## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

**From Fabric A, fussy cut:**

one 22-1/2" x 35-1/2" rectangle for the Main Panel

**From Fabric B, fussy cut:**

six 10-1/2" squares for the Block Centers

**From Fabric C, cut:**

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

three 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" side inner borders

two 2-1/2" x 41-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

one 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" sashing strip

four 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" sashing strips

**From Fabric D, cut:**

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 35-1/2" side Main Panel borders

two 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" top/bottom Main Panel borders

three 1" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1" x 10-1/2" side block borders

four 1" x 11-1/2" top/bottom block borders

**From each of Fabrics E and F, cut:**

three 1" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1" x 10-1/2" side block borders

four 1" x 11-1/2" top/bottom block borders

**From Fabric G, cut:**

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" side outer borders

two 4-1/2" x 49-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

**From the Binding, cut:**

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips



## Assemble the Main Panel and Blocks



**Step 1:** Sew the Fabric D side borders to the sides of the Fabric A panel. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the Fabric A panel. Press toward the borders.

**Step 2:** Sew the Fabric D, E and F side block borders to the sides of the Fabric B blocks. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the Fabric B blocks. Press toward the borders. Repeat with all six Blocks. Each Block should measure 11-1/2" square at this point.



*Note: Pair the Fabric D, E and F strips to the specific block shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram or to a block of your choosing.*



**Step 3:** Sew four Blocks together to form the column on the right edge of the quilt, sewing a Fabric C 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" sashing between each block. Press.

**Step 4:** Sew two Blocks together to form the row on the lower left of the quilt, sewing a Fabric C 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" sashing between the blocks. Press.



**Step 5:** Sew completed Step 1 unit to the top of the completed Step 4 unit, sewing the 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" Fabric C strip in between.

**Step 6:** Sew completed Step 5 unit to the left of the completed Step 3 unit, sewing a 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" Fabric C strip in between.

**Step 7:** Sew the Fabric C side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric C top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.



**Step 8:** Sew the Fabric G side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric G top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
