## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
six $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
twenty-four 3-1/2" squares.
From Fabric B, cut:
five 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 2 " $\times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders.
two 2 " $\times 42$-1/2" top/bottom inner borders.
From each of Fabrics C, E, F, G, and Q, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips from each fabric. Subcut:
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of each fabric. five $3-1 / 2$ " squares of each fabric.

From each of Fabrics $D$ and $H$, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips of each fabric. Subcut:
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of each fabric.
four 3-1/2" squares of each fabric.
From Fabric I, cut:
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle.
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
one 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle.
From each of Fabrics J and O , cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips from each fabric. Subcut: one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of each fabric. one 3-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of each fabric. one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of each fabric. five $3-1 / 2$ " squares of each fabric.

From Fabric K, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: one 3-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangle. one 3-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. seven 3-1/2" squares.

From Fabric L, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
three 3-1/2" squares.

## From Fabric $M$, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle.
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
one 3-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
three 3-1/2" squares.

## From Fabric $\mathbf{N}$, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle.
four 3-1/2" squares.

## From Fabric P , cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle.
one 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle.
one 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle.
five $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Assemble the Flying Geese Units

Step 1: Pin one 3-1/2" Fabric A square on the left edge of the $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J rectangle. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line through the square. Sew on the diagonal line, then trim the excess fabric $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam. Set the seam by pressing it flat, then cut along the diagonal line.


Step 2: Pin another 3-1/2" Fabric A square on the right edge of the unit. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line through the square. Sew on the diagonal line, then trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seam. Set the seam by pressing it flat, then cut along the diagonal line.

Step 3: Repeat using two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A squares and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric O rectangle.


Step 4: Repeat using two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K squares and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle.

Step 5: Repeat using two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $N$ squares and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangle.

## Assemble the Stitch-and-Flip Units

Step 6: Pin two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A squares on the ends of the $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I rectangle. Using a ruler, draw a diagonal line through the squares. Sew on the diagonal lines, then trim the excess fabric $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seams. Set the seams by pressing them flat, then cut along the diagonal lines.


Step 7: Repeat using two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A squares and a 3-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric L rectangle.


Step 8: Repeat using two 3-1/2" Fabric A squares and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $M$ rectangle.

Step 9: Repeat using two 3-1/2" Fabric A squares and a 3-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric P rectangle.


Step 10: Repeat using one 3-1/2" Fabric A square and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K rectangle.

Step 11: Repeat using one 3-1/2" Fabric A square and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $N$ rectangle.


Step 12: Repeat using one 3-1/2" Fabric A square and a 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric L rectangle.


Step 13: Repeat using one 3-1/2" Fabric A square and a 3-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $M$ rectangle.


Step 14: Repeat using one 3-1/2" Fabric A square and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K rectangle.

Step 15: Repeat using one 3-1/2" Fabric A square and a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $N$ rectangle.


Step 16: Repeat using one $3-1 / 2$ " Fabric A square and a 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric L rectangle.


Step 17: Repeat using one 3-1/2" Fabric A square and a 3-1/2" $\times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $M$ rectangle.

## Assemble the Quilt

Step 18: Arrange the 3-1/2" Fabric A squares, remaining rectangles in various lengths, Flying Geese, and Stitch-and-Flip units in rows. See the Quilt Assembly Diagram for exact fabric placement and orientation.

Step 19: Sew any of the rows consisting of pieced units together, then press.

Step 20: After the pieced rows have been assembled, sew the rows together and press.

Step 21: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.


Step 22: Sew sixteen of the 3-1/2" Fabric C-Q squares together to form a side outer border. Make four outer borders.

Step 23: Select two of the outer borders for the sides of the quilt, then sew them in place. Press toward the borders. Sew the two remaining outer borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
