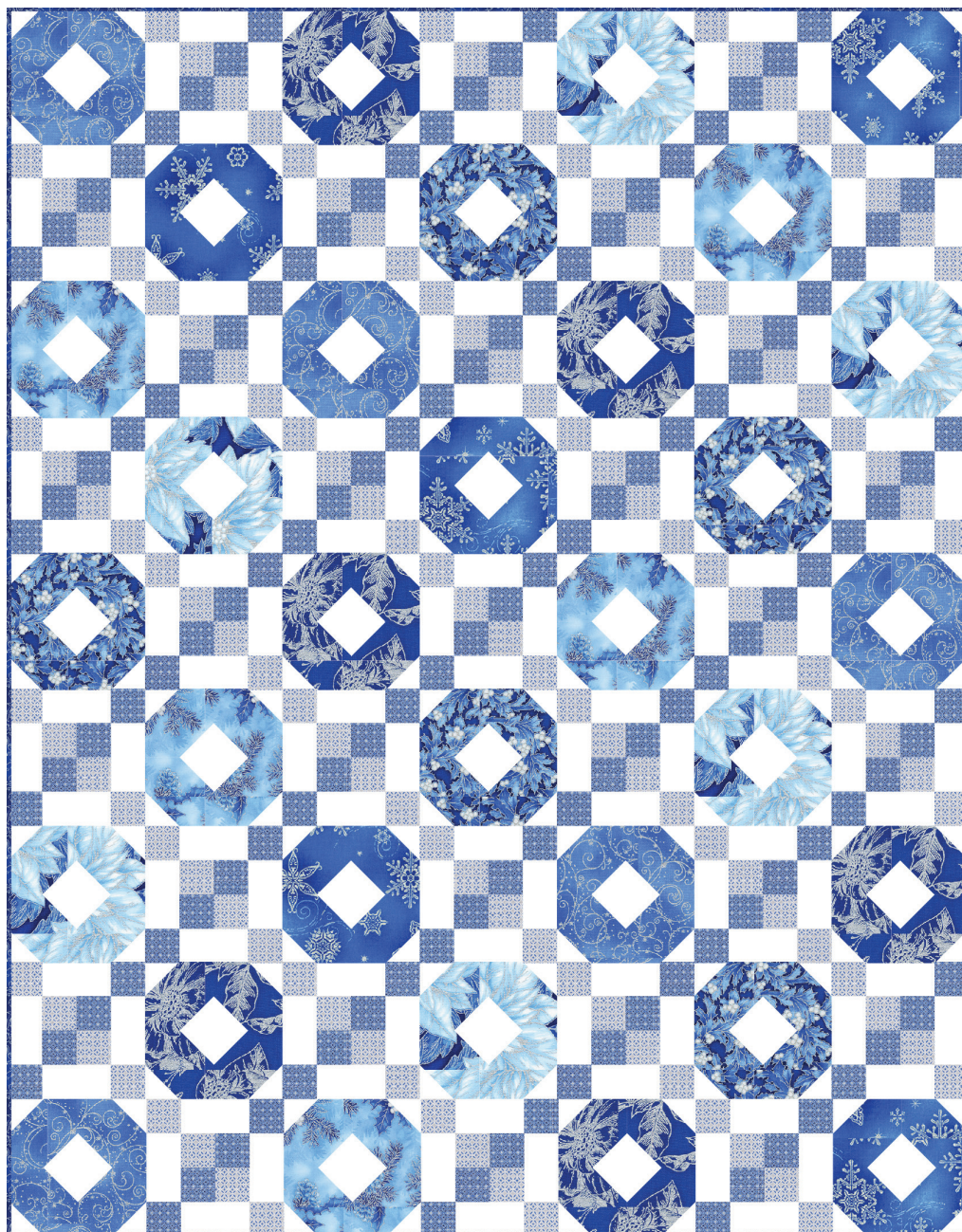

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

eight 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside four for strip piecing. From the remainder, subcut:
sixty-two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
sixteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two hundred fifty-six 2-1/2" squares. Mark a diagonal on the back of each square.

From each of Fabrics B and E-G, cut:

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 4-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics C and D, cut:

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-four 4-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics H and I, cut:

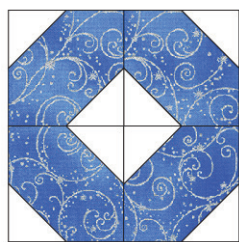
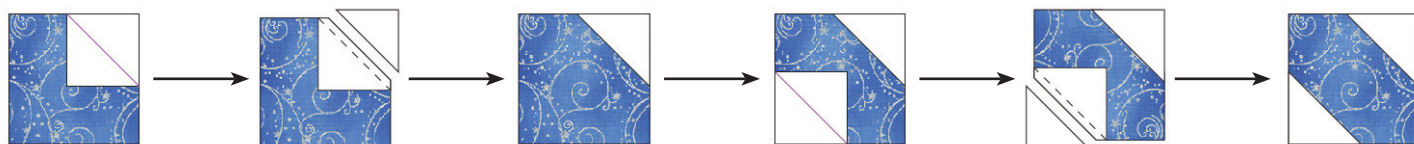
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for strip piecing.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks

Step 1: Place a 2-1/2" Fabric A square in the upper right corner of a Fabric B square, right sides together. Note the orientation of the marked diagonal line. Sew on the marked line, then trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Repeat on the lower left corner with another 2-1/2" Fabric A square. The resulting unit should measure 4-1/2" square. Repeat with all Fabric B squares.



Step 2: Gather:

four Fabric B units from Step 1

Arrange the units into two rows of two. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

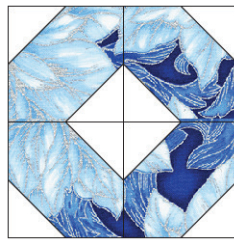
Step 3: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions.

Step 4: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block. The resulting A Block should measure 8-1/2" square. Repeat to make five A Blocks from Fabric B.

Step 5: Repeat Steps 1-4 to make:



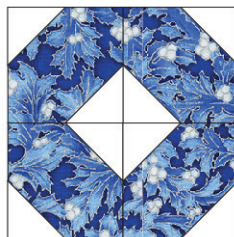
six A Blocks from Fabric C



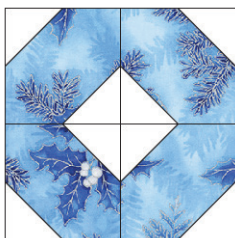
six A Blocks from Fabric D

five A Blocks from Fabric F

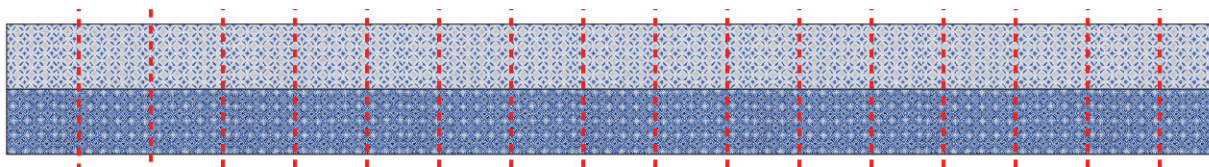


five A Blocks from Fabric G

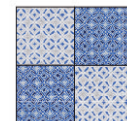
Assemble the B Blocks

Step 6: Sew one Fabric H and one Fabric I strip together, along one long edge. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a total of four strip sets.

Subcut the strip set into a total of sixty-two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" units.

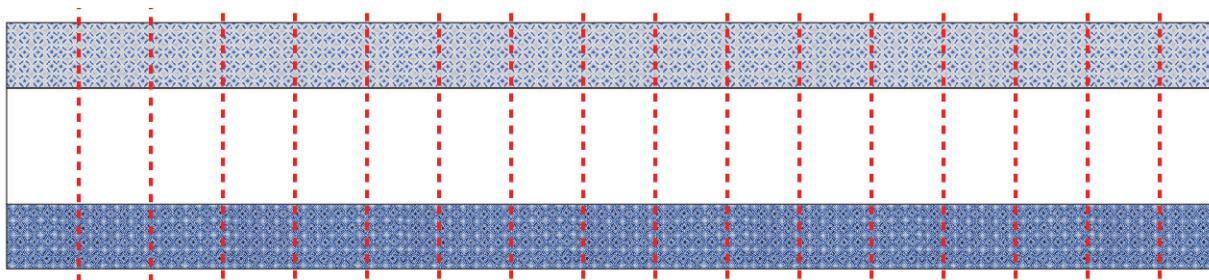


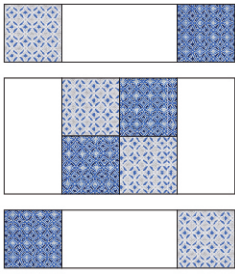
Sew two units together as shown, nesting the seams and pressing the seam to one side to form a 4-1/2" square Four-Patch.



Step 7: Sew one Fabric H and one Fabric I strip to either long edge of a 4-1/2" Fabric A strip. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make a total of four strip sets.

Subcut the strip set into a total of sixty-two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" units.





Step 8: Gather:

one completed Step 6 unit

two completed Step 7 units

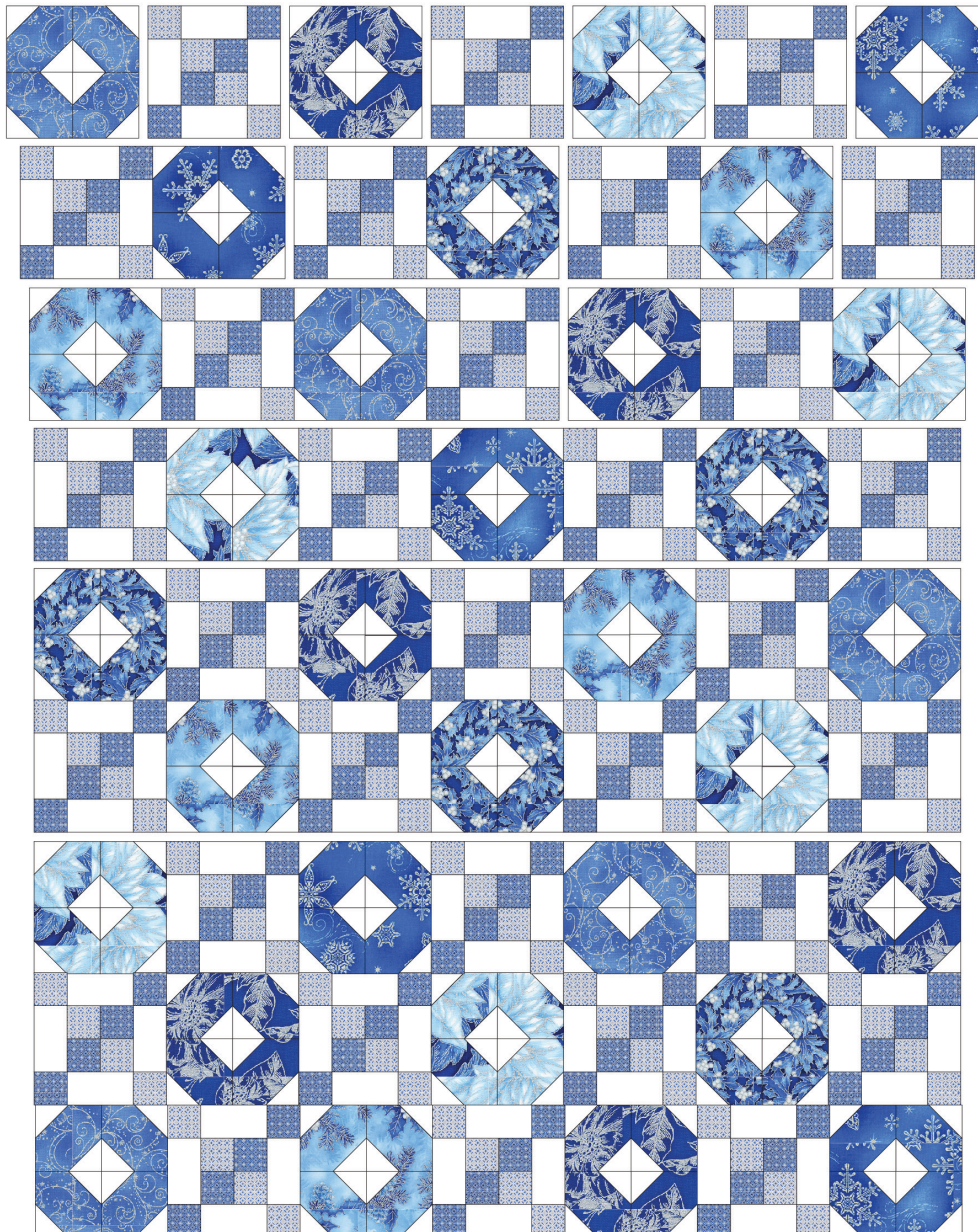
two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangles

Arrange the units into three rows. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 9: Sew the units together to form the rows. In the middle row, press the seams toward the Four-Patch.

Step 10: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block. The resulting B Block should measure 8-1/2" square. Repeat to make thirty-one B Blocks.

Assemble the Quilt



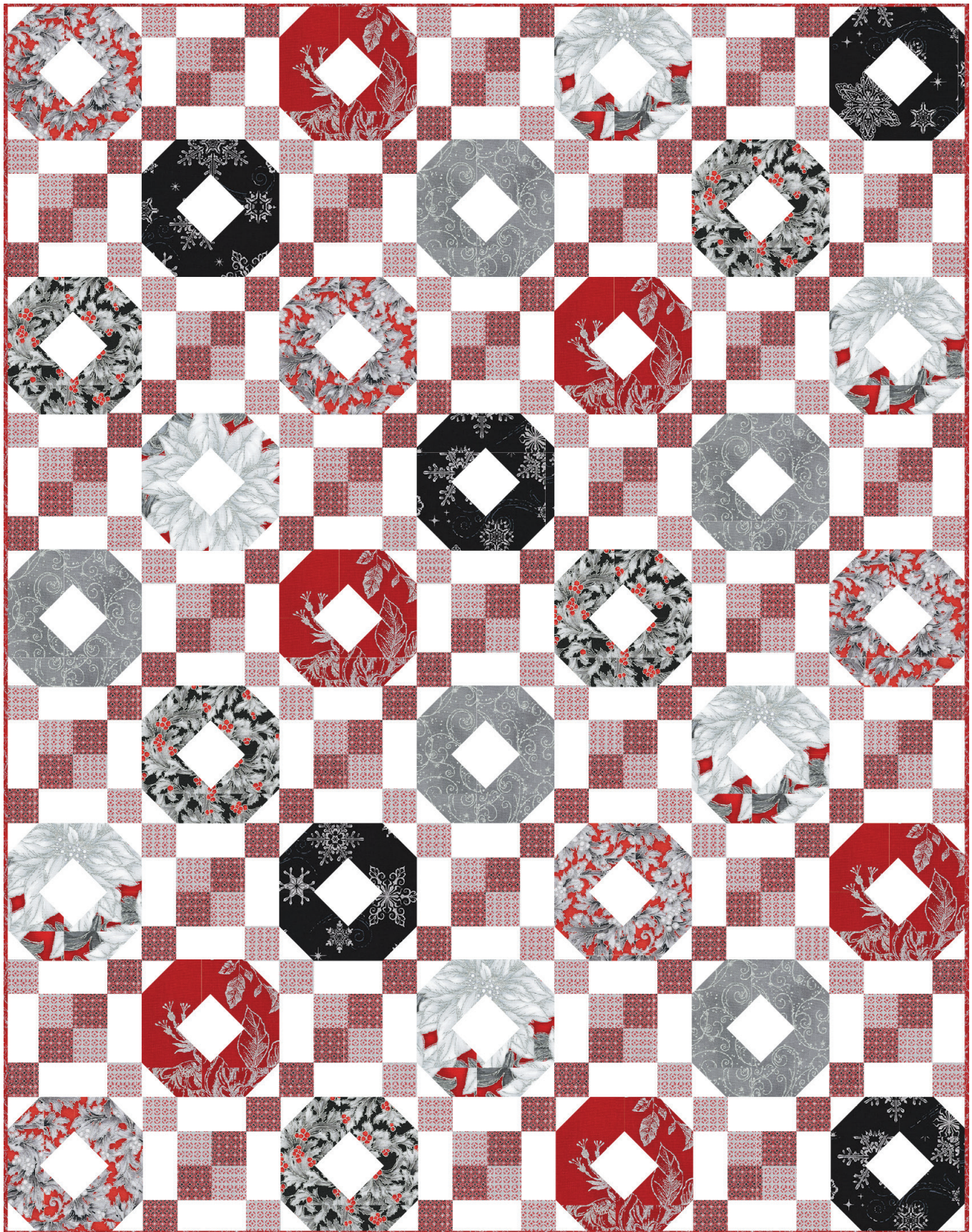
Step 11: Arrange the blocks into nine rows of seven blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 12: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 13: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!






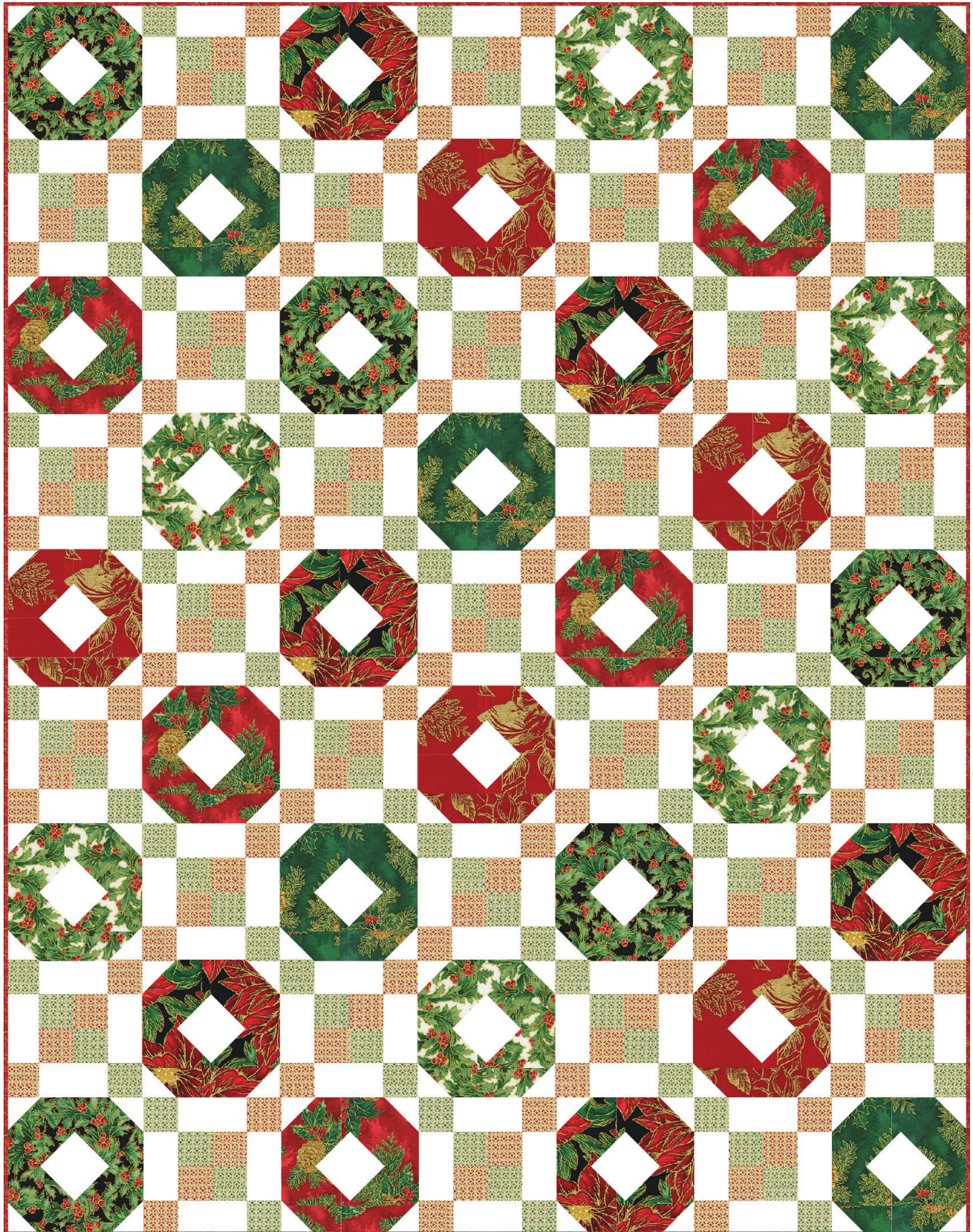
