Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric the Charm Square Packs, cut:

one hundred fifty-two 2-1/2" x 5" rectangles

sixteen 2-1/2" x 2-1/4" rectangles

Tip: Cut each Charm Square into four 2-1/2" x 5" rectangles (for a total of one hundred sixtyeight rectangles). From these rectangles, select sixteen different prints and from these, cut the sixteen smaller rectangles and set aside the remainder from these cuts.

From Fabric A, cut:

thirty-five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew twenty-five strips together, end-to-end, then trim: seventeen 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" column sashing strips two 1-1/2" x 49-1/2" top/bottom inner borders From the ten remaining strips, cut: one hundred fifty-two 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" block sashing strips

From Fabric B, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 4-1/2" x 57-1/2" top/bottom outer borders two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" side outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Rows

Step 1: Gather: ten 2-1/2" x 5" assorted print rectangles from the Charm Pack nine 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric A block sashing rectangles

Arrange the units into one column, alternating between print rectangles and sashing pieces, beginning and ending the column with print rectangles.

Step 2: Sew the units together to form the column. Press the seams toward the print rectangles.

Repeat to make a total of eight A Rows.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 5: Arrange the A and B Rows together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using column sashing strips between each column and at the left and right edge of the quilt. Press seams toward the sashing.

Step 6: Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!



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
