Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

six 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-five 6-1/2" squares.

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

two 4-1/2" x 69" outer side borders.

two 4-1/2" x 55" outer top/bottom borders.

From each of Fabrics B and C, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips of each fabric. Subcut: one-hundred and forty 2-1/2" squares of each fabric.

From Fabric D, cut:

eleven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

From five strips, subcut seventy-two 2-1/2" squares. Sew six strips together end-to-end, then subcut: two 2-1/2" x 60" inner side borders. two 2-1/2" x 47" inner top/bottom borders.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Nine-Patch Blocks

Step 1: Gather five 2-1/2" Fabric B squares and four 2-1/2" Fabric C squares. Arrange the squares in three rows of three to form a nine-patch as shown. Sew the squares together to form rows, then press the seams towards the Fabric B squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make twenty-four Nine-Patch Blocks.

Assemble the Edge Blocks

Step 3: Gather one 2-1/2" Fabric B square, two 2-1/2" Fabric C squares, and three 2-1/2" Fabric D squares. Arrange the squares in three rows as shown. Sew the squares together to form rows, then press the seams towards the Fabric B and D squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press.




Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make twenty Edge Blocks.

Assemble the Corner Blocks

Step 5: Gather one 2-1/2" Fabric C square and three 2-1/2" Fabric D squares. Arrange the squares in two rows as shown. Sew the squares together to form rows, then press the seams towards the Fabric D squares. Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Press.




Step 6: Repeat Step 5 to make four Corner Blocks.



Step 7: Arrange the 6-1/2" Fabric A squares and blocks into thirteen *diagonal* rows. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram on the next page for block placement.

Step 8: Sew the blocks together to form *diagonal* rows. Press the seams towards the Fabric A squares.

Step 9: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.



Step 10: Measure and trim the edge of the quilt 1/4" past the intersection of the Fabric D squares around the perimeter of the quilt.



Step 11: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 12: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

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
