Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 18-1/2" center square four 9-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, fussy cut:

eight 9-1/2" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" side inner borders two 4-1/2" x 26-1/2" top/bottom inner borders nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding twenty-four from Template 2 twenty-four from Template 3

From Fabric D, cut:

twelve 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut four to yield: two 4-1/2" x 26-1/2" side middle borders two 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" top/bottom middle borders Sew the remaining eight together, end-to-end, in pairs to yield: two 4-1/2" x 74-1/2" side outer borders two 4-1/2" x 82-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From Fabric E, cut:

twenty-four from Template 1

From Fabric F, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield: two 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" side borders two 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" top/bottom borders

From Fabric G, cut:

one 9-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 9-1/2" squares

From Fabric H, cut:


four 7-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 7-3/4" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric I, cut:

one 9-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 9-1/2" squares


Assemble the Pieced Border

Step 1: Sew one Fabric C/Template 2 and one Fabric C/Template 3 triangle to adjacent short sides of a Fabric E/Template 1 triangle. Press toward the outer triangles.



Step 2: Repeat with all remaining Fabric C and E triangles.

Step 3: Sew six completed flying geese units together, as illustrated. Press toward the top point of each flying geese unit. Repeat to make four pieced borders.



Assemble the Quilt Center



Step 4: Sew the Fabric C side inner borders to the sides of the 18-1/2" Fabric A center block. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric C top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 5: Sew the 26-1/2" Fabric D middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 34-1/2" Fabric D top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 6: Sew a 9-1/2" Fabric A square to each end of a pieced border, completed in Step 3. Note the border orientation in the diagram. Press toward the squares. Repeat with a second pieced border, noting the direction of the pieced border.




Step 7: Sew a pieced border to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Note the border orientation in the diagram. Press toward the quilt center.

Step 8: Sew an assembled border from Step 6 to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Note the border orientation in the diagram. Press toward the quilt center.

Step 9: Sew the 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" Fabric F borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" Fabric D borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Gather four Fabric H squares, two Fabric B squares, and one Fabric I square. Sew together as illustrated. Press the seams toward the Fabric H squares. This is the top pieced border. Repeat to form the bottom border.









Step 12: Sew a 9-1/2" Fabric G square to each end of the top outer pieced border, completed in Step 10. Note the border orientation in the diagram. Press toward the squares. Repeat with the bottom outer pieced border.

Step 13: Sew the Step 11 outer pieced border to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Note the border orientation in the diagram. Press toward the quilt center.

Step 14: Sew a border from Step 12 to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Note the border orientation in the diagram. Press toward the quilt center.

Step 15: Sew the 74-1/2" Fabric D outer borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Sew the 82-1/2" Fabric D outer borders to the quilt. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, and bind to complete!
