## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42 " wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one $23^{\prime \prime} \times 43^{\prime \prime}$ center panel

## From Fabric B, cut:

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 5" squares for the HSTs
thirteen $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew nine strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2-1/2" $\times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 2 strips
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 44-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 2 strips
two 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips
two 2-1/2" $\times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 3 strips
From the remainder of the strips, cut:
thirty-eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

## From Fabric C, cut:

four 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Sew four strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 1-1/4" $\times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 1 strips
two $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 1 strips

## From Fabric D, cut:

six 4-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 4-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 4 strips
two 4-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 4 strips

## From the Charm Pack:

set aside two squares for the HSTs
From the remaining charm squares, cut:
thirty-eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, referring to the cover image for exact fabric uses and placements

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 5" Fabric B square with a 5" Charm square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $4-1 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make a total of four HSTs


Step 2: Gather:
seven 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles
seven $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, in the fabrics shown in the diagram for the top border
Sew together, as shown, following the fabric placement shown in the diagram. Press the seams to one side or toward the darker fabric.

Step 3: Sew one HST to each end, noting the orientation in the diagram. Press. This is the top Pieced Border. Repeat to make the bottom Pieced Border.


Step 4: Gather:
twelve 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangles
twelve $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, in the fabrics shown in the diagram for the side border

Sew together, as shown, following the fabric placement shown in the diagram. Press the seams to one side or toward the darker fabric. This is the left Pieced Border. Repeat to make the right Pieced Border.



Step 5: Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 6: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the side Pieced Border pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Pieced Border pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
