

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

#### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 24-1/2" x 42-1/2" center panel

## From Fabric B, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 3" squares for the pinwheel blocks four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" side Border 1 pieces two 1-1/2" x 25-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces

## From Fabric C, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" side Border 2 pieces two 2-1/2" x 30-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces

#### From Fabric D, cut:

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 4-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips two 4-1/2" x 19-1/2" strips three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty-six 3" squares for the pinwheel blocks two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: fourteen 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" sashing strips

#### From each of Fabrics E-G, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 3" squares for the pinwheel blocks

#### From each of Fabrics H and I, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 3" squares for the pinwheel blocks

#### From Fabric J, cut:

two 4" x <u>length of fabric</u> strips. Subcut: two 4" x 56-1/2" side Border 4 pieces From the remaining width of fabric, cut: three 4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 4" x 45-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 pieces


#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips


# Assemble the Pinwheel Blocks

**Step 1:** Pair a 3" Fabric D square with a 3" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of eight D/E HSTs.


**Step 2:** Arrange four matching HSTs together in two rows of two, noting the fabric placement and HST orientation in the diagram. Sew the HSTs together to form rows, pressing the seam toward the darker fabric. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the row seam open. Repeat to make two 4-1/2" square pinwheel blocks.




Step 3: Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make:




four Fabric E pinwheel blocks




four Fabric G pinwheel blocks

# Assemble the Border 3 Sections

**Step 4:** Gather: one pinwheel block in each of Fabrics B, E, F, G, H and I five 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric D sashing strips one 4-1/2" x 19-1/2" Fabric D strip

**Step 5:** Arrange in the order shown and sew together. Press the seam to one side. This is one side Border 3 unit.



Repeat Steps 4 and 5 to make a second side Border 3 unit.

## Step 6: Gather:


one pinwheel block in each of Fabrics E, F and G two 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric D sashing strips one 4-1/2" x 24-1/2" Fabric D strip

**Step 7:** Arrange in the order shown and sew together. Press the seam to one side. This is one top/bottom Border 3 unit.



Repeat Steps 6 and 7 to make a second top/bottom Border 3 unit.

Assemble the Border 3 Sections



**Step 8:** Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the Fabric A quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 9:** Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 10:** Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Pay close attention to the orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 11:** Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Pay close attention to the print orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

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
