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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Fabric A, cut:

- eleven 5-3/4" x WOF, subcut:
each strip into eighteen rectangles 2-1/4" x 5-3/4"
- ten 2-1/4" x WOF, subcut:
each strip into eighteen squares 2-1/4" x 2-1/4"
- twenty-four 2-3/4" x WOF", subcut:
each strip into fifteen squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

Fabric B, I, L, N, O, Q, S and T, cut:

- one strip 4" x WOF, subcut:
nine squares 4" x 4"
two squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"
- one 2-3/4" x WOF, subcut:
sixteen squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4".

Fabric E, cut:

- one 4" x WOF, subcut:
into eight squares 4" x 4".

Fabric C, J, M and P, cut:

one 4" x WOF, subcut:

eight squares 4" x 4"

two 2-3/4" x WOF, subcut:

sixteen squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

five squares 2-1/4" x 2-1/4"

Fabric G, H, K, R, cut:

one 4" x WOF, subcut:

eight squares 4" x 4"

two 2-3/4" x WOF, subcut:

sixteen squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

four squares 2-1/4" x 2-1/4"

Fabric D, cut:

two 4" x WOF, subcut:

seventeen squares 4" x 4"

three 2-3/4" x WOF, subcut:

thirty-four squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

Fabric F, cut:

two 4" x WOF, subcut:

seventeen squares 4" x 4"

three 2-3/4" x WOF, subcut:

thirty-four squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4"

four squares 2-1/4" x 2-1/4"

Binding Fabric, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assembly Instructions

Step One: Make Half Square Triangles (HSTs)

Place a Fabric A (shown in white) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" square right sides together with a Fabric B 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" square.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and then sew a scant 1/4" from each side of the line (fig. 1).

Cut apart along the drawn line (fig. 2).

You will now have 2 half square triangles.

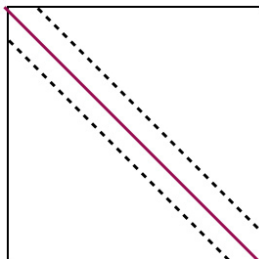

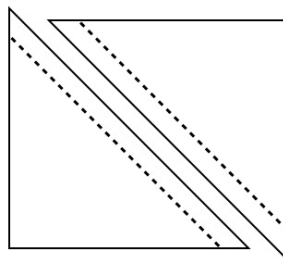

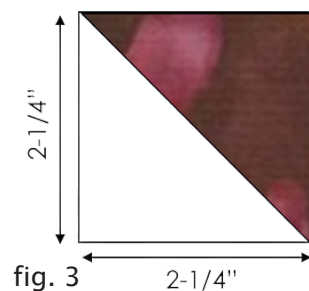

Sew four A/B HSTs and one Fabric A 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" square to a Fabric B 4" x 4" square. **Notice the direction of the HSTs.**

Step Two: Make Bear Claw Units square as pictured (fig 4 and 5)

Repeat to make one-hundred seventy-eight bear claw units, always matching the HSTs with a matching 4" x 4" square (fig. 5).

Use the chart on page 5 to organize the HSTs and squares for ease in assembling.

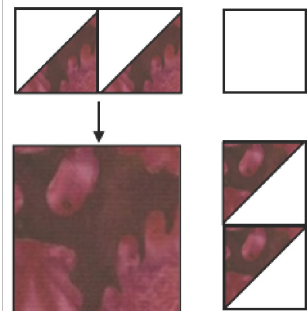

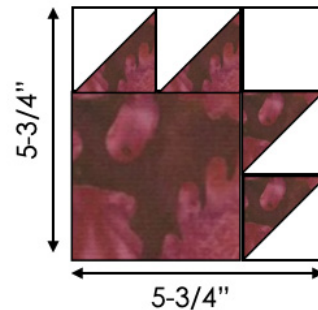

Step Three: Make Bear Claw Blocks

Use fig. 9 on page 6 as a guide to lay out the blocks.

Sew a bear claw unit to each long side of a Fabric A $2\text{-}1/4'' \times 5\text{-}3/4''$ rectangle. Press seam allowance towards Fabric A (fig. 6).

Repeat to make a second set.

Sew a Fabric A $2\text{-}1/4'' \times 5\text{-}3/4''$ rectangle to opposite sides of a $2\text{-}1/4'' \times 2\text{-}1/4''$ square. Press seam allowance towards Fabric A (fig. 7).

Sew the three rows together as pictured (fig. 8).

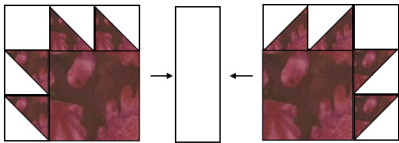

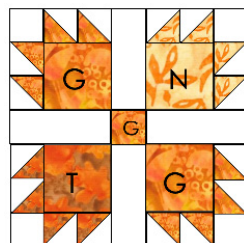
Assemble the Bear Claw blocks as indicated below.

The blocks for the edges of the quilt will only have three bear claw units per

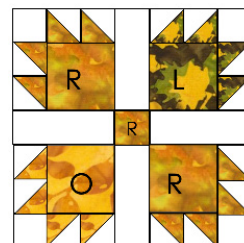

Step Four: Assemble the Quilt Top

Sew the blocks into diagonal rows and then sew rows together to make the quilt top.



Step Five: Finishing

True up all four sides of the quilt top to create straight edges (fig. 11).

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind & enjoy.

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
