

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## **Cutting Instructions**

Tip: To organize your cuts of fabric for easier piecing, it is recommended that you stack pieces in piles with the following labels:

Rows 1 & 35

Rows 2 & 34

Rows 3 & 33

Rows 4 & 32

Rows 5 & 31

Rows 6 & 30

Rows 7 & 29

Rows 8 & 28

Rows 9 & 27

Rows 10 & 26

Rows 11 & 25 Rows 12 & 24

Rows 13 & 23

Rows 14 & 22

Rows 15 & 21


Rows 16 & 20

Rows 17 & 19


#### From Fabric A. cut:

- four 5-1/2" x 33" rectangles, two each for Rows 2 and 34
- four 4-1/2" x 21-1/4" rectangles, two each for Rows 6 and 30
- two 4-1/2" x 21" rectangles, one each for Rows 6 and 30



#### From Fabric B, cut:

- eight 3-1/2" x 15-3/4" rectangles, four each for Rows 10 and 26
- four 4-1/2" x 21-1/4" rectangles, two each for Rows 14 and 22
- two 4-1/2" x 21" rectangles, one each for Rows 14 and 22
- two 5-1/2" x 33" rectangles, for Row 18



#### From Fabric C, cut:

- one 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  four 4-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 6 and 30
- four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
- $\Box$  four 3-1/2" x 21-3/4" rectangles, two each for Rows 1 and 35

#### From Fabric D, cut:

- two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  two 3-1/2" x 22" rectangles, for Rows 1 and 35
  - □ Trim the remainder of one strip to 2-1/2" wide, then subcut:
    - ♦ four 2-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 3 and 33

#### From Fabric E, cut:

- one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  two 5-1/2" squares, one each for Rows 2 and 34
  - □ Trim the remainder of the strip to 3-1/2" wide, then subcut:
    - ♦ four 3-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 1 and 35
    - ♦ Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2" wide, then subcut:
      - six 2-1/2" squares, three each for Rows 4 and 32
- four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  four 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, two each for Rows 3 and 33

#### From Fabric F, cut:

- four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  eight 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles, four each for Rows 4 and 32
    - $\Box$  eight 2-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 5, 7, 29 and 31

#### From Fabric G, cut:

- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  six 2-1/2" x 22-1/2-1/2" rectangles, three each for Rows 5 and 31

#### From Fabric H, cut:

- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  six 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, three each for Rows 7 and 29

#### From Fabric I, cut:

- four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  eight 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles, four each for Rows 8 and 28
  - $\Box$  four 2-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 11 and 25

#### From Fabric J, cut:

- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  six 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, three each for Rows 15 and 21
  - sixteen 2-1/2" squares, three each for Rows 8, 16, 20 and 28, and two each for Rows 13 and 23

#### From Fabric K. cut:

- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  six 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, three each for Rows 9 and 27

#### From Fabric L, cut:

- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\,\Box\,$  six 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, three each for Rows 13 and 23

#### From Fabric M, cut:

- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  six 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, three each for Rows 11 and 25
  - $\Box$  ten 2-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 9 and 27, and three each for Rows 12 and 24

#### From Fabric N, cut:

- one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  six 3-1/2" squares, three each for Rows 10 and 26
- four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  eight 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles, four each for Rows 12 and 24

#### From Fabric O, cut:

- one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  one 5-1/2" square, for Row 18
  - □ Trim the remainder of the strip to 4-1/2" wide, then subcut:
    - four 4-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 14 and 22
    - ♦ Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2" wide, then subcut:
      - o four 2-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 17 and 19

#### From Fabric P, cut:

- four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  eight 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" rectangles, four each for Rows 16 and 20
  - $\Box$  four 2-1/2" squares, two each for Rows 15 and 21

#### From Fabric Q, cut:

- six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  six 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, three each for Rows 17 and 19

#### From Fabric R, cut:

- two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - $\Box$  two 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" rectangles, one each for Rows 3 and 33

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Rows

#### Row 1: Gather:

two 3-1/2" x 21-3/4" Fabric C rectangles one 3-1/2" x 22" Fabric D rectangles two 3-1/2" Fabric E squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 35.



#### Row 2: Gather:

two 5-1/2" x 33" Fabric A rectangles one 5-1/2" Fabric E square

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 34.



#### Row 3: Gather:

two 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric E rectangles one 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric R rectangle two 2-1/2" Fabric D squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 33.



#### Row 4: Gather:

four 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" Fabric F rectangles three 2-1/2" Fabric E squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 32.

Row 5: Gather:

three 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric G rectangles

two 2-1/2" Fabric F squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 31.



Row 6: Gather:

two 5-1/2" x 21-1/4" Fabric A rectangles

one 4-1/2" x 21" Fabric A rectangle (this is placed in the center of the row)

two 4-1/2" Fabric C squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 30.



Row 7: Gather:

three 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric H rectangles

two 2-1/2" Fabric F squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 29.



Row 8: Gather:

four 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" Fabric I rectangles

three 2-1/2" Fabric J squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 28.



Row 9: Gather:

three 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric K rectangles

two 2-1/2" Fabric M squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 27.



Row 10: Gather:

four 3-1/2" x 15-3/4" Fabric B rectangles

three 3-1/2" Fabric N squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 26.



Row 11: Gather:

three 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric M rectangles

two 2-1/2" Fabric I squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 25.



#### Row 12: Gather:

four 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" Fabric N rectangles

three 2-1/2" Fabric M squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 24.



#### Row 13: Gather:

three 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric L rectangles

two 2-1/2" Fabric J squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 23.



#### Row 14: Gather:

two 5-1/2" x 21-1/4" Fabric B rectangles

one 4-1/2" x 21" Fabric B rectangle (this is placed in the center of the row)

two 4-1/2" Fabric O squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 22.



#### Row 15: Gather:

three 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric J rectangles

two 2-1/2" Fabric P squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 21.



#### Row 16: Gather:

four 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" Fabric P rectangles

three 2-1/2" Fabric J squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 20.



Row 17: Gather:

three 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric Q rectangles

two 2-1/2" Fabric O squares

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press. Repeat to make Row 19.




**Row 18:** Gather: two 5-1/2" x 33" Fabric B rectangles one 5-1/2" Fabric O square

Sew together, following the assembly diagram. Press.



### Assemble the Quilt




rows together, gradually working toward sewing two halves of the quilt together.

**Step 20:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt. Press the row seams open. *Tip: Sew rows together in pairs, then sew pairs of* 

**Step 19:** Arrange the rows in numerical order. Note the fabric placement and orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
