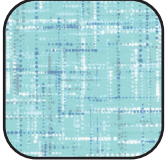
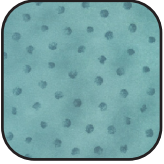




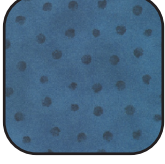

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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You will also need:  
twin size batting (50" x 68")

### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 5/8" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

From **Fabrics A-J**, cut:  
three 8" x WOF, subcut:  
twelve 8" x 9-1/2" rectangles

From **batting**, cut:  
seventy two 6" x 7-1/4" rectangles

## Quilting the Blocks

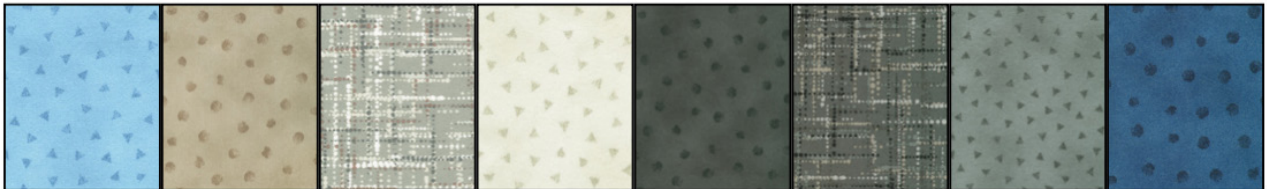
**Step 1:** Place one fabric rectangle face down on work surface. Center a batting rectangle on top. Place a second flannel rectangle face up on top of the batting. Pin in place.

**Step 2:** Sew an X through the center of each sandwich block.

**Tip:** For straight lines without marking, press diagonal fold lines before sewing.

## Assembling the Quilt

**Step 3:** Arrange the finished blocks into nine rows of eight blocks. Rectangles must be oriented in the correct direction when assembling rows. See diagram.



**Step 4:** Place blocks, seam sides up, and sew together using a 5/8" seam allowance. Join blocks into rows, and then sew the rows together.

**Step 5:** Sew a decorative seam around the entire outer edge using the same 5/8" seam allowance.

**Step 6:** Clip the seams approximately 1/4" apart along all interior seams and around the outer edge. Be careful not to cut through the stitching.

**Step 7:** Wash the quilt with a few towels to create friction. Tumble dry on medium or high heat and check the lint filter periodically.

**Finished:** After washing and drying, the clipped seams will fluff up into the classic rag quilt texture. This quilt can easily be quilted in a single weekend.
