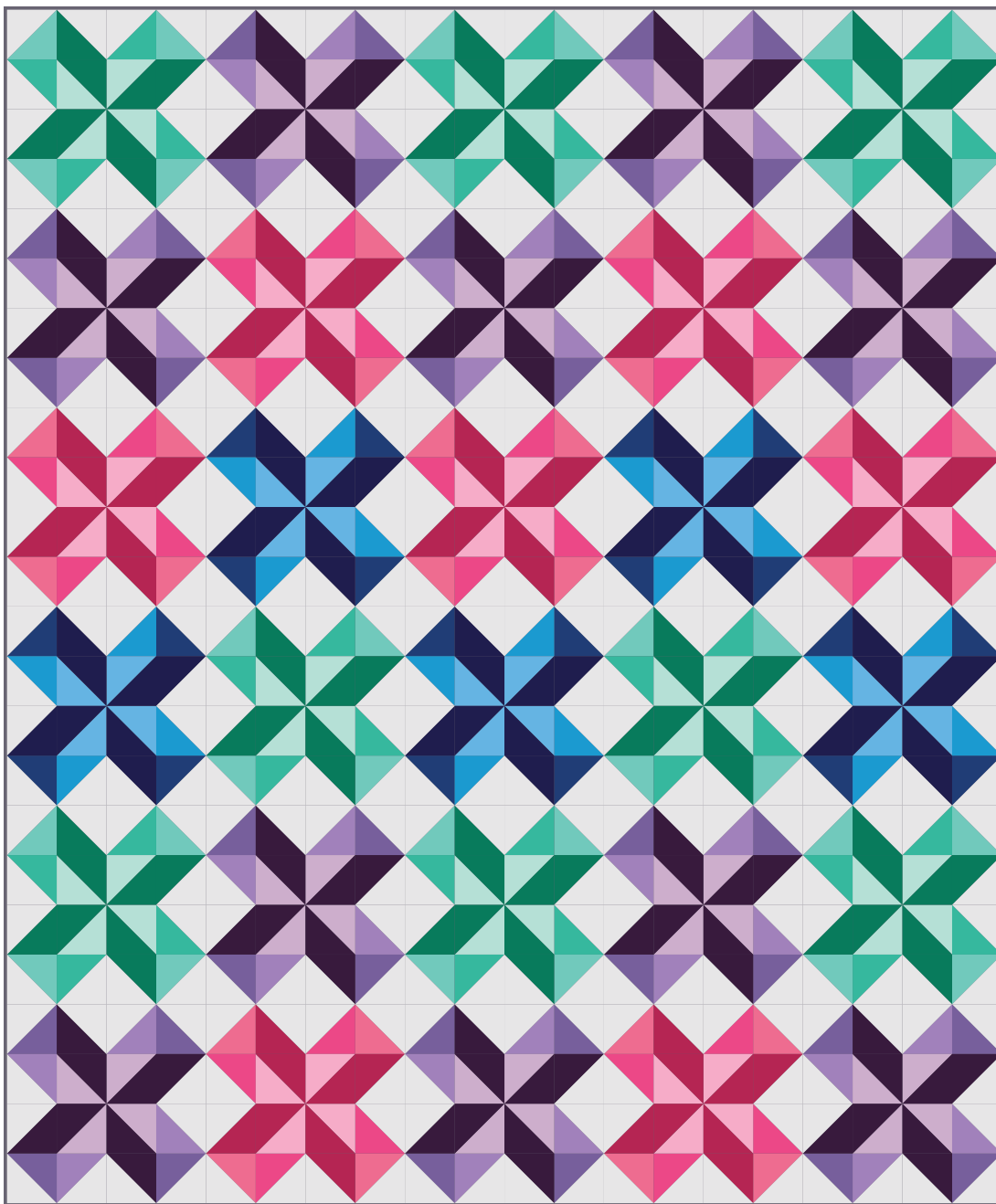

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
thirty-two 4-1/2" squares for the A Blocks

### **From each of Fabrics B-D, cut:**

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
sixteen 4-1/2" squares for the A Blocks

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

five 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
forty 4-1/2" squares for the B Blocks

### **From each of Fabrics F-H, cut:**

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty 4-1/2" squares for the B Blocks

### **From Fabric I, cut:**

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty-eight 4-1/2" squares for the C Blocks

### **From each of Fabrics J-L, cut:**

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
fourteen 4-1/2" squares for the C Blocks

### **From Fabric M, cut:**

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
twenty 4-1/2" squares for the D Blocks

### **From each of Fabrics N-P, cut:**

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
ten 4-1/2" squares for the D Blocks

### **From Fabric Q, cut:**

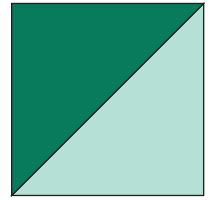
twenty 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
one hundred eighty 4-1/2" squares for the A-D Blocks

### **From Fabric R, cut:**

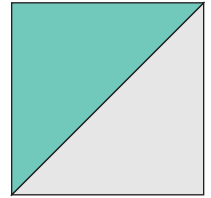
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

## Assemble the A Blocks

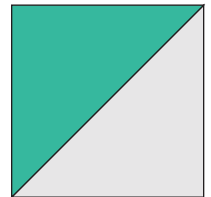
**Step 1:** Pair a Fabric A square with a Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4" square. Repeat to make thirty-two A/B HSTs.



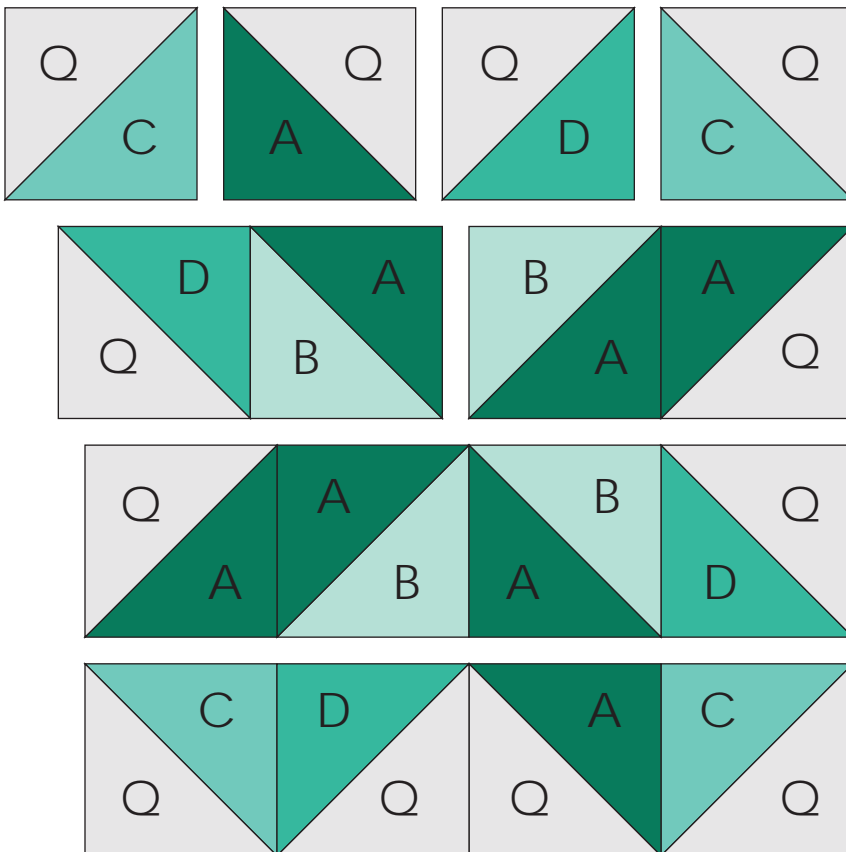
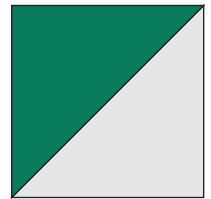
**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 with Fabric C and Q squares to make thirty-two C/Q HSTs.



**Step 3:** Repeat Step 1 with Fabric D and Q squares to make thirty-two D/Q HSTs.



**Step 4:** Repeat Step 1 with Fabric A and Q squares to make thirty-two A/Q HSTs.



**Step 5:** Arrange the HSTs into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

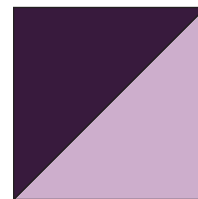
**Step 6:** Sew the units together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 7:** Sew the rows together to form the block. Press the row seams open.

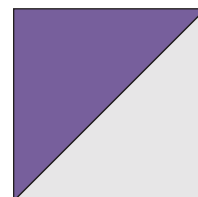
Repeat to make eight A Blocks.

## Assemble the B Blocks

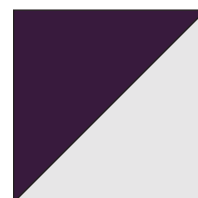
**Step 8:** Pair a Fabric E square with a Fabric F square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4" square. Repeat to make forty E/F HSTs.



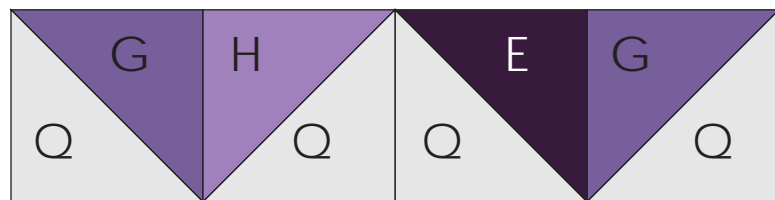
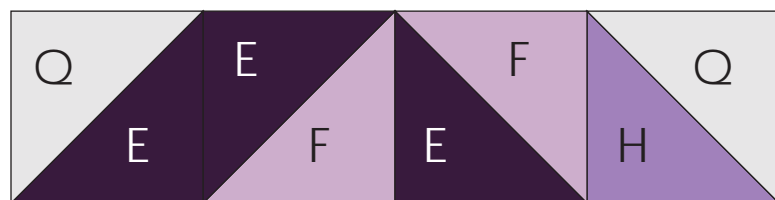
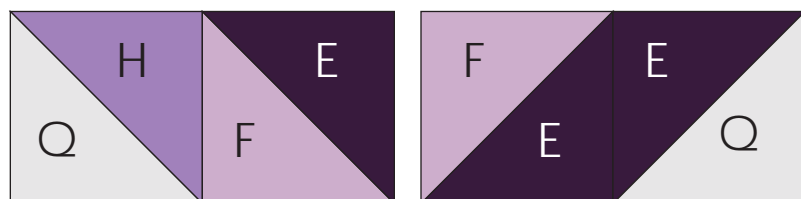
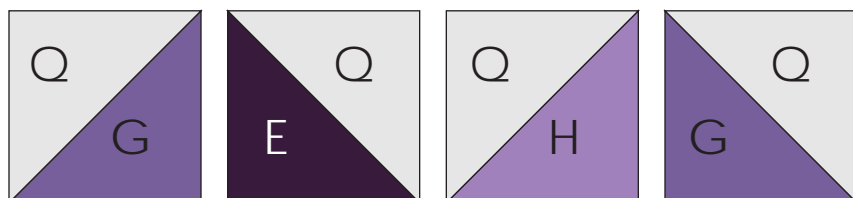
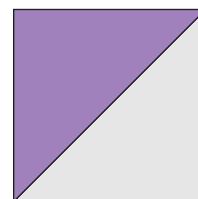
**Step 9:** Repeat Step 8 with Fabric G and Q squares to make thirty-two G/Q HSTs.



**Step 10:** Repeat Step 8 with Fabric E and Q squares to make thirty-two E/Q HSTs.



**Step 11:** Repeat Step 8 with Fabric H and Q squares to make thirty-two H/Q HSTs.



**Step 12:** Arrange the HSTs into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

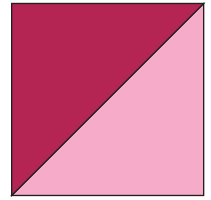
**Step 13:** Sew the units together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 14:** Sew the rows together to form the block. Press the row seams open.

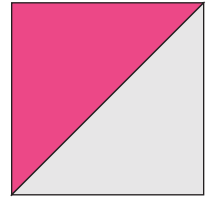
Repeat to make ten B Blocks.

## Assemble the C Blocks

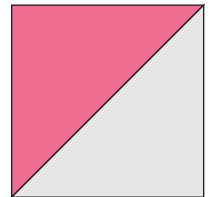
**Step 15:** Pair a Fabric I square with a Fabric J square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4" square. Repeat to make twenty-eight I/J HSTs.



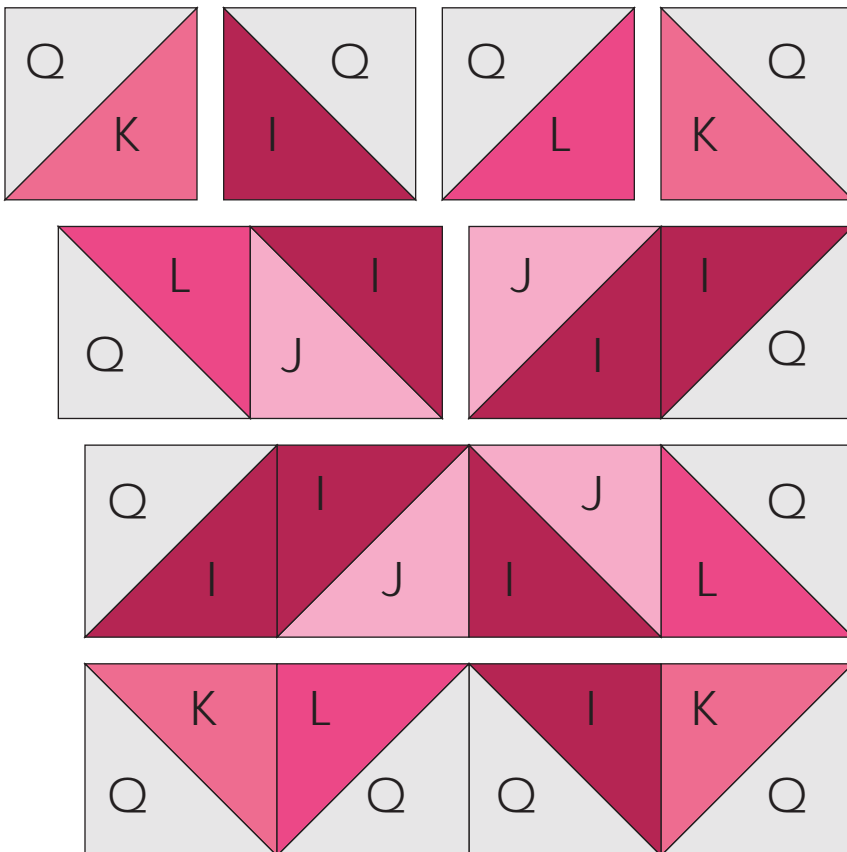
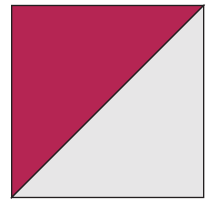
**Step 16:** Repeat Step 15 with Fabric L and Q squares to make twenty-eight L/Q HSTs.



**Step 17:** Repeat Step 15 with Fabric K and Q squares to make twenty-eight K/Q HSTs.



**Step 18:** Repeat Step 15 with Fabric I and Q squares to make twenty-eight I/Q HSTs.



**Step 19:** Arrange the HSTs into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

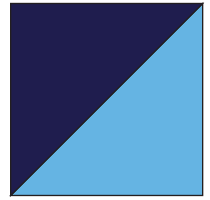
**Step 20:** Sew the units together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 21:** Sew the rows together to form the block. Press the row seams open.

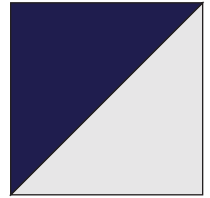
Repeat to make seven C Blocks.

## Assemble the D Blocks

**Step 22:** Pair a Fabric M square with a Fabric N square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4" square. Repeat to make twenty M/N HSTs.



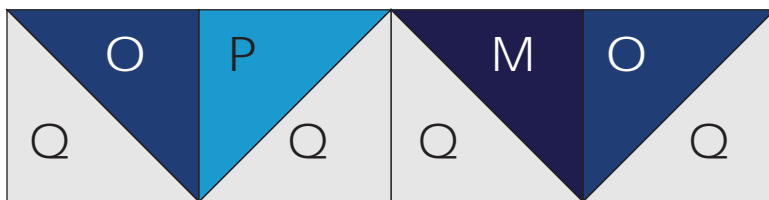
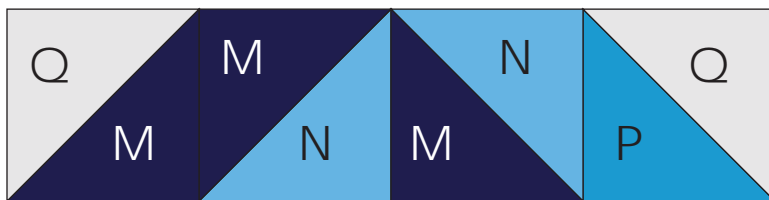
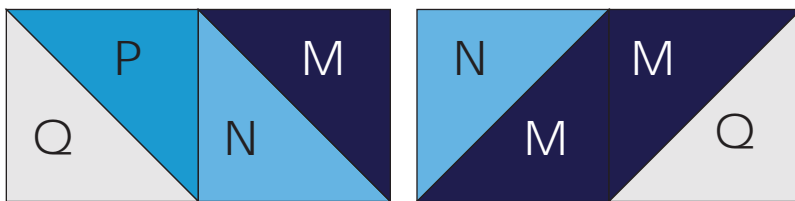
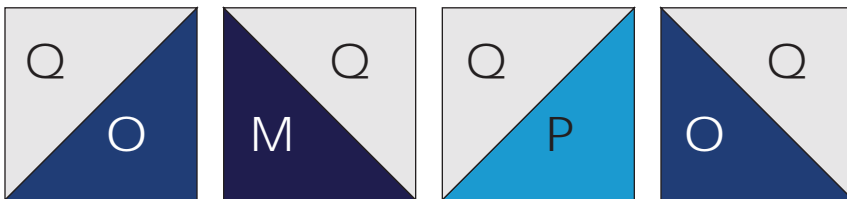
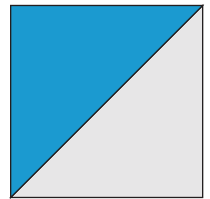
**Step 23:** Repeat Step 22 with Fabric M and Q squares to make twenty M/Q HSTs.



**Step 24:** Repeat Step 22 with Fabric O and Q squares to make twenty O/Q HSTs.



**Step 25:** Repeat Step 22 with Fabric P and Q squares to make twenty P/Q HSTs.



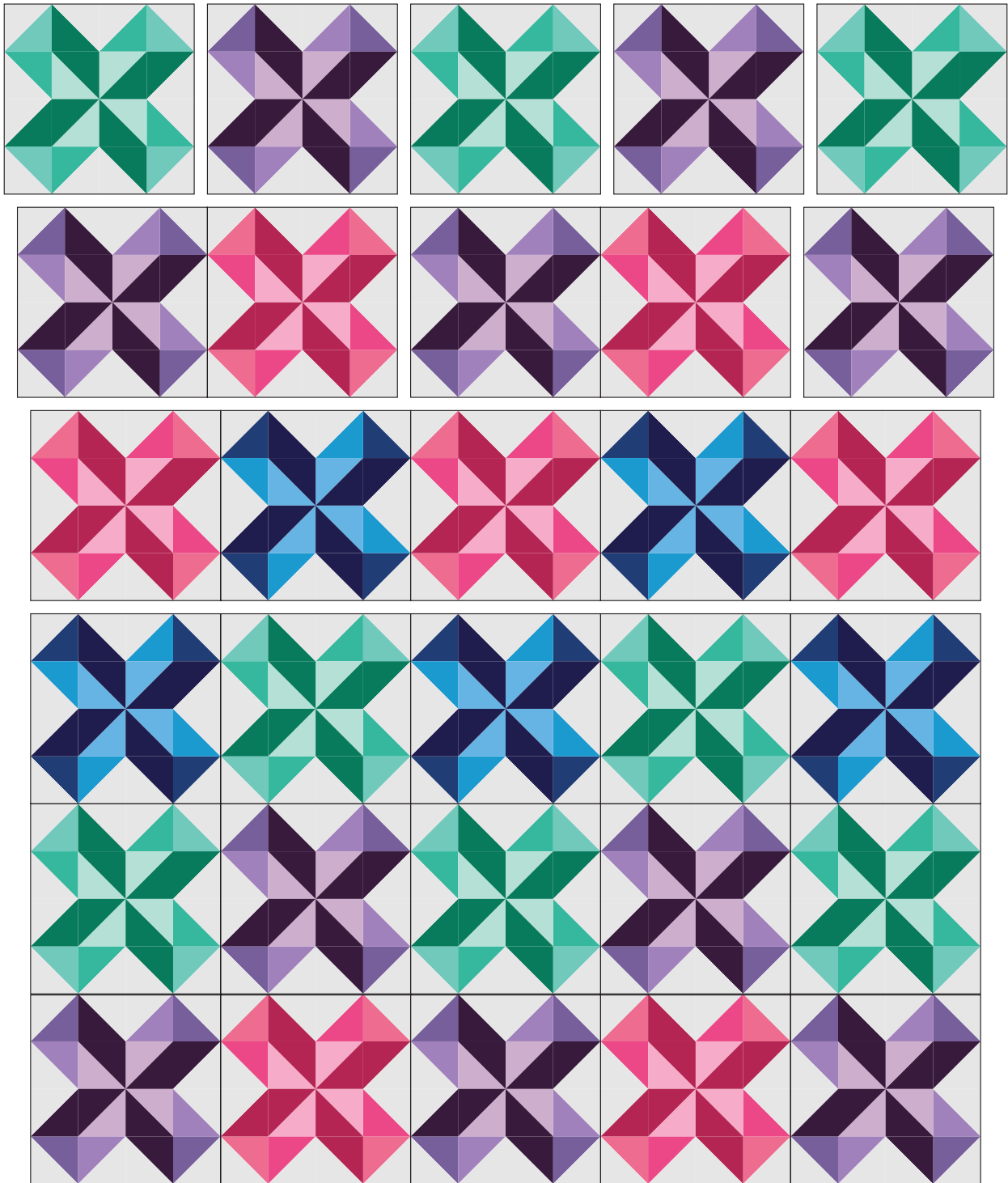
**Step 26:** Arrange the HSTs into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 27:** Sew the units together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 28:** Sew the rows together to form the block. Press the row seams open.

Repeat to make five D Blocks.

## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 29:** Arrange the blocks into six rows of five blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 30:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 31:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
