Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A, P and Q, cut:

two 5-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut:

four 5-1/2" squares

one 2-1/2" square for the centers

three 2-1/2" 3-1/2" rectangles for the border

three 1-3/4" x 21" strips. Subcut:

two 1-3/4" x 10" side block borders

two 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" top/bottom block borders

From each of Fabrics B, D, K, L, and O, cut:

one 2-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut:

three 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for the border

three 1-3/4" x 21" strips. Subcut:

two 1-3/4" x 10" side block borders

two 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" top/bottom block borders

From each of Fabrics E and F, cut:

two 3" x 21" strips. Set aside for strip piecing. one 2-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut:
three 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for the border

From each of Fabrics G, H, M, and N, cut:

two 5-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut:
four 5-1/2" squares
one 2-1/2" square for the centers
three 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for the border

From Fabric R, fussy cut:

eight 11" squares. These will be embroidered and trimmed to 10" later.

From Fabric S, cut:

five 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then set aside for the inner border. four 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then set aside for the outer border. four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighty-four 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric T, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 3" x 21" strips for strip piecing four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: fifty-six 3" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:


six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Embroider the Blocks

Step 1 Embroider eight Fabric R blocks with floss, using 1 or 2 strands, matching the colors on the panel. Use an outline stitch, lazy daisy stitch, straight stitch and French knots. Press the blocks right side down on a fluffy towel. **Trim** the blocks to 10" square.


Step 2 Sew the colored 1-3/4" x 10" block border strips to the sides of each of the embroidered blocks. Press toward the border.

Step 3 Sew matching 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" block border strips to the top and bottom of each of the blocks. Press toward the border. At this point the blocks should measure 12-1/2" square. Set aside.




Assemble the Pieced Blocks


Step 1 Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the 3" Fabric T squares. Place a Fabric T square on the corner of a 5-1/2" Fabric Q square. Sew on the diagonal, trim the excess to leave a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat on the opposite corner of the colored block. Do this same procedure for each of the 5-1/2" squares.




Step 2 Sew together the 3" Fabric F and 3" Fabric T strips to make two 5-1/2" x 21" strip sets. Repeat with the Fabric E and T strips to make two more strip sets. Press toward the darker fabric. Cut the strip sets apart into a total of sixteen 2-1/2" wide F/T units and twelve 2-1/2" E/T units.




Step 3 Sew two matching units from Step 1 on either side of a strip set unit from Step 2. Press toward the center. Repeat to make a second identical pair.




Step 4 Sew a matching 2-1/2" square between two Step 2 units. Press toward the Step 2 units.





Step 5 Sew the Step 3 and Step 4 units together to make a block. Press toward the center. At this point the block should measure 12-1/2". Repeat for the other six blocks.



Step 1 Alternating the pieced blocks with the embroidered blocks, sew the blocks together in five rows of three blocks. Press toward the sashing.

Step 2 Sew the rows together, matching and pinning seam intersections. Press the seams all one direction.

Step 3 Measure, trim and sew the white 2" Fabric S inner borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Repeat for the top and bottom of the quilt.

Step 4 Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the 1-1/2" Fabric S squares. Place a square on the corner of a colorful print rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal, trim and press.

Note: HALF of the blocks are sewn with the corners one direction and half the other direction. Note the pressing directions also.




Step 6 Sew ten A and ten B units from Step 5 together in a row. Press the seams open. Repeat for the other side of the quilt. (Two units will be left over.)




Step 7 Sew an A unit to the end of the left pieced border, continuing the A/B pattern. Sew a B unit to the end of the right pieced border, continuing the A/B pattern. Press. Sew the pieced borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the inner border.



Step 8 Piece, measure and trim two 2" Fabric S borders the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt.



Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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Alternate Cutting Instructions for Small Quilt

(See alternate assembly instructions for the Small Quilt below)

From each of Fabrics A-E, cut:

two 5-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut:

four 5-1/2" squares

two 2-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" squares for the block centers and border corners

ten 2-1/2" 3-1/2" rectangles for the border

From Fabric G, fussy cut:

four 11" squares. These will be embroidered and trimmed to 10" later.

From Fabric I, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

six 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 1-3/4" x 10" side block borders

eight 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" top/bottom block borders

From Fabric H, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty 3" squares

ten 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then subcut:

eight 1-3/4" x 2-1/2" rectangles for the border. Set the remainder aside for the inner and outer borders.

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

ninety-six 1-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Alternate Assembly Instructions for making the Small Quilt

Embroider the Blocks

Follow all assembly instructions as in the Large quilt, but make only four Blocks. Each Block will have a Fabric I border.

Pieced Blocks

Step 1 Follow directions from the Large Quilt, using 3" Fabric H squares with 5-1/2" red print squares.

Step 2 Follow directions from the Large Quilt to make two strip sets with Fabrics H and I. Press toward the blue strips. Cut the strip sets apart into a total of twenty 2-1/2" wide units.

Steps 3-5 Follow directions from the Large Quilt to make a total of five Pieced Blocks.


Assembling the Quilt

Step 1 Alternating the pieced blocks with the embroidered blocks, sew the blocks together in three rows of three blocks. Press toward the blue sashing.

Step 2 Sew the rows together, matching and pinning seam intersections. Press the seams all one direction.

Step 3 Measure, trim and sew the white 1-3/4" borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders. Repeat for the top and bottom of the quilt.

Step 4 Make the Border units as in the Large Quilt, noting that half will be in each of two orientations, as in the Large Quilt.



Step 5 Sew six A and six B units from Step 4 together in a row. Press the seams open. Repeat for the other 3 sides of the quilt. Sew a 1-3/4" x 2-1/2" Fabric H rectangle on the ends of each row.

Step 6 Sew the pieced borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the inner border. Sew 2-1/2" red print squares to the ends of the remaining borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press towards the inner border.

Step 7 Piece, measure and trim two 1-3/4" wide borders the length of the quilt. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Repeat for the top and bottom of the quilt.

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
