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Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

four 11-1/2" x 19-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eight 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips for the top/bottom panel borders
eight 1-1/2" x 19-1/2" strips for the side panel borders
seven 5" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 5" x 70-1/2" strips for the top/bottom outer borders

two 5" x 76-1/2" strips for the side outer borders

From Fabric C, cut:

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: six 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips for the block sashing three 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" strips for the row sashing

From Fabric D, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

six 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" for the block row sashing

ten 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield: two 3-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips for the side inner borders two 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" strips for the top/bottom middle borders two 3-1/2" x 70-1/2" strips for the side middle borders two 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips for the mug blocks

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 3" x 35-1/2" strips for the top/bottom inner borders fifteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

ten 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" for the block column sashing

twenty-four 2-1/2" x 15" strips for paper piecing the pint glass blocks six 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 2" x 10-1/2" strips for the pint glass blocks

From Fabric E, cut:

three 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: fourteen 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips for the pint glass and mug blocks two 1-1/2" x 9" strips for the curved glass blocks two of Template 2 two of Template 4

From Fabric F, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for paper piecing the pint glass blocks

From Fabric G, cut:

one 9" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 9" x 9" squares for the curved glasses Trim the remainder of the strip to 8-1/2" wide. Then subcut: two 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for paper piecing the pint glass blocks

From Fabric H, cut:


one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for paper piecing the pint glass blocks Trim the remainder of the strip to 7-1/2" wide and subcut: two 7-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles for the mug blocks

From Fabric I, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for paper piecing the pint glass blocks

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.



Assemble the Quilt Center

Step 1: Sew the Fabric B side panel borders to the left and right edges of each Fabric A panel piece. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B top/bottom panel borders to the Fabric A panel pieces. Press toward the borders.

Step 2: Arrange the completed Step 1 units together as indicated in the Quilt Center Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using Fabric C block sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make two block rows.

Step 3: Sew the row sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing. The completed quilt center will measure 29-1/2" x 45-1/2". **Step 4:** Sew the Fabric D side inner borders to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward Fabric D. Sew the Fabric D top/bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward Fabric D.

Assemble the Blocks

Step 5: Using one 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric I rectangle and two 2-1/2" x 15" Fabric D rectangles, paper piece one Template 1 unit. Trim to the outer edge of the template, leaving a 7-1/2" x 9-1/2" unit.

Step 6: Sew one 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric E rectangle to the top edge of the glass. Press toward the center of the block. Sew one 2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the left and right edge of the block. Press away from the center of the block. The completed blocks will measure 10-1/2" x 10-1/2".

Repeat Steps 5-6 to create a total of twelve 10-1/2" square Pint Glass Blocks, from the following fabrics:

> four from Fabric I four from Fabric F two from Fabric G two from Fabric H


Step 7: Sew a 7-1/2" x 1-1/2" Fabric E rectangle to the top edge of a 7-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric H

rectangle. Press. Sew a 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the right edge of the block. Press. Step 8: Place a Fabric E/Template 2 piece,


centered along the length of the Fabric H piece. Pin in place, then sew to the block with your preferred raw edge appliqué stitch, such as a straight stitch or small zigzag.

Repeat to make a second 10-1/2" square Fabric H mug block, this time with the Fabric D rectangle and handle on the left edge.

Step 9: Sew a 1-1/2" x 9" Fabric E rectangle to the top of a 9" Fabric G square. Press. Place the Template 3 copy on top of the unit, aligning the top raw edges. Cut the pieced unit to the shape of the template.

Step 10: Center the unit from Step 9 along the top of a 10-1/2" Fabric D square, aligning the top raw edges. Pin in place, then sew to the block with your preferred raw edge appliqué stitch, such as a straight stitch or small zigzag.

Step 11: Place a Fabric E/Template 4 piece at the bottom of the glass. Pin in place, then sew to the block with your preferred raw edge appliqué stitch, such as a straight stitch or small zigzag.

Repeat to make two 10-1/2" square Fabric G curved glass blocks.

Assemble the Quilt

Step 12: Gather four blocks and five 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D sashing pieces for the left pieced column, referring to the QAD for specific blocks used. Sew together to form a column. Press. Sew to the left edge of the quilt center. Press.

Repeat for the right pieced column, sewing to the right edge.

Step 13: Gather four blocks and three 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D sashing pieces for the top pieced border, referring to the QAD for specific blocks used. Sew together to form a the top pieced row. Press. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center. Press.





Repeat for the bottom pieced row, sewing to the bottom edge.



Step 14: Sew the Fabric D side middle borders to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward Fabric D. Sew the Fabric D top/bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward Fabric D.

Step 15: Sew the Fabric B side outer borders to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward Fabric B. Sew the Fabric B top/bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward Fabric B.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
