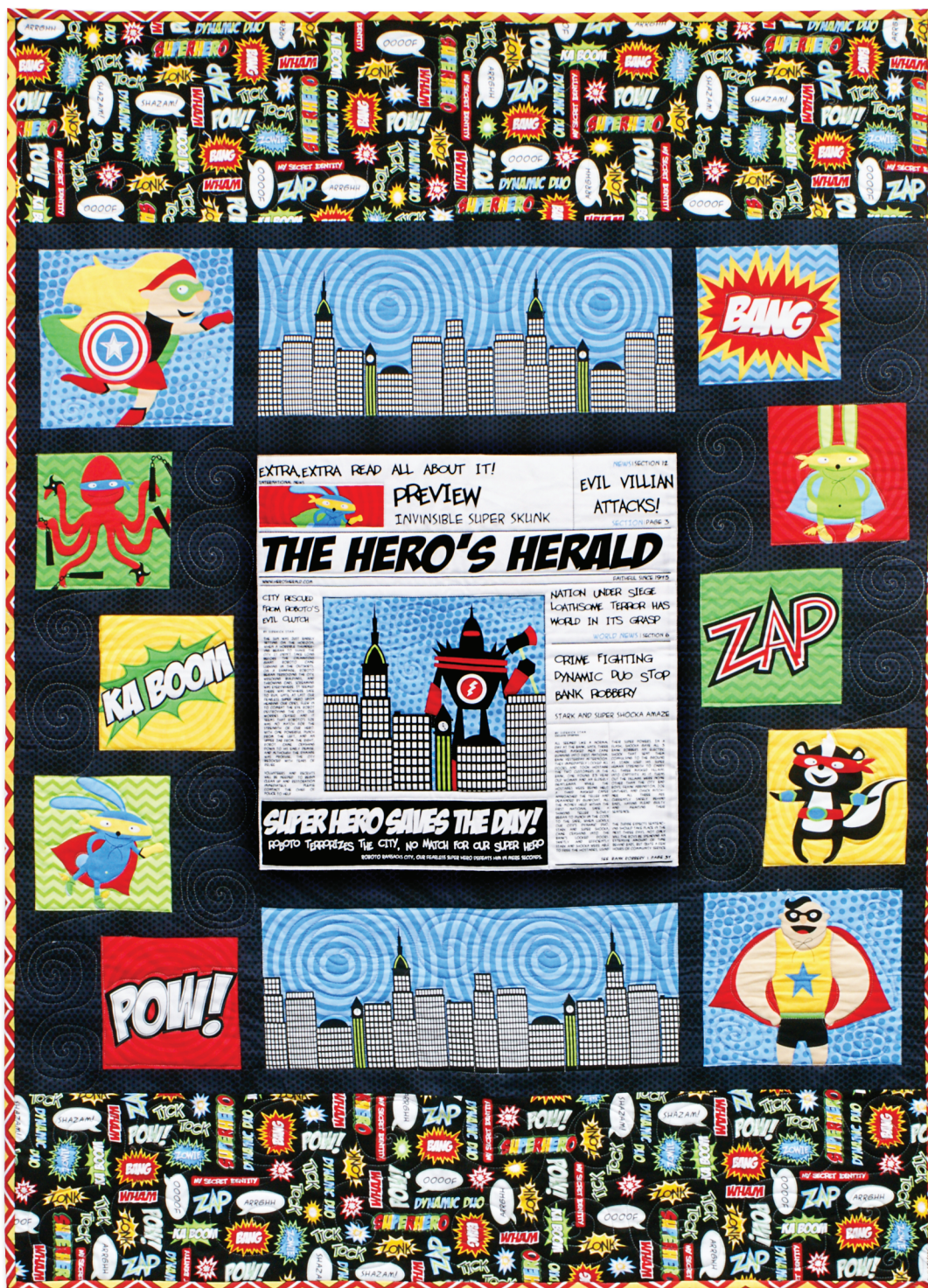

35" x 48" baby quilt

## Fabric Requirements (combined, to make all projects)

	Panel Print (quilt blocks, soft blocks, placemat, softies, pillow covers, bumpers)*	AIB-13230-267	2/3yd (1 panel)
	Word Bursts	AIB-13231-267	1/2yd
	Black tonal dot	AIB-13232-2	2/3yd
	Red/yellow zig zag	AIB-13234-101	1/2yd
	Quilt backing	your choice	1-1/2yds

## Superhero Quilt

### Cutting & Sewing Instructions

From the Panel print, cut the following:

- (1) News panel (cut it to 16" square)
- (2) superheroes (the boy and the girl, cut to 7-5/8" x 7" squares)
- (1) each of the 4 sidekicks (cut to 5-1/2" square)
- (4) word bursts (cut to 5-1/2" square)

From the leftover cityscape:  
(when you made the bumper)

cut (2) pieces of cityscape to be 16" long x 6-1/2"

Following the illustration, cut (8) 2-5/8" x 5-1/2" Black Dot rectangles, and sew to the right side of the odd numbered blocks, and to the left side of the even numbered blocks.

Cut (8) 7-5/8" x 1-1/2" strips from the black dot, and sew to the tops of blocks 1-4, and the bottoms of blocks 5-8.

Sew blocks 1-4 into a column, repeat with blocks 5-8. Trim the excess of the length of each black dot strip.

Sew a superhero to the top of the blocks you'll use for the left side of the quilt top, and to the bottom of the blocks for the right side of the quilt top.

Cut (4) strips of Black dot 1-1/2" x WOF, and sew one onto each side of the character columns, to make each column 9-5/8" wide.

For the center column of the quilt, cut a 2" strip from the remaining black dot, then subcut into (2) pieces 16" wide, and sew to the top and bottom of the News block.

Sew the Cityscape pieces above and below the 2" strips, trim the center column to measure 31" x 16".

Sew the character column with blocks 1-4 to the left of the center column, and the character column with blocks 5-8 on the right.

---

Cut (2) more 1-1/2" strips from the black tonal dot, and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Trim the excess of the length of each black dot strip.

---

Cut (2) pieces from the word burst print at 8" x WOF (or the width of your top) and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Trim as needed.

---

From the Red/Yellow zig-zag: Cut (5) strips 2-1/2" x WOF for binding.

---

Press. Quilt, bind, and enjoy!
