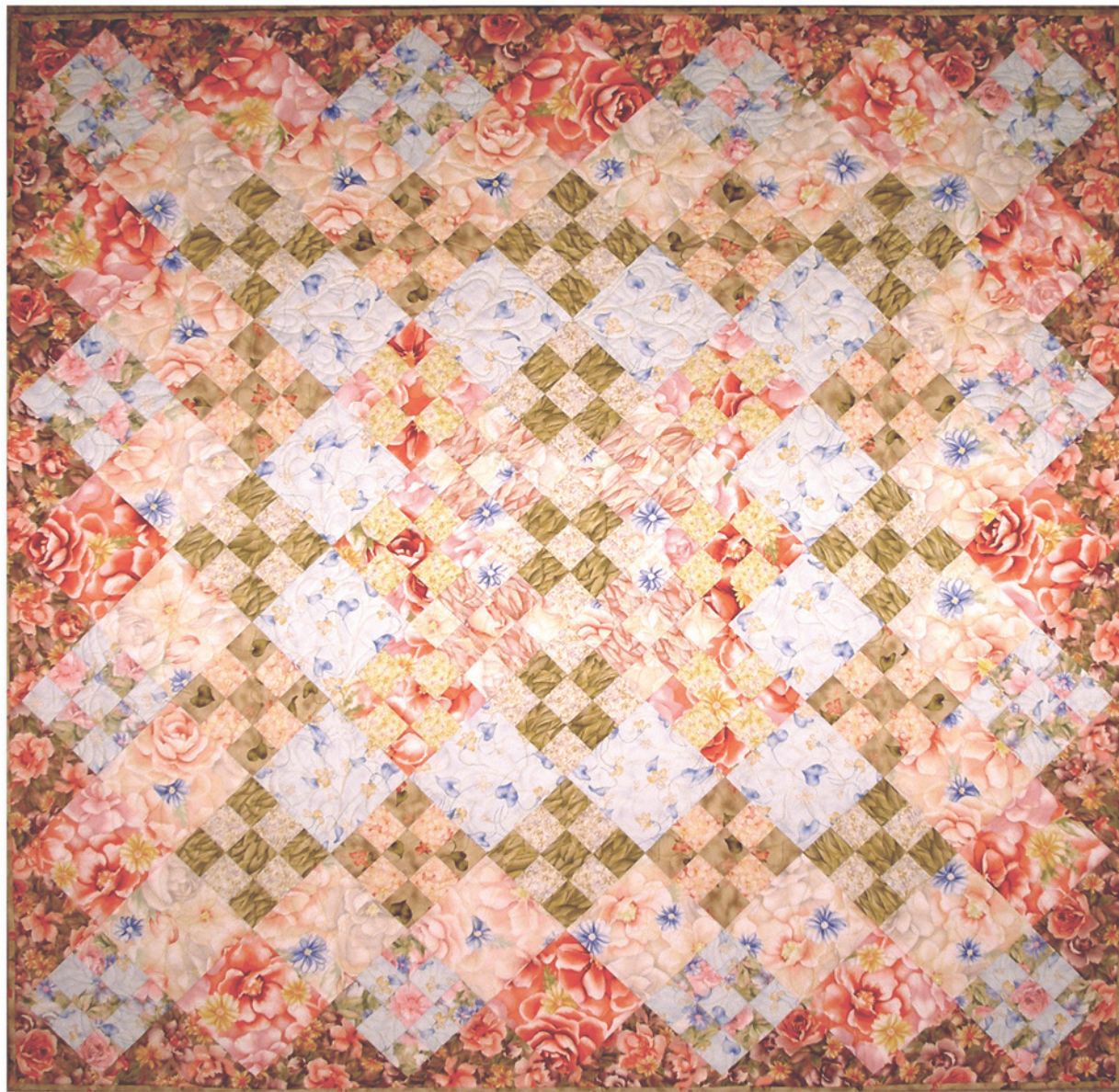

FABRIC #	YARDAGE	CUTTING
5755-3	5/8	Three 2" strips and two 5" strips. Cut the 5" strips into 5" squares.
5755-144	3/4	Three 2" strips and three 5" strips. Cut the 5" strips into 5" squares.
5756-10	1/4	Three 2" strips
5756-144	1/2	Two 8-1/2" strips. Cut the strips into six 8-1/2" squares. Cut the squares into quarters diagonally (side triangles). Also cut two 7" squares. Cut these in half diagonally for the corners.
5757-5	5/8	Three 2" strips and two 5" strips. Cut the 5" strips into 5" squares.
5757-144	1/4	Three 2" strips
5758-144	1/4	Three 2" strips
5759-5	1/4	Three 2" strips
5759-15	1/4	Three 2" strips
5760-49	1/4	Three 2" strips
5760-144	1/4	Three 2" strips
5758-144	3	Backing
5757-144	3/8	Binding: Five 2-1/4" strips

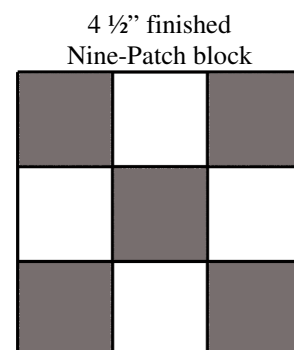
CONSTRUCTION

Following are the five fabric combinations for the nine-patch blocks. [diagram #1]

Combination:	# of blocks needed:
#1 5756-10 and 5757-5	12 – 6 with light corners & 6 with dark corners
#2 5759-15 and 5760-49	11 – 3 with light corners & 8 with dark corners
#3 5757-144 and 5758-144	8 – all with dark corners
#4 5755-3 and 5759-5	6 – all with dark corners
#5 5755-144 and 5760-144	4 – all with light corners

Alternate Blocks

#6	5755-3
#7	5757-5
#8	5755-144



1. For each nine-patch combination, join the six 2" strips together to make two strips sets, as shown.
[diagram #2]
2. Cut the sets apart every 2", to make units.
[diagram #3]
3. Sew the units together to make the nine-patch blocks. Refer to the chart above to determine the number of blocks required with light and dark corners before assembling the units.
[diagram #4]

ASSEMBLY

1. Layout all of the nine-patch, alternate blocks and setting triangles, referring to the diagram for the exact placement.
[diagram #5]
2. Sew the blocks together with the setting triangles in diagonal rows.
3. Join the rows together to complete the quilt top.
4. Trim and straighten the edges, if necessary.
5. Layer, baste, quilt and bind to complete the quilt.
