# Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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# Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:

one 10-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 10-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric C, cut:

one 10-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 10-1/2" squares

seven 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, then trim to make:

two 5" x 68" side outer borders

two 5" x 61-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

#### From Fabric E, cut:

one 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 3" squares for the HSTs

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, then trim to make:

two 2-1/2" x 64" side middle borders

two 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom middle borders

four 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

four 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

#### From each of Fabrics D and F-I, cut:

one 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 3" squares for the HSTs

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

four 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

#### From Fabric J, cut:

twelve 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, then trim to make:

two 2" x 61" side inner borders

two 2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

three 2" x 45-1/2" row sashing strips

eight 2" x 14-1/2" block sashing strips

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

# Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 3" Fabric D square with a 3" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight D/E HSTs.



#### **Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:





#### Assemble the Blocks



**Step 3:** Gather: one Fabric A square two Fabric D/E HSTs one 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle from each of Fabrics D and E one 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle from each of Fabrics D and E

Arrange the units as shown. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.


**Step 4:** Sew the 10-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of the center square. Press the seams toward the rectangles.

**Step 5:** Sew the HSTs to the 12-1/2" rectangles noting the orientation of the HST. Press the seams toward the rectangles.

**Step 6:** Sew the completed Step 5 units to the left and right edges of the Block, nesting the seams and pressing the seam to one side.

The resulting Block should measure 14-1/2" square. Repeat to make four A Blocks.

**Step 7:** Repeat Steps 3-6 to make:



four B Blocks



four C Blocks

## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 8:** Arrange the A, B and C Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

**Step 9:** Sew the row sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

**Step 10:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 11:** Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 12:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.



Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
