## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

four 14" x WOF strips. Subcut:
ten 14" squares
fourteen 2" x 14 " rectangles for the Bear Paw Block borders
five $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
eighty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
seventeen 2 " x WOF strips. Subcut:
six 2" x 14 " rectangles for the Bear Paw Block borders
twenty 2" x 11 " rectangles for the Bear Paw Block borders
forty 2" x 5" rectangles for the Bear Paw Blocks
forty 2 " squares for the Bear Paw Blocks
six sets of Templates 14-21
one each of Templates 74, 81, 101, 114, 115 and 116
From Fabric B, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$ strip
three of Template 11
three of Template 12
From Fabric C, cut:
two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
one 4-1/2" $\times 68^{\prime \prime}$ strip
three of Template 23
three of Template 25
three of Template 27
four of Template 29-37

## From Fabric D, cut:

one 14" x WOF strip. Subcut:
three 14" squares
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
four 2 " x WOF strips. Subcut:
four 2" x 14 " rectangles for the Bear Paw Block borders
four 2" $\times 11$ " rectangles for the Bear Paw Block borders
eight 2" $\times 5$ " rectangles for the Bear Paw Blocks
eight 2" squares for the Bear Paw Blocks

## From Fabric E, cut:

eight 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2" $\times 84$ " side inner borders
two 2 " $\times 71$ " top/bottom inner borders
one of Template 73, 78, 79, 92, 93, and 110-113
four of Template 2

## From Fabric F , cut:

eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" $\times 87^{\prime \prime}$ side outer borders
two 4-1/2" x 71 " top/bottom outer borders

## From Fabric G, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: twelve 3-1/2" squares
two 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twenty-four 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
Trim the remainder of the second strip to 2 " wide, then subcut: two 2" squares

## From Fabric H, cut:

four of Template 1
three of Template 24
three of Template 26
three of Template 28
one of Template 117
From Fabric I, cut:
two 2" squares
three of Template 12
seven each of Templates 3-10
one of Template $49,50,56,57,64,65,72,76,77$
From Fabric J, cut:
one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 4-1/2" squares
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 3-1/2" squares
Trim the remainder of the strip to 2 " wide, then subcut:
two 2" squares
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From Fabric K, cut:
Three of Template 1 and 22

## From Fabric L, cut:

two 2" squares
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: eight 3-1/2" squares
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
three of Template 2
four of Templates 44-46
six of Template 13
one of Template 70
one of Template 99

## From Fabric $M$, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: twelve 3-1/2" squares
two 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twenty-four 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
Trim the remainder of the second strip to 2 " wide, then subcut: two 2" squares
four of Templates 11, 41-43
three of Template 22
one of Template 98 and 118

## From Fabric N , cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 3-1/2" squares
Trim the remainder of the second strip to 2 " wide, then subcut:
two 2" squares
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
four of Templates 38-40
one of Template 97

From Fabric O, cut:
one of Templates 47, 54, 61, 69, 80, 100

From Fabric P, cut:
one of Templates 48, 51-53, 55, 58-60, 62, 63, 66-68, 71, 75, 82-91, 99-102
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Step 1: Copy all templates at $100 \%$.
Step 2: On the fusible web, trace the indicated number of each Template, as instructed on the Template sheets. Be sure to note the quantity. Tip: In addition to the piece number, include the fabric letter shown on the Template. This will help you to ensure you are fusing it to the correct fabric.

Step 3: Cut out each traced shape, leaving $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ of excess fusible web outside the marked lines. You will NOT cut on the marked/traced lines at this point.

Step 4: Follow in the steps below to fuse each piece to the appropriate fabric. Fuse, following the manufacturer's instructions, then cut out each shape on the marked line.

## Assemble the Bear Paw Blocks

Step 1: Pair a 2-1/2" Fabric A square with a 2-1/2" Fabric G square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2" square. Repeat to make thirty-two A/G HSTs.
Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:


Step 3: Gather:
four A/G HSTs
one 2" Fabric A square
one 3-1/2" Fabric G square
Arrange as shown, noting the orientation of the HSTs. Sew the HSTs together as shown to form pairs. Press.


Sew the units together to form two rows. Press away from the HST pairs. Sew the rows together to form the larger unit. Press. The larger unit should measure 5" square.

Repeat to make four larger units.


Step 4: Gather:
four large units from Step 3
four 2" $\times 5$ " Fabric A rectangles
one 2" Fabric $N$ square
Arrange as shown in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew the units together in three rows of three. Press the seams away from the Fabric A rectangles. Sew the rows together to form the block center. Press.

Step 5: Sew a 2 " $\times 11$ " Fabric A strip to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press. Sew a $2 " \times 14$ " Fabric A strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press.
The Bear Paw Block should measure 14" square. Repeat to make:

one Bear Paw Block from Fabrics D/M
two Bear Paw Blocks from Fabrics A/L
two Bear Paw Blocks from Fabrics A/J

two Bear Paw Blocks from Fabrics $A / M$

one Bear Paw Block from Fabrics D/G

Step 6: Using the Appliqué Placement diagram as a guide, place the assorted Template pieces in the pairings indicated. Pin in place. One piece at a time, peel the paper backing from the lower layer Template pieces and fuse to the 14" Fabric A squares. Continue by peeling the backing to the upper layer Template pieces and fusing to the Blocks as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Edge stitch the templates to the block.


Repeat to make nine Flower Blocks in a Fabric A base and three Flower Blocks on a Fabric D base.

## Assemble the Squirrel Panel

Step 7: Sew the 68" long Fabric A, B and C strips together. Press.
Using the same process as described in Step 6, arrange, pin, press and stitch each Template piece in place.



Step 8: Arrange the blocks into four rows of five blocks to form the upper section of the Quilt Center. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 9: Arrange the blocks into one row of five blocks to form the lower section of the Quilt Center. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 10: Sew the lower section to the Squirrel Panel, then sew the upper section to the unit to form the quilt center. Press.

Step 11: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders

Step 12: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
