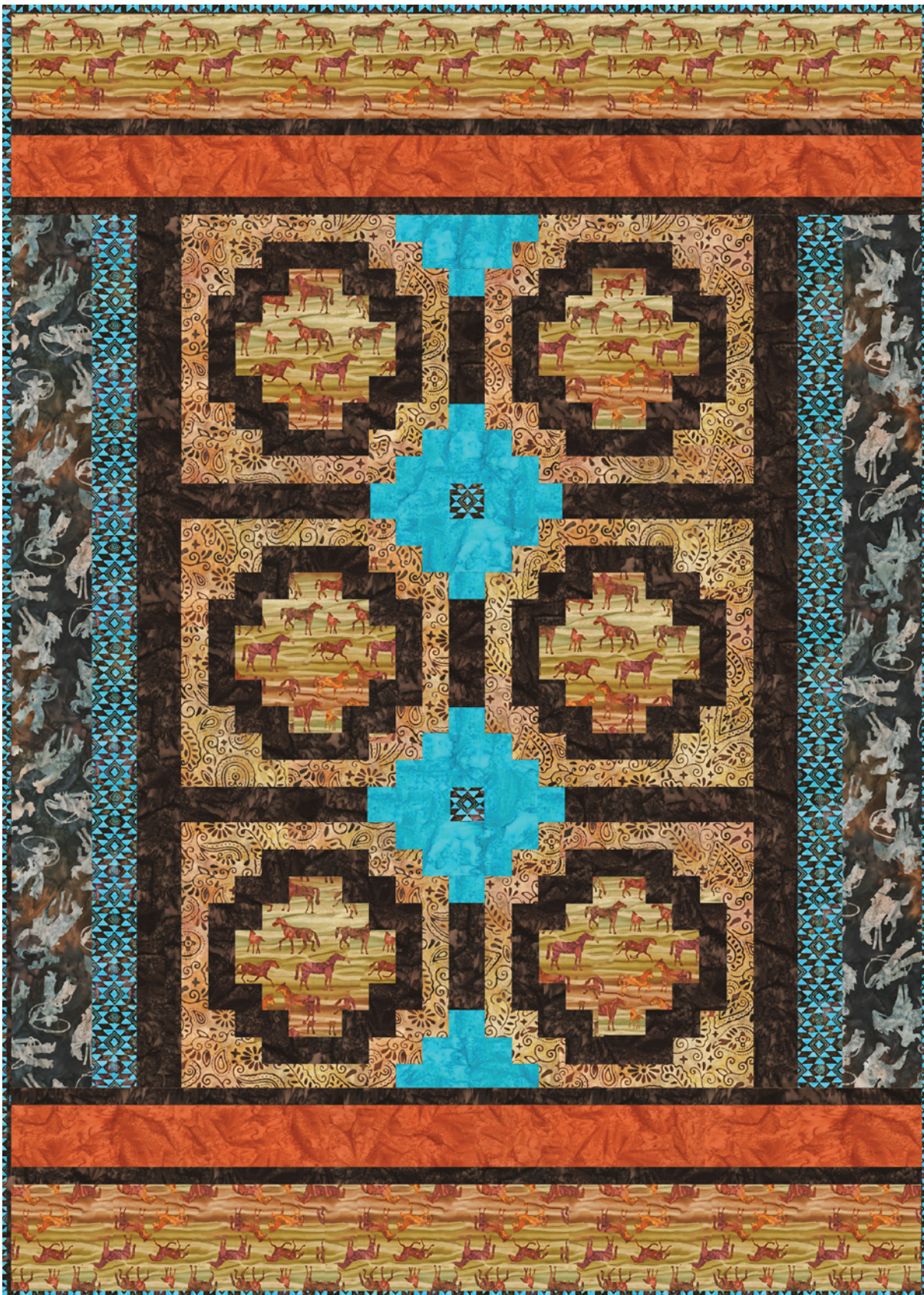

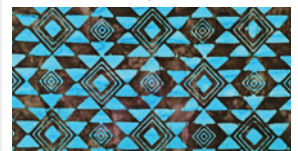

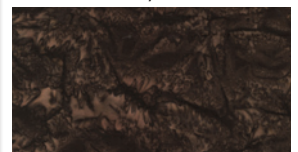

Santa Fe Trail Quilt

This pattern is suitable for quilters of all levels. Please note the following abbreviations are used in this pattern: SPU (strip-pieced unit), WOF (width of fabric, selvage to selvage).

Cutting Instructions



From the Horse Print (1 Yard AMD 7378-170)

Cut four 6 1/2" x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- six 6 1/2" squares (Blocks A & B)
- reserve three strips for borders

Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- twelve 3 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)

Cut one 2" x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- twelve 3 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)



From the Brown Prisma (1 1/8 yards AMD 7000-16)

Cut three 3" x WOF strips (borders)

Cut two 2 1/2 x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- four 10 1/2" x 2 1/2" pieces (sashing)
- three 5 1/2" x 2 1/2" pieces (Block A)

Cut eight 2" x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- twenty-four 6 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)
- twenty-four 3 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)
- twenty-four 2" squares (Blocks A & B)

Cut six 1 1/2" x WOF strips. (borders)



From the Gold Paisley Print (3/4 yards AMD 7382-170)

Cut twelve 2" x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- eighteen 12 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)
- six 9 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)
- twenty-four 3 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)
- twenty-four 2" squares (Blocks A & B)



From the Pacific Prisma Dye (1/3 yard AMD 7000-60)

Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- ten 5 1/2" x 2 1/2" pieces (Blocks A & sashing)

Cut two 2" x WOF strips. From these strips cut:

- twelve 3 1/2" x 2" pieces (Blocks A & B)
- twelve 2" squares (Blocks A & B)



From the Blue Geometric Print (7/8 yards AMD 7383-81)

Cut three 3" x WOF strips, from strips cut:

- cut two 2 1/2" squares (sashing)
- reserve strips for borders

Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips (binding)



From the Cowboy Print (1/2 yard AMD 7381-188)

Cut three 5" x WOF strips. (borders)

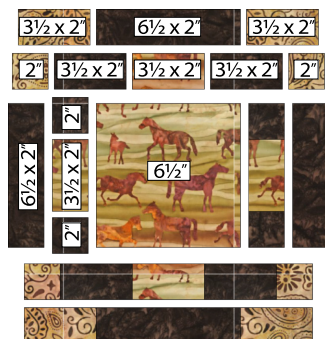


From the Pumpkin Prisma (1/2 yard AMD 7000-148)

Cut three 3 3/4" x WOF strips (borders)

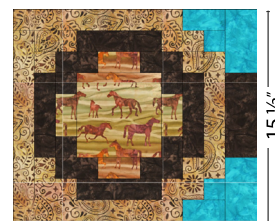
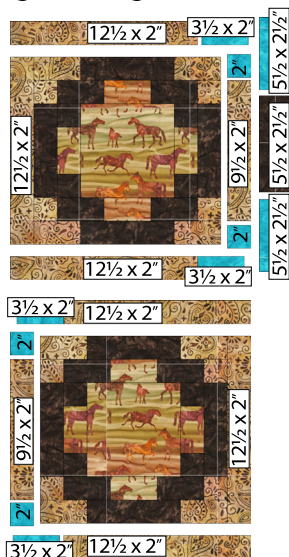
Making the Blocks

Using the listed pieces, sew the block as illustrated. Press all seams to the darker fabric.

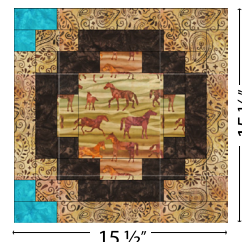


Make 6 Blocks

Add the listed pieces to the blocks made in the previous step. Press all seams to the darker fabric. **Be sure your horses are going in the right direction!**



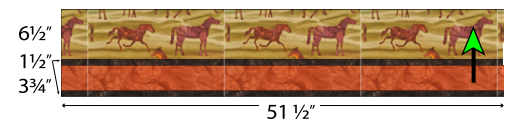
A Block, make 3



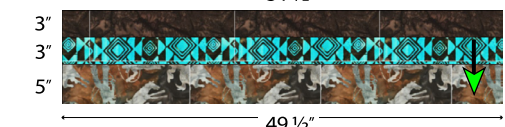
B Block, make 3

Making the Borders

Join the following strips, end to end, creating one long strip for each size and color: 3" brown strips, 3" geometric strips, 5" cowboy strips, 1 1/2" brown strips, 3 3/4" pumpkin strips, and 6 1/2" horse strips. Strip piece the long strips together, as illustrated, and cut to the listed size. Press in the direction indicated by arrows.



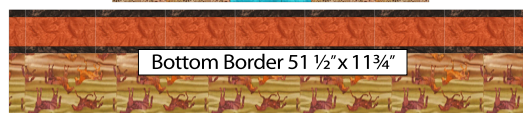
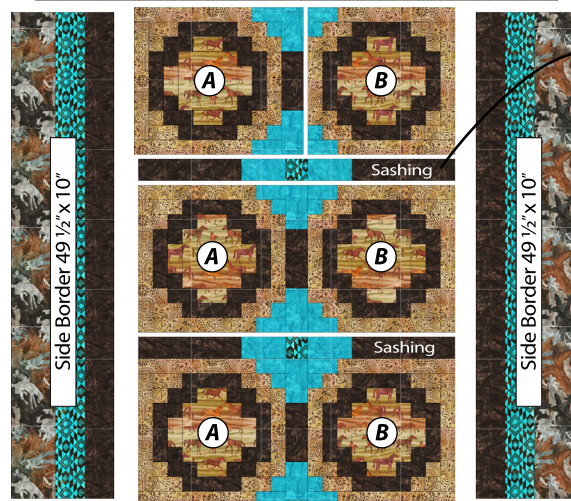
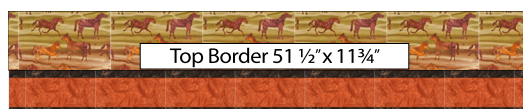
Top & Bottom make 2

Putting It All Together

Sew the blocks, sashing strips and borders together as illustrated. Press seams to the least amount of bulk.
