






 1/2 yard Binding  
 4-1/2 yards Backing Fabric  
 56" x 80" Quilt Batting

### Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### Fabric A

Cut the following and label:

Aa- Cut two squares  $18\frac{1}{2}'' \times 18\frac{1}{2}''$ .

Ab- Cut two squares  $14\frac{7}{8}''$ , then cut into half- square triangles (HSTs).

Ac- Cut three rectangles  $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 28\frac{1}{2}''$ .

Ad- Cut seven squares  $4\frac{3}{8}'' \times 4\frac{3}{8}''$ , then cut into HSTs.

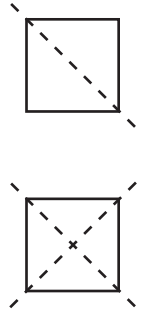
Ae- Cut four squares  $8\frac{1}{4}'' \times 8\frac{1}{4}''$ , then cut into quarter square triangles (QSTs).

Border Rectangles- Cut three strips  $4'' \times \text{WOF}$ , then:

Af- Cut five rectangles  $4'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ .

Ag- Cut two rectangles  $4'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ .

Ah- Cut five rectangles  $4'' \times 9''$ .



### Fabric B

- Cut seven squares  $8\frac{1}{4}'' \times 8\frac{1}{4}''$ , then cut into QSTs.

### Fabrics C, D, E, G, K and M

- Cut two squares  $8\frac{1}{4}'' \times 8\frac{1}{4}''$ , then cut into QSTs.

### Fabrics F, H, I, J and L

- Cut three squares  $8\frac{1}{4}'' \times 8\frac{1}{4}''$ , then cut into QSTs.

## Assembly Instructions

1. Following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange the HSTs, beginning with column 1 on the right hand side of the diagram. They will be sewn together in vertical columns (these are numbered from right to left on the schematic).

When you are pleased with the arrangement of colors, sew the triangles in column 1 (**Figure 1**).

2. Complete columns 1 through 4 for section 1.

Sew the columns together.

Add piece Ab to the top and bottom of the section.

Complete section 2, sewing columns 5 through 8 in the same manner.

Add piece Ab to the top and bottom.

Sew sections 1 and 2 together. Add piece Ac to the top and

3. Section 3: The HSTs are assembled in diagonal rows (**Figures 2 & 3**).

Complete the two rows and sew them together.

Add piece Ab.

Complete the second part of section 3. Sew the two parts together.

Add piece Ac to the left side.

Sew an Aa square to the top and bottom of section 3.

Sew section 3 to the rest of the quilt.

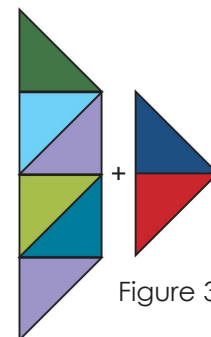
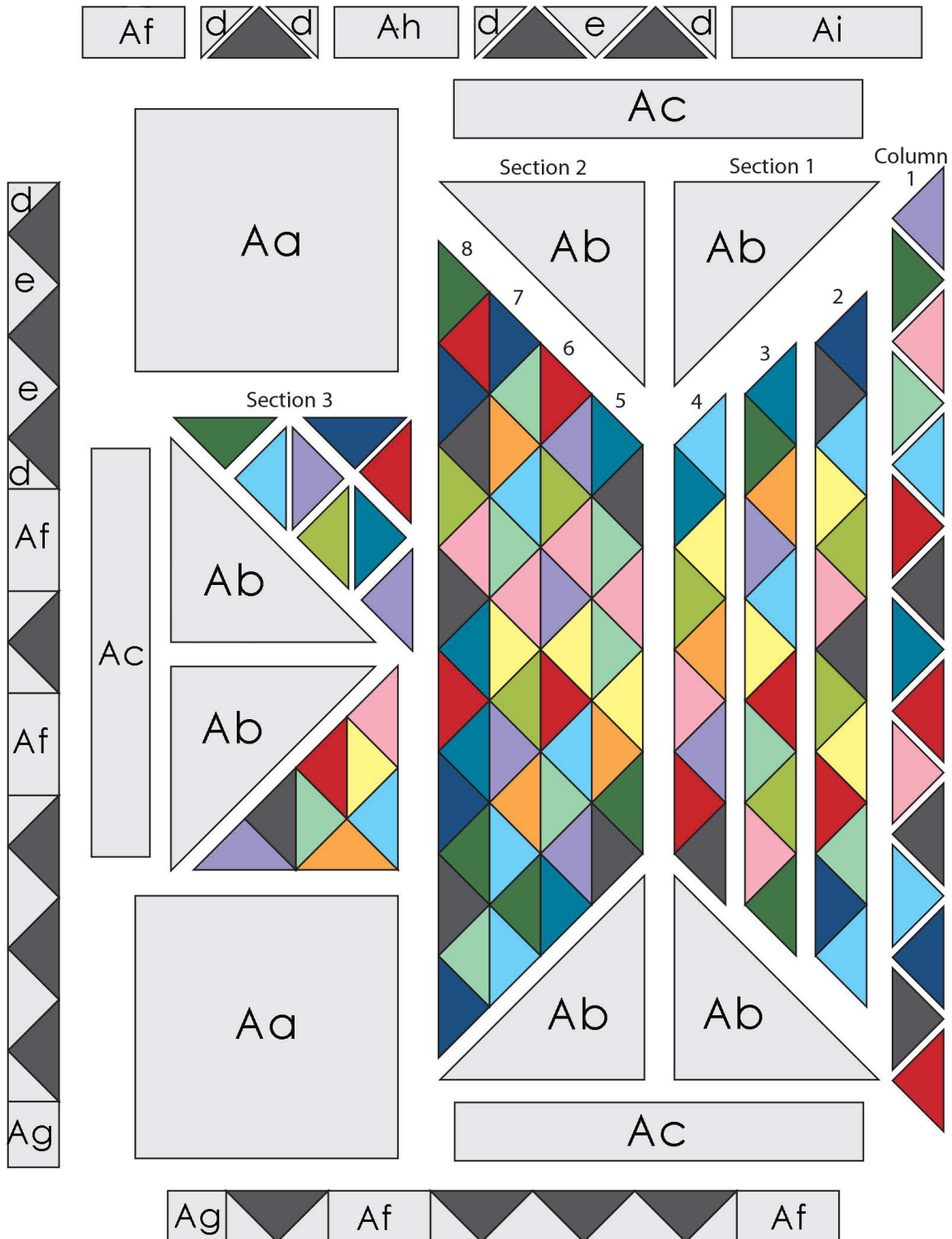

- Beginning with the bottom border and following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange the border pieces and stitch together. Add to the quilt.
- Follow the same procedure and complete the side border, then the top border. Add them to the quilt.
