## Block Construction:

You will need to make 80 Half Square Triangles (HST's) for this quilt. You will need to cut 6 1/2" square blocks from the following colors:

You will need 5 strips of fabric that are 2 1/2" x 43"

\*you can use 2 yards and include the selvedge in the seam allowance when piecing or use 2 3/4 yards to piece the back. Or add leftover patterned fabric for a scrappy back!

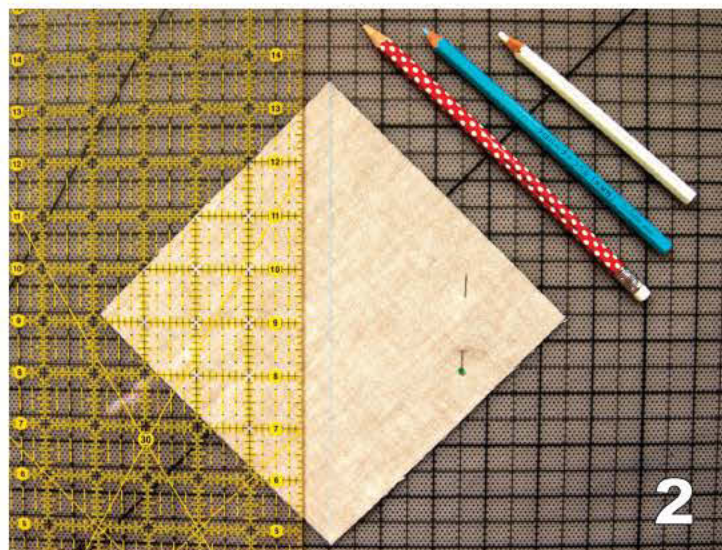
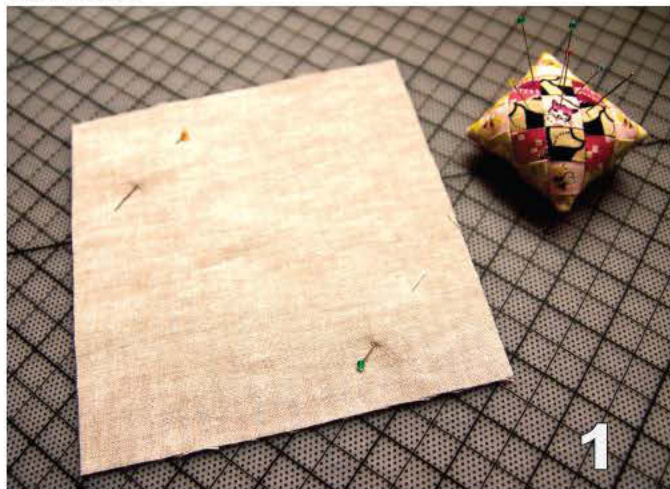

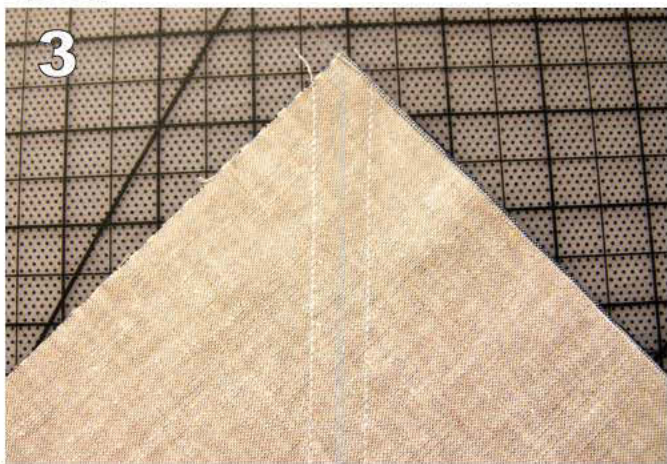
## Creating Half Square Triangles (HST'S)

Start with two 6 1/4" squares, one solid and one patterned. Place the fabric right side together and pin at two opposing corners.



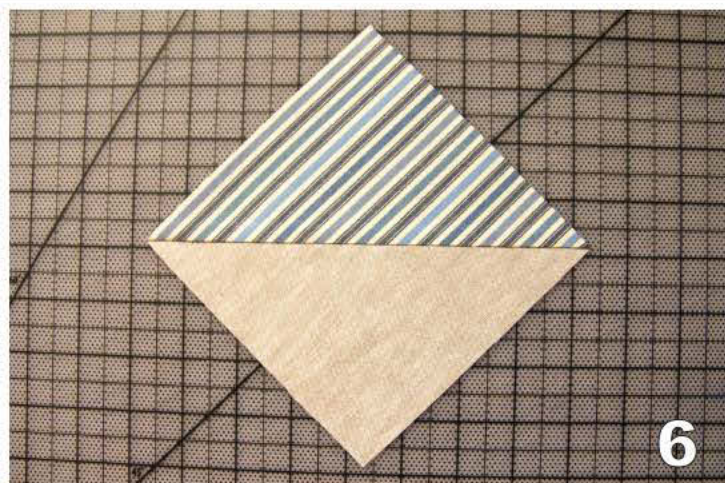
Draw a line with a pencil, water-soluble pen or tailor's chalk on the diagonal through the block, from corner to corner. This will help you line up your seams when you go to sew.

Feed your block through your machine, using the line you drew as a guide. Sew 1/4" from the line on either side of the block.



The line you drew will now become your cutting guide. Place your ruler on the line and cut. Now you have two blocks!

Press your seams towards the darker side.



Trim blocks to 5 3/4" and piece according to desired layout (see attached images.)

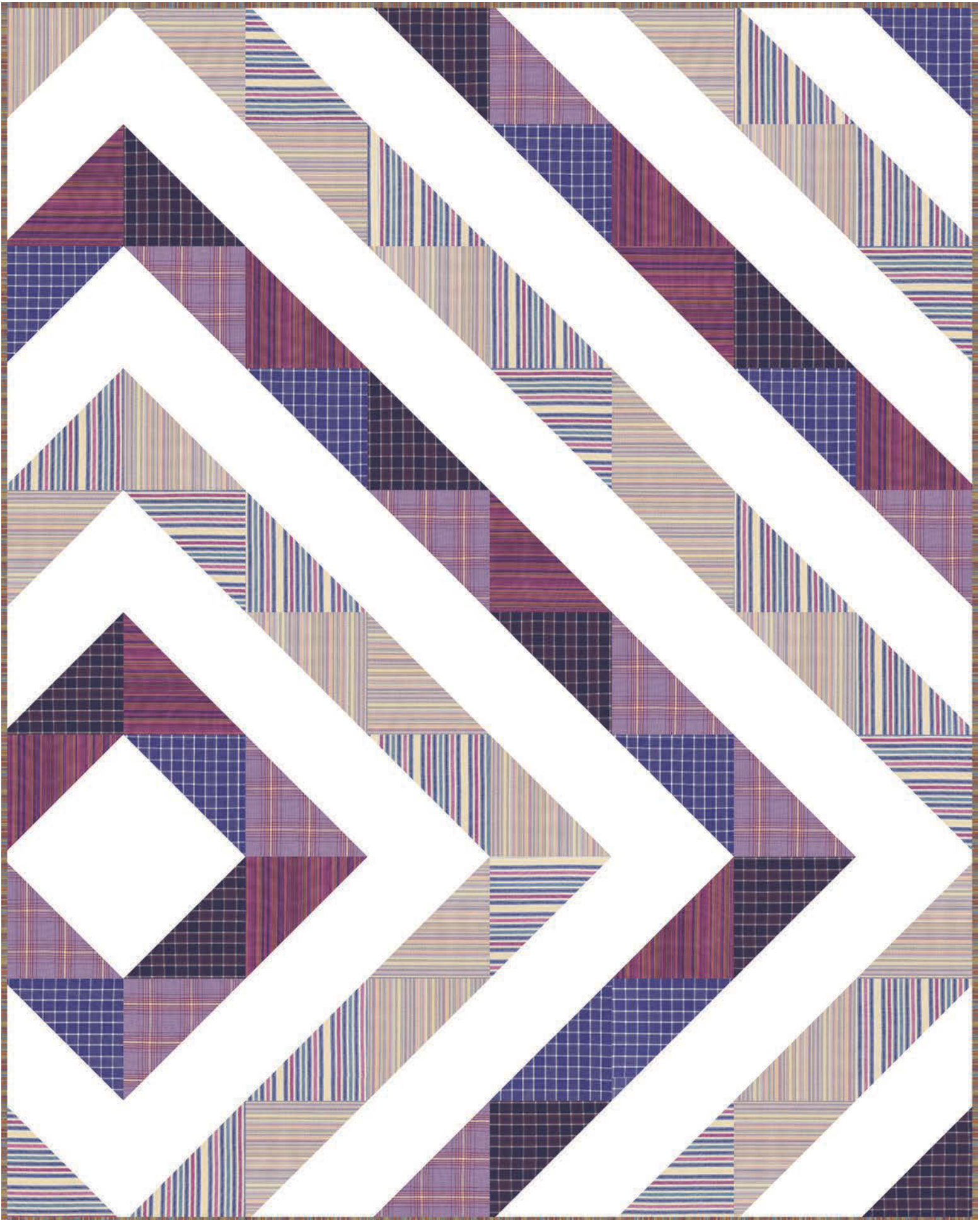
