Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From the Fat Quarters, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two-four 5-1/2" squares of each fabric. A total of thirty-six squares are needed.

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two-four 3-1/2" squares of each fabric. A total of seventy-two squares are needed.

Note: Cut the squares in matching sets of four.

From Fabric A, cut:

seven 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.

nine 5-1/2" squares.

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-two 3-1/2" squares.

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

six 2-1/2" x 55-1/2" sashing strips.

thirteen 2" x WOF strips.

one-hundred and forty-four 2" squares

Sew the remaining strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

two 2" x 67-1/2" side inner borders.

two 2" x 58-1/2" top/bottom inner borders.

From Fabric B, cut:

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" side middle borders.

two 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" top/bottom middle borders.

From Fabric C, cut:

four 5-1/2" x LOE strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

two 5-1/2" x 72-1/2" side outer borders.

eight 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:

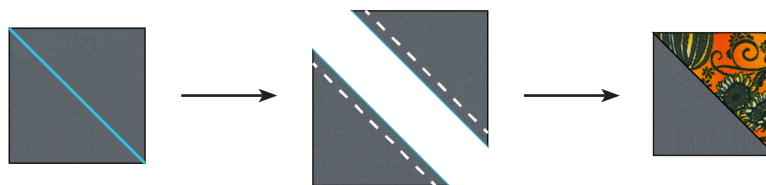
two 5-1/2" x 70-1/2" top/bottom outer borders.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

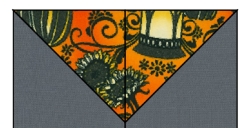
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Flying Geese

Step 1: Pair a 3-1/2" Fabric A square with a 3-1/2" square cut from a fat quarter, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3" square. Repeat to make one-hundred and forty-four HSTs. As you make the HSTs, be sure to make them in matching sets of four.



Step 2: Gather two matching HSTs. Sew them together as shown, then press the seam open or to one side. Make seventy-two flying geese. As you make the flying geese, be sure to make them in matching pairs.



Assemble the Stitch-and-Flip Units

Step 3: Gather one 5-1/2" square cut from a fat quarter and four 2" Fabric A squares. Place the Fabric A squares on each corner of the 5-1/2" square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on each smaller square. Sew on the marked lines, then trim the excess fabric 1/4" away from the sewn seams. Press towards the corners. Repeat to make thirty-six units.



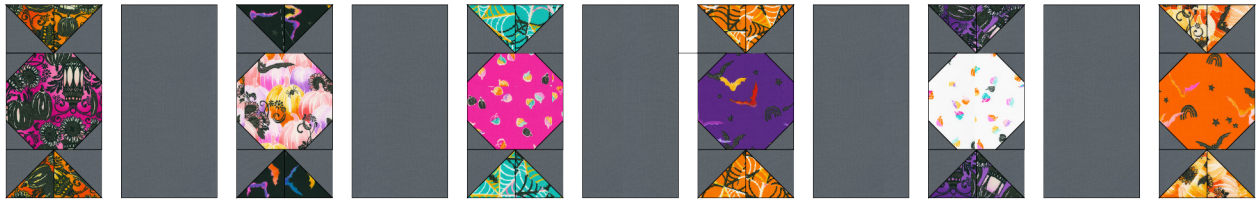
Assemble the Blocks

Step 4: Gather two matching flying geese made in Step 2 and one Stitch-and-Flip Unit made in Step 3. Sew the two flying geese to the top and bottom of the Stitch-and-Flip Unit, then press the seams towards the center of the block. Make thirty-six blocks.



Assemble the Rows

Step 5: Gather six blocks made in Step 4 and five 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangles. Alternate between blocks and rectangles to form a row. Sew the blocks and rectangles together, then press the seams towards the rectangles. Make four vertical candy rows.



Step 6: Gather four blocks made in Step 4 and three 5-1/2" Fabric A squares. Alternate between blocks and squares to form a row. Sew the blocks and squares together, then press the seams towards the squares. Make three horizontal candy rows.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 7: Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram to layout the quilt center. Alternate between vertical candy rows and horizontal candy rows to arrange the quilt center. Place a 2-1/2" x 55-1/2" sashing strips between the rows.

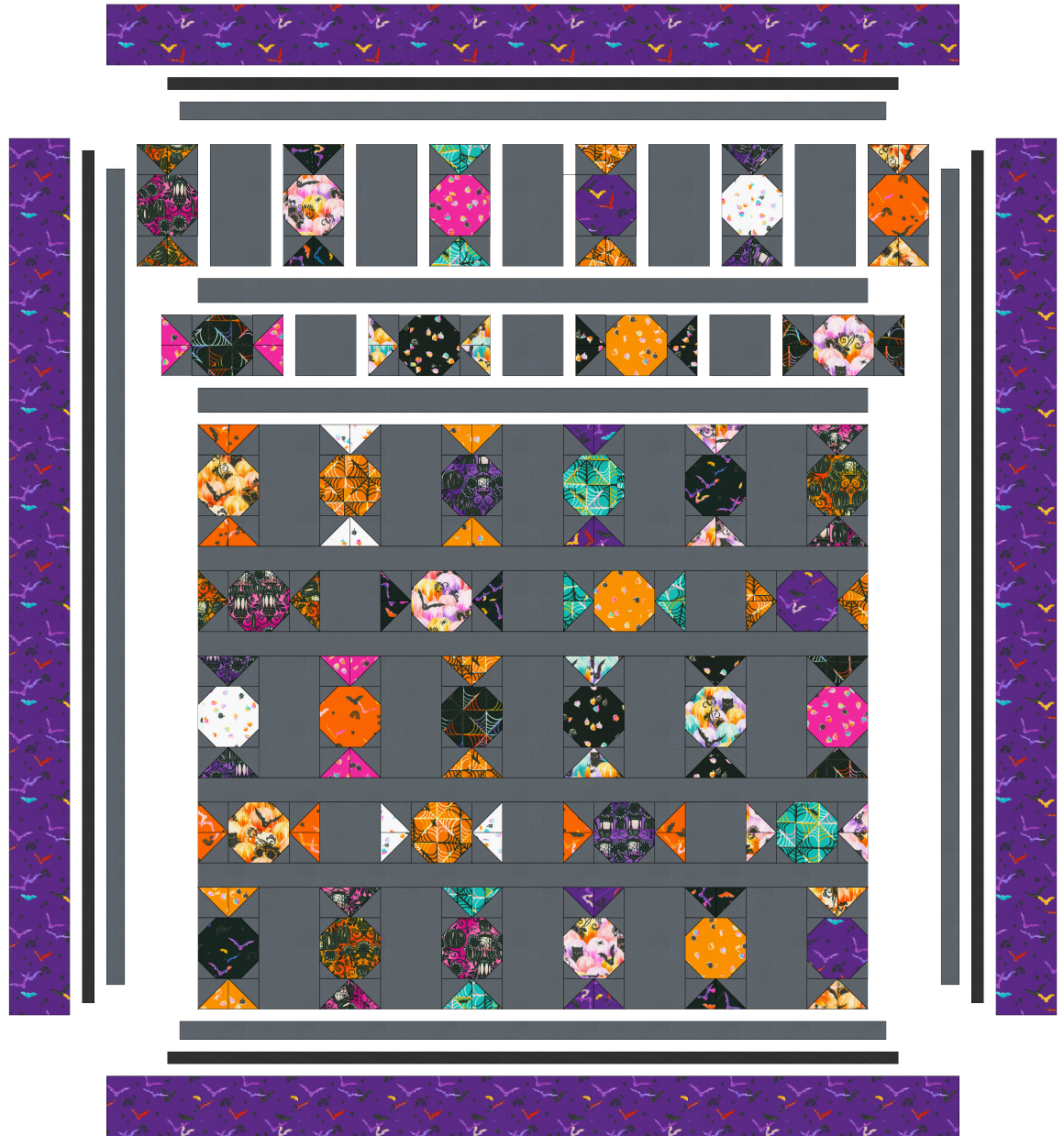
Step 8: Sew the rows and sashing strips together to form the quilt center. Press the seams towards the sashing strips.

Step 9: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 11: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!



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
