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- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4 unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Square-In-a-Square has been abbreviated to SIAS.
- Half-square triangle has been abbreviated to HST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

eight 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for the outer borders. one 3-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 3-3/8" squares for the SIAS blocks two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

seventeen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-nine 2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips

From Fabric C, cut:

two 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty 2" squares for the cornerstones
two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 3" squares for the HSTs
one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: ten 2-7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal for the SIAS blocks.

From each of Fabrics D and E, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 3" squares for the HSTs one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: ten 2-7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal for the SIAS blocks.

From Fabric F, cut:

five 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty 3" squares for the HSTs one 2-7/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: ten 2-7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal for the SIAS blocks.

From each of Fabrics G-I, cut:

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty 3" squares for the HSTs

From each of Fabrics J-L, cut:


one 3-3/8" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 3-3/8" squares for the SIAS blocks two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric M, cut:


eighteen 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: two hundred forty 3" squares for the HSTs five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eighty 2-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut: eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks




Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric C square with a 3" Fabric M square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make forty C/M HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 with 3" Fabric H and Fabric M squares to make eighty H/M HSTs.






Step 3: Sew two H/M HSTs together, with the Fabric M edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.


Step 4: Sew two H/M HSTs together, with the Fabric H edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.





Step 5: Sew one Step 3 unit to one Step 4 unit, along a long edge with the Fabric H edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty. These units should measure 4-1/2" square.

Step 6: Gather one 2-1/2" Fabric M square, one 2-1/2" Fabric J square and two C/M HSTs. Arrange as shown, in two rows of two. Sew the squares together to form rows, pressing away from the HSTs. Sew the rows together to form a 4-1/2" square block corner unit. Press. Repeat to make twenty.






Step 7: Sew a Fabric C triangle to opposite sides of a 3-3/8" Fabric J square. Press seam allowances toward the triangles. Repeat on remaining sides of the Fabric J square. Trim the Square-in-a-Square (SIAS) block to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make five.

Step 8: Gather:


four block corner units from Step 6 four Step 5 units one SIAS unit

Arrange as shown, in three rows of three. Sew the square together to form rows, pressing away from the Step 5 units. Sew the rows together to form a 12-1/2" square A Block. Press. Repeat to make five.

Note: The process for Blocks C-D is the same as in the A Blocks. Only quantities and Fabric labels are shown here, for brevity.



Assemble the B Blocks




Step 1: Make forty F/M HSTs.


Step 2: Make eighty I/M HSTs.

Step 3: Sew two I/M HSTs together, with the Fabric M edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.

Step 4: Sew two I/M HSTs together, with the Fabric I edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.










Step 5: Make twenty.

Step 6: Make twenty bock corner units, using squares of Fabric A and M.

Step 7: Make five SIAS units, using a 3-3/8" square of Fabrics A and triangles from Fabric F.




Step 8: Gather:

four block corner units from Step 6 four Step 5 units one SIAS unit


Arrange as shown, in three rows of three. Sew the square together to form rows, pressing away from the Step 5 units. Sew the rows together to form a 12-1/2" square B Block. Press. Repeat to make five.







Assemble the C Blocks



Step 1: Make forty E/M HSTs.


Step 2: Make eighty G/M HSTs.

Step 3: Sew two G/M HSTs together, with the Fabric M edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.

Step 4: Sew two G/M HSTs together, with the Fabric G edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.










Step 5: Make twenty.

Step 6: Make twenty bock corner units, using squares from Fabric K and M.


Step 7: five SIAS units, using a 3-3/8" square of Fabrics K and triangles from Fabric E.




Step 8: Gather:


four block corner units from Step 6 four Step 5 units one SIAS unit

Arrange as shown, in three rows of three. Sew the square together to form rows, pressing away from the Step 5 units. Sew the rows together to form a 12-1/2" square C Block. Press. Repeat to make five.









Step 1: Make forty D/M HSTs.


Step 2: Make eighty F/M HSTs.


Step 3: Sew two F/M HSTs together, with the Fabric M edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.

Step 4: Sew two F/M HSTs together, with the Fabric F edges touching. Press. Repeat to make twenty.












Step 5: Make twenty.

Step 6: Make twenty bock corner units, using squares from Fabric L and M.


Step 7: Make five SIAS units, using a 3-3/8" square of Fabrics L and triangles from Fabric D.




Step 8: Gather:

four block corner units from Step 6 four Step 5 units one SIAS unit


Arrange as shown, in three rows of three. Sew the square together to form rows, pressing away from the Step 5 units. Sew the rows together to form a 12-1/2" square D Block. Press. Repeat to make five.







Assemble the Quilt Center



Step 1: Arrange the A, B, C and D Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using Fabric B sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five block rows.


Step 2: Gather five Fabric C cornerstone squares and four Fabric B sashing strips. Sew each row together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make six sashing rows.

Step 3: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 4: Sew the Fabric A outer border strips together, end-to-end. Measure the length of the quilt through the center. Cut two side border strips to this length. Sew the borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the border. Measure the width of the quilt through the center. Cut two top/bottom border strips to this width. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the border.

Your quilt top is now complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
