

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 20-1/2" x 40-1/2" center panel

From Fabric B, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" top/bottom panel borders

Sew three strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 46-1/2" top/bottom panel borders

two 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From each of Fabrics C and D, cut:

two 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

fourteen 4" squares

From each of Fabrics E and F, cut:

two 4-3/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

fourteen 4-3/8" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal.

Trim the remainder of the second strip to 3-1/2" wide, then subcut:

one 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle

From Fabric G, cut:

eleven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 58-1/2" side Border 1 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" side Border 3 pieces

From Fabric H, cut:

six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces

two 5-1/2" x 68-1/2" side Border 2 pieces

From Fabric I, cut:

seven 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5-1/2" x 60-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 pieces

two 5-1/2" x 82-1/2" side Border 4 pieces

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

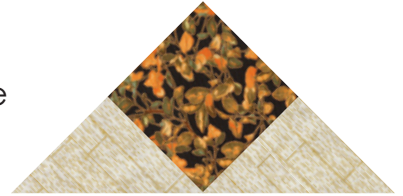
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Quilt Center

Step 1: Sew the Fabric B top and bottom panel borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B side panel borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Note: For Steps 2-4, sew with a seam allowance just under 1/4" in order for the block to end up at the correct size. If you use a seam allowance of 1/4" or larger, the block will be just barely too small.

Step 2: Sew a Fabric F triangle to two adjacent sides of a Fabric C square. Press toward the triangle. Repeat to make fourteen units like this.



Step 3: Sew a Fabric E triangle to two adjacent sides of a Fabric D square. Press toward the square. Repeat to make fourteen units like this.

Step 4: Arrange two completed Step 2 units and two completed Step 3 units together to form a block. Sew together in two halves, pressing the seams in opposite directions. Then sew together, nesting the seams and pressing open. Repeat to make a total of seven blocks, each 10-1/2" square.



Step 5: Sew together, in order: one Fabric E rectangle + two Step 4 blocks + one Fabric B rectangle. Press. Sew to the top of the quilt center. Note the orientation of the Step 4 blocks.



Step 6: Sew together, in order: one Fabric F rectangle + four Step 4 blocks + one Fabric B rectangle + one Step 4 block. Press. Sew to the right edge of the quilt center. Note the orientation of the Step 4 blocks.



Add the Quilt Borders



Step 7: Sew the Fabric G top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric G side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the Fabric H top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric H side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the Fabric G top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric G side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the Fabric I top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric I side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
