Inspired by Quiltmaker Magazine's patterns

Here is your opportunity to take a pattern from an issue of *Quiltmaker Magazine*, current, vintage, or somewhere in between, and make it better by adding your own creative spin, in batiks. Using Artisan Batiks fabrics, select any past *Quiltmaker Magazine* pattern, and give it an original interpretation.

RULES

1. All of the quilt top and binding of the Batik Remix '08 entry must be made from the Robert Kaufman *Artisan Batiks* fabric collection.
2. Any other fabrics from any manufacturer may be used to back the quilt.
3. Judging will emphasize originality and creativity, creative interpretation of the original design, creative translation into batiks, and visual impact. The pattern being interpreted must be identified by month, year, and pattern name.
4. To be considered for judging, entries must be able to be a part of a traveling exhibition through November of 2009. Entries should be returned between December 1, 2009 and January 30, 2010. Approximately 20 to 25 entries will be selected to make up the traveling collection.
5. Entries must be able to be folded.
6. Your digital image must be received by *Robert Kaufman Co., Inc.* attention Marketing Dept. Batik Remix, 129 W. 132nd St., Los Angeles, CA 90061, only between September 1, 2008 and October 3, 2008. Digital images must be submitted on a CD-ROM and may be in jpg or tiff format with a resolution of at least 72 dpi but not more than 300 dpi. Send 1 full view of the completed quilt and 1 detail view. Label the CD with your name and the title of the quilt.
7. Notifications of selected quilts will be mailed on October 14, 2008. Selected quilts are due by November 14, 2008. Notification of prize winners will be made by December 1, 2008. If the entry in the opinion of the judges is determined to be significantly different than the digital image, it will be not be considered for judging.
8. Only one entry per person will be accepted for Batik Remix '08.
9. The entry must be accompanied by a \$10.00 entry fee (\$20 for foreign entries) and a signed copy of the official entry form. The entry form and fee must be included with the entry. **(Make checks payable to Robert Kaufman)**
10. All entries must be submitted to the Batiks Remix '08 contest **FIRST** and may not have appeared anywhere else before entry into the contest. The submitted quilt design may not have been published anywhere else, including “online” before submission and may not be published by anyone other than Quiltmaker and its properties during the time the quilt may be traveling.
11. The quilt can be of any shape, but the combined total of all sides of the quilt cannot be less than 88 inches nor more than 180 inches (for example a 22” x 22” quilt equals 88”, a 45” x 45” quilt equals 180”). A round quilt cannot have a diameter greater than 45 inches.
12. The quilt must have a sleeve attached to the top back for hanging. The sleeve opening must be 4 inches wide after it is attached to the quilt, and must be attached in a way that it will not show when the quilt is hanging.
13. An identification label must be securely fastened to the bottom back corner of the quilt (a paper label pinned to the quilt is not acceptable). The label must contain the same full name, address, and phone that appears on the official entry form. The label should also contain the title of the entry.
