
#### Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


#### Printing the Templates

**Triangle Arch Templates:** Print four copies each of pages 7-9 at 100%. Cut out along gray seam allowance lines. Do NOT tape together.

Inner and Outer Background Templates: Print one copy each of pages 10-27 at 100%. Trim along the red lines and then tape together, matching letters and circles. You will have two large templates that look like the illustrations below. Cut the templates out along the gray seam allowance lines.

**Triangle Blocks**: If you choose to paper-piece the triangle blocks, print twenty-eight copies of page 28 (Triangle Block Paper-Piecing Template) at 100%. Cut templates out along gray seam allowance lines.

Alternately, you may free piece the blocks by printing one copy of page 29 (Triangle Template) and one copy of page 28. Use the Triangle Template to cut the triangles and then use the Triangle Block Paper Piecing Template as a guide to trim the finished blocks (see page 5 for a photo).

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### Fabric A

- Cut five strips 5" x WOF, then subcut thirty-six squares 5" x 5" (Triangle Arch).
- Cut four strips 6" x WOF, then subcut fifty-six rectangles 3" x 6".
  - Cut the rectangles diagonally to make triangles. (Background for Triangle Blocks).

#### Fabric B

- Cut four pieces using the Inner Background Template.
- Cut four pieces using the Outer Background Template.
- Cut eight strips 4" x WOF (Outer solid border).


Fabric C-gg (Choose a mix of these fabrics for your quilt. Some will be used twice.)

- Cut thirty-two rectangles 4" x 5" (Triangle Arch)
- Cut fifty-six pieces using the Triangle Template (Triangle Block) OR, if paper-piecing, Cut fifty-six squares 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".

### **Assembly Instructions**

### Paper-piece the Triangle Arch Templates

- 1. Paper-piece Triangle Arch Template 1,2 and 3 using the Fabric C-gg 4" x 5" rectangles and the Fabric A 5" x 5" squares.
- 2. Sew the templates together, as pictured. Press seams open and remove papers.
- 3. Repeat Step 1 with the remaining Triangle Arch Templates, to create four Triangle Arch units.



#### Assemble the Quilt Center


- Sew an Inner Background to a Triangle Arch, easing the curve. Press the seams toward the background.
- Sew an Outer Background to the Triangle Arch, easing the curve. Press the seams toward the background.
- 3. Repeat with the remaining background and Arch units to make four blocks.

4. Sew the four blocks together, as pictured, and set aside.



Quilt Center

#### Piece the Triangle Blocks

on the top/bottom border strips.

#### Option #1

1. Paper-piece fifty-six Triangle Blocks using the Fabric C-gg 4-1/2" squares and the Fabric A triangles. Trim to seam allowance lines and remove papers.

or

#### Option #2

1. Piece a Fabric A triangle to a Fabric C-gg triangle, as pictured. Press seams toward Fabric A and repeat on the other side. Trim to 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" square, using your ruler as a guide.







Tip: For quick and accurate trimming, use the Triangle Block Paper-piecing Template as a guide to place tape on your ruler.



2. Sew the Triangle Blocks together into border strips. The Top and Bottom Borders will have fifteen triangles each and the Side Borders will have thirteen triangles each.




Top/ Bottom Triangle Border: Make 2





#### Attach the Quilt Borders


- 1. Measure the length of a Side Triangle Border and true up the Quilt Center to match (the border should measure about 52-1/2").
- 2. Sew the Side Borders to the Quilt Center and then sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the Quilt Center.
- 3. Sew two Fabric B 4" x WOF short ends together. Repeat to make four fabric B Border strips.
- 4. Sew a Fabric B Border strip to each side of the quilt and trim excess fabric. Sew a Fabric B Border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt and trim excess fabric.





