## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

three 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 9-1/2" $\times 23^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles*
one 9-1/2" $\times 21-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
two 9-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles*
one 9-1/2" x 11 " rectangle
*Tip: cut one of each of these from one strip to maximize yardage.
seven 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty-six 4" squares for the HSTs
three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-three 3-1/2" squares
five 3 " x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty-six 3" squares
twenty-two 2 " x WOF strips. Sew sixteen strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
eight 2 " $\times 62$ " row sashing strips
two 2 " $\times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side inner borders
From the remaining strips, subcut:
twenty-two 2" x 9-1/2" block sashing strips

## From Fabric B, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2-1/2" x 69 " top/bottom middle borders
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side middle borders
From Fabric C, cut:
seven $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 77^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom outer borders
two 4-1/2" $\times 79-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
six 4" squares for the HSTs
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twelve 3-1/2" squares
From each of Fabrics D-K, R and S, cut:
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 4" squares for the HSTs
Trim the remainder of the strip to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, then subcut:
four $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## From Fabric L, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 4" squares for the HSTs
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight $3-1 / 2$ " squares

## From each of Fabrics $M$ and $N$, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 4" squares for the HSTs
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twelve 3-1/2" squares
From each of Fabrics $\mathrm{O}-\mathrm{Q}$ cut:
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 4" squares for the HSTs
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 3-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 4" Fabric A square with a 4" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make twelve A/C HSTs.

Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

four A/D HSTs

four A/H HSTs

eight A/L HSTs

sixteen A/P HSTs

four A/E HSTs

four A/l HSTs

twelve A/M HSTs

sixteen A/Q HSTs

four A/F HSTs

four A/J HSTs

twelve A/N HSTs

four A/R HSTs

four A/G HSTs

four A/K HSTs

sixteen A/O HSTs

four A/S HSTs

## Assemble the Stem Units

Step 3: Place a 3" Fabric A square in one corner of a $3-1 / 2$ " Fabric $D$ square, right sides together. Sew along the diagonal, as shown. Trim the excess fabric, leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press toward Fabric A. Repeat on the opposite corner, with a second $3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square.


Step 4: Repeat Step 4 to make:
one Stem unit from each of Fabrics D-K, R and S two Stem units Fabric L
three Stem units from each of Fabrics $C, M$ and $N$ four Stem units from each of Fabrics $O-Q$

## Assemble the Blocks



Step 5: Gather:
one 3-1/2" Fabric A square
three 3-1/2" Fabric D squares
one Fabric D Stem unit
four A/D HSTs
Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the pieces together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

Step 7: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Block will measure 9-1/2" square.
Step 8: Repeat Steps 5-7 to make a total of thirty-three Blocks:
one Block from each of Fabrics D-K, R and S
two Block from Fabric L
three Block from each of Fabrics $\mathrm{C}, \mathrm{M}$ and N
four Block from each of Fabrics $O-Q$


Step 9: Arrange the Blocks and Fabric A rectangles together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Note the orientation of the leaf blocks. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make seven block rows.

Step 10: Sew the eight Fabric A row sashing strips and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 11: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
Step 12: Sew two middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew two middle borders to top and bottom the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew two outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew two outer borders to top and bottom the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
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
