

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Note: Stack cut pieces in piles by column number. This will make for speedy piecing during assembly!

From Fabric A, cut:

four 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles for Column 9

four 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, two each for Column 7 & Column 8

four 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, two each for Column 5 & Column 6

two 5-1/2" squares for Column 4

eight 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, two for Col. 1, and three each for Col. 2 & Col. 3

From Fabric B, cut:

three 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 9

four 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, two each for Column 7 & Column 8

four 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, two each for Column 5 & Column 6

two 5-1/2" squares for Column 4

six 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, two each for Col. 1, Col. 2 & Col. 3

Trim the remainder of the last strip to 3" wide, then trim:

one 3" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 9

From Fabric C, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 9

two 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, one each for Column 7 & Column 8

four 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, two each for Column 5 & Column 6

two 5-1/2" squares for Column 4

four 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, two for Col. 1, and one each for Col. 2 & Col. 3

one 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one 3" x 8-1/2" rectangle for Column 7

From Fabric D, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 9

two 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, one each for Column 7 & Column 8

three 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, two for Column 5, one for Column 6

one 5-1/2" square for Column 4

three 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, one each for Col. 1, Col. 2 & Col. 3

From Fabric E, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 4

two 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, one each for Column 7 & Column 8

one 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle for Column 6

one 5-1/2" square for Column 3

three 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, one each for Col. 1, Col. 2 & Col. 3

From each of Fabrics F-H, and J-L, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 9

two 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, one each for Column 7 & Column 8

two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, one each for Column 5 & Column 6

one 5-1/2" square for Column 4

three 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, one each for Col. 1, Col. 2 & Col. 3

From Fabric I, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 9

three 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, one for Column 7 and two for Column 8

two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, one each for Column 5 & Column 6

one 5-1/2" square for Column 4

three 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, one each for Col. 1, Col. 2 & Col. 3

one 8" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 8" x 12-1/2" rectangle for Column 9

Trim the remainder of the strip to 3" wide, then subcut:

one 3" x 8-1/2" rectangle for Column 7

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Step 1: Arrange the cut pieces into columns, as shown. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for proper fabric placement.

Step 2: Sew each column together, pressing the seams in one direction. Press the seams up in the even numbered columns and down in the odd numbered columns.

Step 3: Sew the columns together, nesting the seams where they meet, and pressing the seams open or to one side.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
