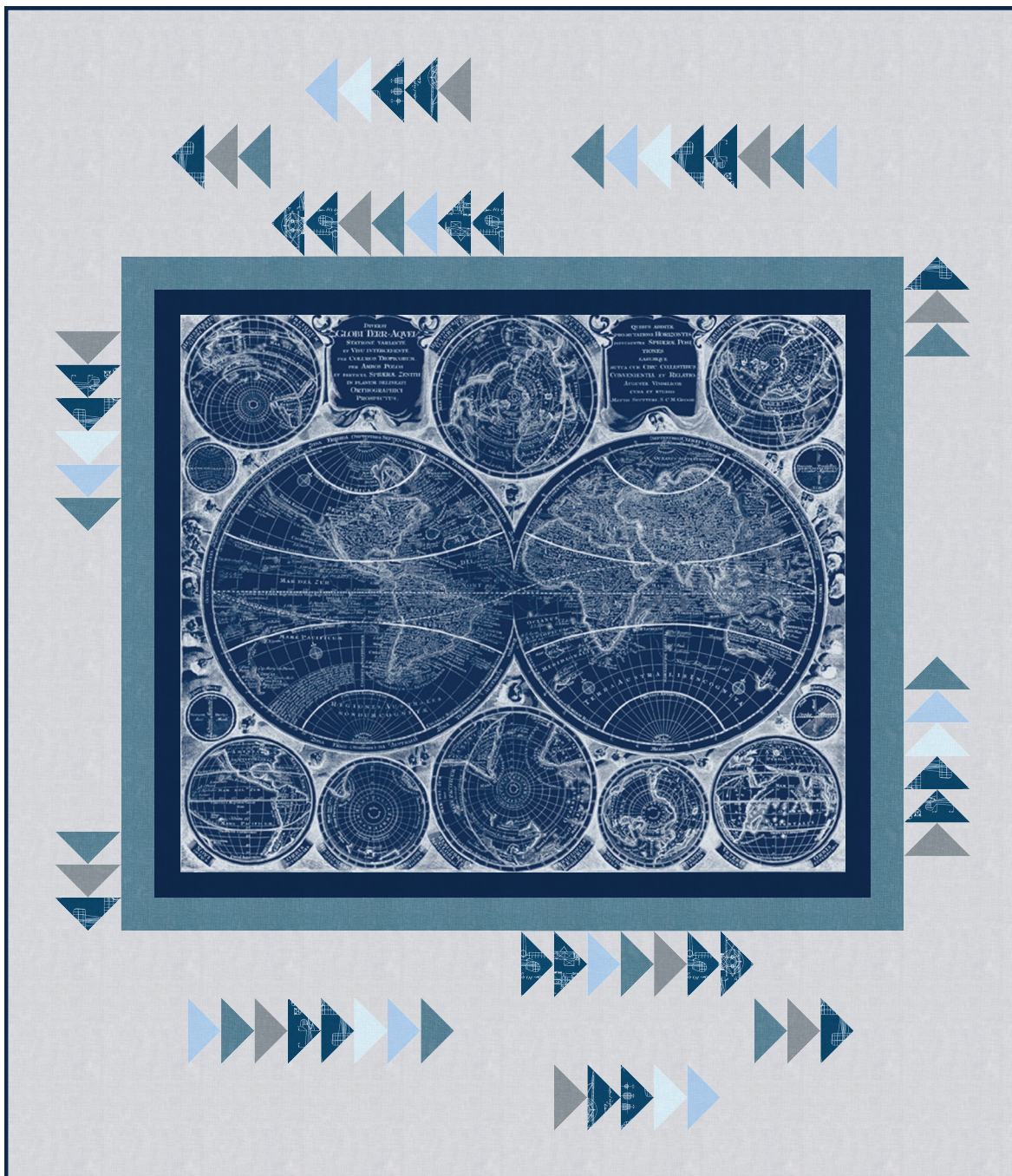





Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 34" x 40-1/2" center panel

From Fabric B, cut:

eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut**:

From the first and second strips, cut:

one 4-1/2" x 26-1/2" rectangle and one 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle, for a total of two of each length

From the third and fourth strips, cut:

one 4-1/2" x 24-1/2" rectangle and one 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle, for a total of two of each length

From the fifth strip, cut:

two additional 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles for a total of four of this length

From the sixth strip, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 17" rectangles

From the seventh strip, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangles and two 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From the eighth strip, cut:

two 4-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles and two 4-1/2" squares

** Subcut using the strip number indicated in the parenthesis in order to maximize the yardage

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 pieces

two 3-1/2" x 65-1/2" side Border 3 pieces

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one hundred twenty-eight 2-1/2" squares for the flying geese

From Fabric C, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for the flying geese

From Fabric D, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for the flying geese

From Fabric E, cut:

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

ten 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for the flying geese

From Fabric F, cut:

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for the flying geese

From Fabric G, cut:

four 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 2" x 40-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces

two 2" x 37" side Border 1 pieces

From Fabric H, cut:

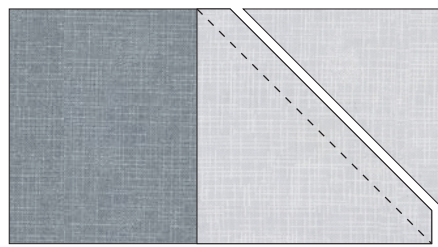
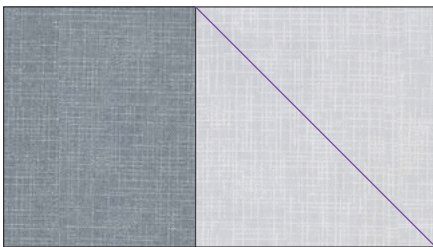
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then cut:
two 2-1/2" x 43-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces
two 2-1/2" x 41" side Border 2 pieces
twelve 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for the flying geese

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

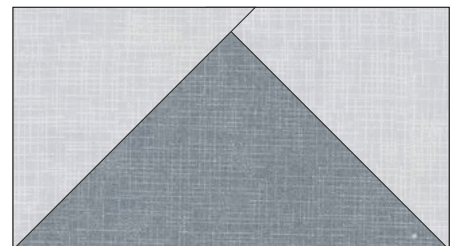
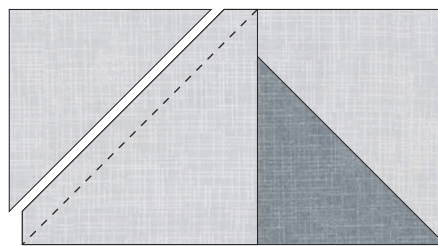
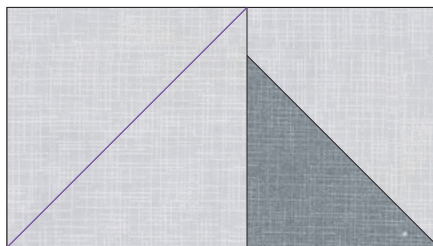
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Flying Geese

Step 1: Place a 2-1/2" Fabric B square RST at one end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric C rectangle. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square, as shown. Sew on the marked line and trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the triangle.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 at the remaining end of the rectangle. The resulting flying geese block should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".



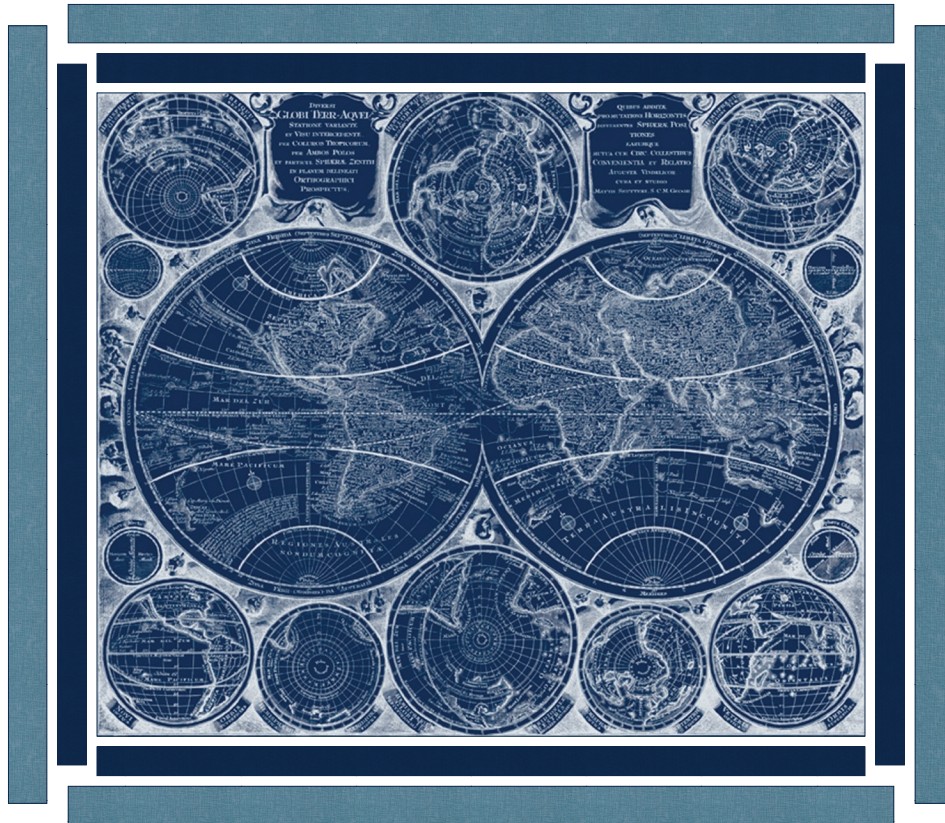
Step 3: Repeat with all remaining 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to create:

twelve Fabric C flying geese
six Fabric D flying geese
ten Fabric E flying geese
twenty-four Fabric F flying geese
twelve Fabric H flying geese

Assemble the Quilt Center

Step 4: Sew the top/bottom Border 1 pieces to the top and bottom of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the left and right edges of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders.

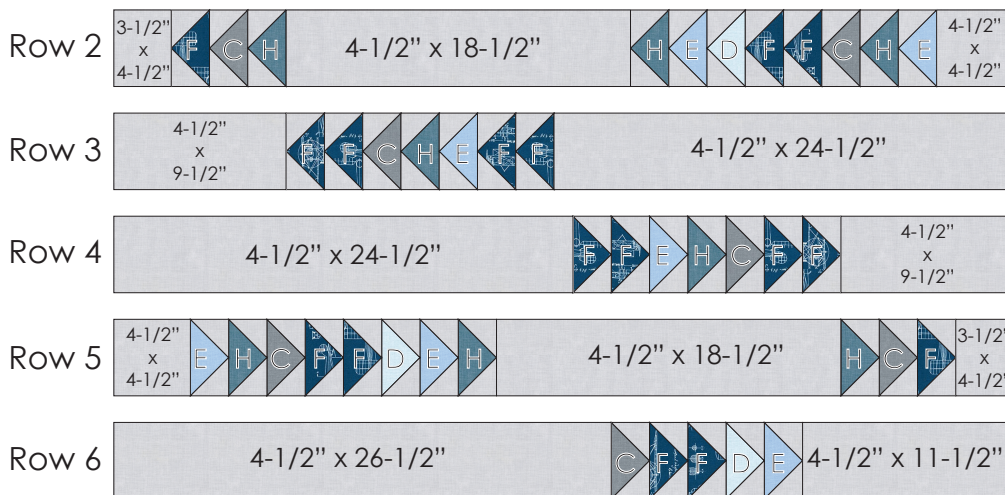
Step 5: Sew the top/bottom Border 2 pieces to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.



Assemble the Pieced Borders

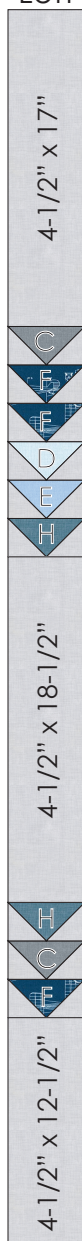
Step 6: Gather and sew the Fabric B pieces and assorted flying geese as shown in the illustration. Sew together to form a row, pressing the seams in one direction. This is Row 1.





Step 7: Continue, as in Step 6, to gather and sew the Fabric B pieces and assorted flying geese as shown in the illustrations. Sew together to form the rows, pressing the seams in one direction.

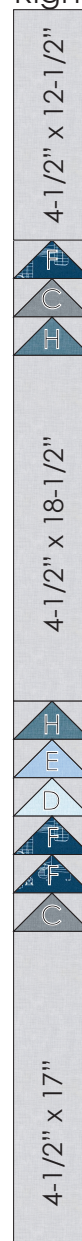
Left



Step 8: Gather and sew the Fabric B pieces and assorted flying geese as shown in the illustration. Sew together to form a side pieced border, pressing the seams in one direction. This is the left pieced border.

Step 9: Continue, as in Step 8, to gather and sew the Fabric B pieces and assorted flying geese as shown in the illustration. Sew together to form the right pieced border, pressing the seams in one direction.

Right



Assemble the Pieced Borders



Step 10: Sew Rows 1-3 together, as shown, noting the orientation of each row. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center. Press. Sew Rows 4-6 together, as shown, noting the orientation of each row. Sew to the bottom edge of the quilt center. Press.

Step 11: Sew the left and right pieced borders to their respective edges of the quilt center. Press.

Step 12: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top/bottom Border 3 pieces to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
