## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

nineteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- forty-nine 2" x 10-1/2" rectangles for the sashing strips
- Sew the remainder of the last strip and the remaining full strips together, end-to-end, then trim:
  - two 2-1/2" x 68" side outer borders
  - two 2-1/2" x 59-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

eight 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- sixty 5" squares for the HSTs

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- one hundred twenty 2-1/2" squares

### **From each of Fabrics B-O, cut:**

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- four 5" squares for the HSTs

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- four 2-1/2" squares

### **From Fabric P, cut:**

one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- twenty 2" squares for the cornerstones

### **From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 5" Fabric A square with a 5" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight A/B HSTs.



**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:



eight A/C HSTs



eight A/D HSTs



eight A/E HSTs



eight A/F HSTs



eight A/G HSTs



eight A/H HSTs



eight A/I HSTs



eight A/J HSTs



eight A/K HSTs



eight A/L HSTs



eight A/M HSTs



eight A/N HSTs



eight A/O HSTs

**Step 3:** Sew each 2-1/2" Fabric B-O square to a 2-1/2" Fabric A square. Press toward the darker fabric. You will create six units from each of Fabrics B-O.

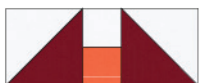
**Step 4:** Gather:

four Fabric A/B HSTs

two completed Step 3 units, Fabric O

two 2-1/2" Fabric A squares

one 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric O rectangle

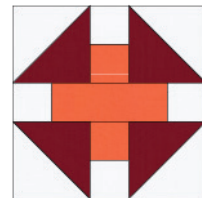


Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

**Step 5:** Sew the units together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the HSTs in the top and bottom row, and toward the rectangle in the middle row.

**Step 6:** Sew the rows together and press the seams to one side to form the block. The resulting Block should measure 10-1/2" square.

**Step 7:** Repeat Steps 4-6 to make a total of thirty blocks, using the fabric combinations shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

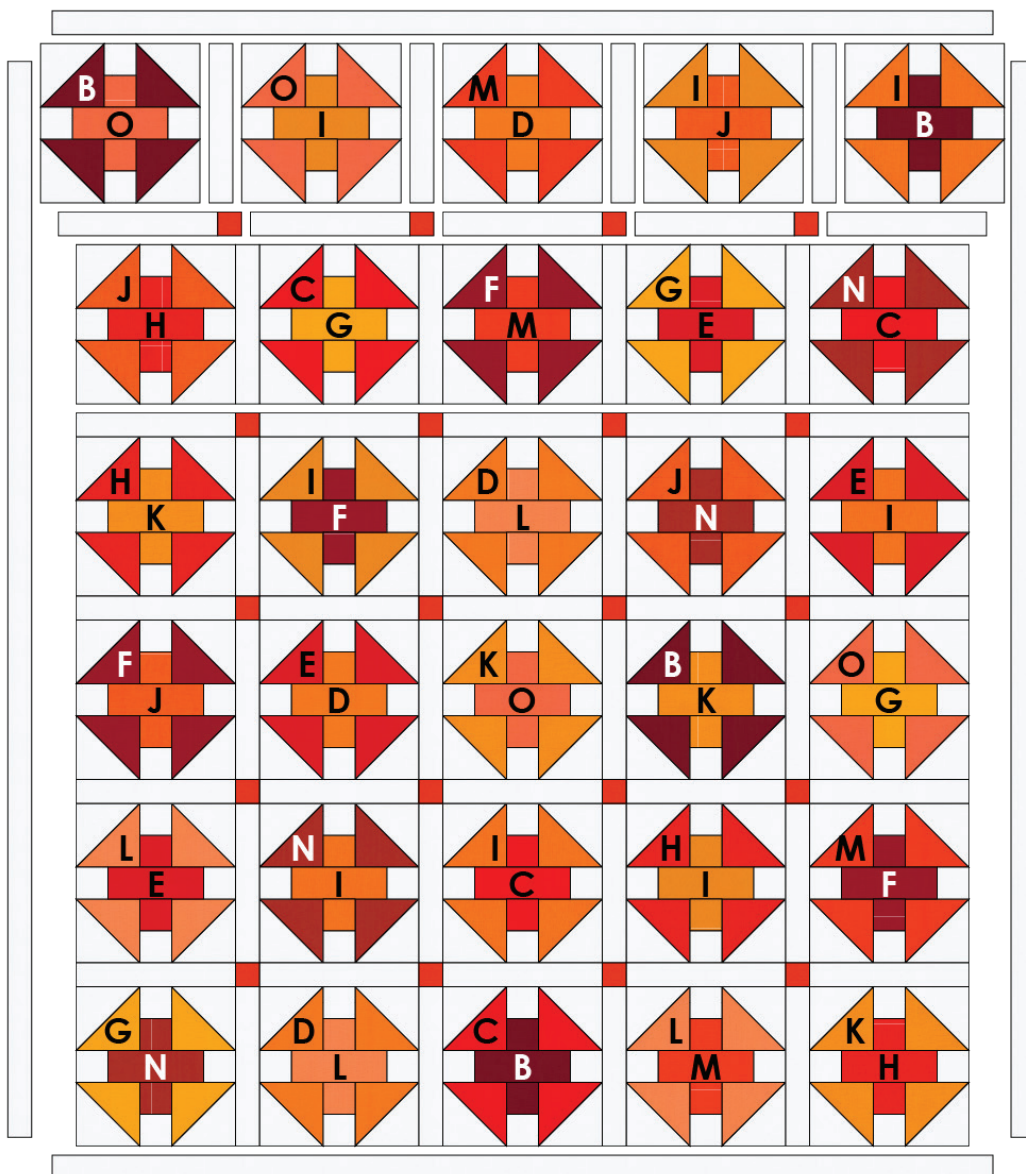


## Assemble the Quilt

**Step 8:** Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make six block rows.

**Step 9:** Gather five cornerstone squares and five sashing strips. Sew each row together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five sashing rows.

**Step 10:** Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.



**Step 11:** Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
