## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 31" x 40" center panel

### From Fabric B, cut:

four 2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 40" side inner borders

two 1-1/2" x 33" top/bottom inner borders

two 1-1/2" x 48" side outer borders

two 1-1/2" x 41" top/bottom outer borders

**From Fabric C, cut:**

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 3-1/2" x 18" rectangles

two 3-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles

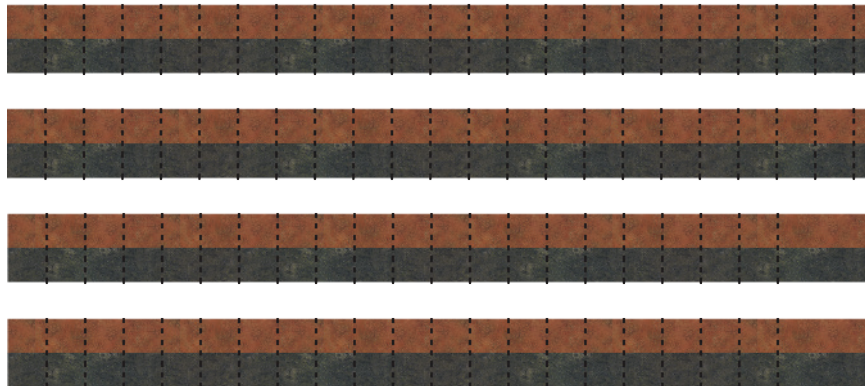
four 2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Strip Set Units

**Step 1:** Sew a 2" Fabric B strip to a 2" Fabric C strip. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a total of four strip sets. Subcut the strip sets into a total of eighty-two 2" x 3-1/2".



**Step 2:** Sew thirteen Step 1 units together, orienting the units as shown, nesting the seams and pressing the row seams to one side. Sew a 3-1/2" x 16-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to one end, as shown. Repeat to make a second unit like this.



**Step 3:** Sew eighteen Step 1 units together, orienting the units as shown, nesting the seams and pressing the row seams to one side. Sew a 3-1/2" x 18" Fabric C rectangle to one end, as shown. Repeat to make a second unit like this.





## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 4:** Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 5:** Sew a Step 2 unit to the top of the quilt, starting at the left edge and stopping the stitching about 3" before the right edge of the quilt center.

**Step 6:** Sew a Step 3 unit to the right edge of the quilt, starting at the top edge and stopping the stitching about 3" before the bottom edge of the quilt center. Press. Return to the top border and complete the seam you started in Step 5. Press.

**Step 7:** Sew a Step 2 unit to the bottom edge of the quilt, starting at the right edge of the quilt center and stopping the stitching about 3" before the left edge of the quilt center. Press. Return to the right border and complete the seam you started in Step 6. Press.

**Step 8:** Sew a Step 3 unit to the left edge of the quilt, starting at the bottom edge and stitching all the way to the top of the Step 5 border. Press. Return to the bottom border and complete the seam you started in Step 7. Press.

**Step 9:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
