Finished quilt measures: $56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From the Roll Up:

Divide the strips into two stacks: Warm (red, purple, pink) and Cool (blue, green)
From the Warm stack, cut a total of:
eighty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
one hundred sixty-six 2 " squares
ten 1-1/2" square for the Block centers
From the Cool stack, cut a total of:
eighty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
one hundred sixty-six 2" squares
ten 1-1/2" square for the Block centers

## From Fabric A, cut:

ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
one hundred sixty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
seventeen 2 " x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-one 2" x 10-1/2" block sashing strips
eighty 2 " squares for the Blocks
Sew the remaining five strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2" x 56-1/2" side inner borders
two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom inner borders
ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighty $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " rectangles for the Blocks

## From Fabric B, cut:

six 5 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 5 " $\times 59-1 / 2$ " side outer borders
two 5" $\times 57$ " top/bottom outer borders
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 2-1/2" Fabric A square with a 2-1/2" Warm square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2" square. Repeat with all 2-1/2" Warm squares to make one hundred sixty Warm HSTs.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 with all 2-1/2" Cool squares to make one hundred sixty Cool HSTs.


Assemble the Blocks


Step 3: Gather:
four 2" Warm squares
four Warm HSTs
one 2" Fabric A square
Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite direction every other row.


Step 5: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block unit. This unit should measure 5 " square.

Repeat to make forty Warm Block Units.


Step 6: Repeat Steps 3-5 with all 2-1/2" Cool squares to make forty Cool Block Units.


Step 7: Gather:
four Cool Block Units
four 1-1/2" $\times 5$ " Fabric A rectangles
one 1-1/2" Warm (or Cool) square

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 8: Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams toward the Fabric A rectangles.


Step 9: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Block should measure 10-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of twenty Blocks.

Repeat Steps 7-9 to make a total of Twenty Warm Blocks


## Assemble the Quilt

Step 10: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five block rows.

Step 11: Gather three cornerstone squares and four sashing strips. Sew each row together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four sashing rows.

Step 12: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 13: Sew the side
 inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
