Bump Thump Quilt

Quilt approximate size 75" x 88"

All border strip length measurements are approximate. Please measure your quilt top before cutting the length of each border.

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions

* The fabric pieces with an asterisk in front of the them need to have fusible web on the back of them before cutting. Follow the manufacturer's instructions on the fusible web to press the fusible to the back of these fabrics before cutting these pieces.

Fabric A- 1 Panel of ADE10798-203	• Fussy cut ten panels no larger than 8-1/2" x 10-1/2", crop as needed.
Fabric B- 2-1/8 yards of ADE10792-3	Cut eight 8-3/4" x 11-1/2" pieces with the strips running vertical.
	• Cut eight 2-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make
	two 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" strips and two 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" strips. for the inner border.
	Cut eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
Fabric C- 1 yard of ADE10792-70	 Cut seven 8-3/4" x 11-1/2" pieces with the strips running vertical.
Fabric D- 2/3 yard of ADE10797-203	• *Cut five 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces.
Fabric E- 1/4 yard of ADE10795-203	•*Cut eight 4-1/2" squares.
Fabric F- 1/4 yard of ADE10793-3	•*Cut eight 4-1/2" squares.
Fabric G- 3/4 yard of ADE10791-81	Cut fifteen 6-1/2" squares.
Fabric H- 3/4 yard of K001-1308	Cut fifteen 6-1/2" squares.
Fabric I- 1/4 yard of ADE-10796-3	•*Cut seven 4-1/2" squares.
Fabric J- 1/4 yard of ADE10794-203	•*Cut seven 4-1/2" squares.
Fabric K-2-3/4 yards of K001-140	• Cut thirty-five 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips.
	• Cut sixty 2" x 11-1/2" strips.
	 Cut nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make six 2-1/2" x
	59-1/2" strips.
Fabric L- 1-5/8 yards of ADE10796-203	Cut eight 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two
	6-1/2" x 76-1/2" strips and two 6-1/2" x 75-1/2" strips for the outer border.
Backing- 5-1/2 yards of Your Choice	• Cut two 96" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make one 86" x 96" back.

Quilt Assembly Instructions:

Fusible Web- 4 yards

- 1) Sew one 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of one 8-3/4" x 11-1/2" Fabric B strip. Sew one 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric B strip. Refer to figure 1 and cut the block on an angle tipping to the left to make one 9-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric B rectangle. Repeat to make eight Fabric B backgrounds.
- 2) Sew one 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of one 8-3/4" x 11-1/2" Fabric C strip. Sew one 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric C strip. Refer to figure 1 and cut the block on an angle tipping to the right to make one 9-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric C rectangle (fig. 2). Repeat to make seven Fabric C backgrounds.
- 3) Refer to the quilt photo for placement and press the ten Fabric A panels and five 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric D rectangles to the Fabric B and C backgrounds (Fig. 3). Stitch around each panel with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
- 4) Refer to the quilt photo to press eight 4-1/2" Fabric E squares onto eight 6-1/2" Fabric H squares. Press seven 4-1/2" Fabric J squares onto seven 6-1/2" Fabric H squares. Press eight 4-1/2" Fabric F squares onto eight 6-1/2" Fabric G squares. Press seven 4-1/2" Fabric I squares onto seven 6-1/2" Fabric G squares. Stitch around each panel with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
- 5) Refer to the quilt photo and sew together one Fabric H square from Step 4 to one Fabric I square to make one 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" block. Repeat to make fifteen 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" blocks.
- 6) Refer to the quilt photo for block placement and sew together three panel blocks, three 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" blocks and seven 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric K strips to make one row. Repeat to make five pieced rows.
- 7) Starting with one 2-1/2" x 59-1/2" Fabric K strip, sew together the six 2-1/2" x 59-1/2" Fabric K strips and five pieced rows, alternating them to make the quilt top.
- 8) Sew one 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 63-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 9) Sew one 6-1/2" x 76-1/2" Fabric L strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 6-1/2" x 75-1/2" Fabric L to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 10) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.





