# Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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# Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: three 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips

#### From Fabric B, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips

#### From Fabric C, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: three 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

#### From each of Fabrics D and E, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles one 4-1/2" square

#### From Fabric F, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

#### From each of Fabrics G and H, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: three 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

#### From each of Fabrics I and J, cut:

five 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: five 2" x 40-1/2" strips

#### From Fabric K, cut:

one 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixteen 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Pieced Rows

#### **Step 1:** Gather:

one Fabric C rectangle

one Fabric D rectangle

one Fabric F rectangle

one Fabric E rectangle

four Fabric K rectangles

Arrange as shown in Row 2 and sew together, pressing the seams to one side. Row 2 should measure 4-1/2" x 40-1/2".



**Step 2:** Repeat the process from Step 1 to sew Rows 4, 6 and 8 together. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement.

## Assemble the Strip Rows

**Step 3:** Gather: one Fabric A strip one Fabric I strip one Fabric J strip

Arrange as shown in Row 1 and sew together, pressing the seams to one side. Row 1 should measure 5-1/2" x 40-1/2".



**Step 4:** Repeat the process from Step 3 to sew Rows 3, 5, 7 and 9 together. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement.



Step 5: Arrange Rows 1-9 together as shown and sew together. Press.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
