# Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

three 7-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

fifteen 7-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal for paper piecing section A1 of Template 1.

four 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty 4-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal for paper piecing section A3 of Template 1.

#### From Fabric B, cut:

twenty-three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixty 2-1/2" x 10" rectangles for paper piecing section A2 of Template 1. sixty 2-1/2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for paper piecing section B5 of Template 2. three 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty 4-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal for paper piecing section B4 of Template 2.

#### From Fabric C, cut:

three 7-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

fifteen 7-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal for paper piecing section A1 of Template 1.

#### From Fabric D, cut:

five 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal for paper piecing section B1 of Template 2.

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: sixty 2-1/2" x 5-1/4" rectangles for paper piecing section B3 of Template 2.

#### From Fabric E, cut:

five 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty 5-1/2" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal for paper piecing section B2 of Template 2.

#### From the binding fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

# Assemble the A Blocks

This quilt is constructed by paper piecing the blocks. Sew the pieces in the order indicated on the template, working from section #1-3. Trim seam allowances to 1/4" as each new pieces is added.

Thirty of the Template 1 pieces will be composed of Fabrics A and B, while the remaining thirty will be composed of Fabrics A, B and C.





Make thirty.

Trim the units to the template edge. Arrange two units of each fabric combination together to form the block. Sew together as illustrated.



Remove the paper.

# Assemble the B Blocks

Sew the pieces in the order indicated on the template, working from section #1-5. Trim seam allowances to 1/4" as each new pieces is added.

Each of the sixty Template 2 units will be identical.






Make sixty.

Trim the units to the template edge. Arrange four units to form the block. Sew together as illustrated.

Remove the paper.

Assemble the Quilt

Arrange the A and B Blocks by alternating them in a pattern as illustrated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, assembling them in six rows of five blocks, each. Note the orientation of the blocks in the Diagram and rotate accordingly.





Sew the blocks into rows, pressing the seams to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the row seams open.

Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!


# Templates

Prepare the paper piecing templates by making sixty copies of Template 1 and sixty copies of Template 2, both at 100%. Cut out the templates on the dotted line.
