

# Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

two 10-1/2" x 40-1/2" panel rectangles

#### From each of Fabrics B and C, fussy cut:

two 25-1/2" x 17-1/2" panel rectangles, for a total of four

#### From Fabric D, cut:

fifteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 2" x 13-1/2" side block borders

four 2" x 40-1/2" top/bottom block borders

eight 2" x 20-1/2" side block borders

Sew the remaining five strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

eight 2" x 25-1/2" top/bottom block borders

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 76-1/2" side Border 2 strips

two 1-1/2" x 64-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 strips

#### From Fabric E, cut:

one 13-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 8" x 13-1/2" rectangles

twelve 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" side Border 1 strips

two 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 strips

three 2-1/2" x 58-1/2" row sashing strips

two 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" block sashing strips

#### From Fabric F, cut:

two 2-1/2" x <u>length of fabric</u> strips. Subcut:

two 5-1/2" x 78-1/2" side Border 3 strips

From the remaining width of fabric, cut:

five 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 5-1/2" x 74-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 strips

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Blocks

**Step 1:** Sew a 2" x 40-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of a Fabric A panel block. Press toward the strips. Sew a 2" x 13-1/2" Fabric D strip to the sides of the block. Press toward the strips. The block should measure 43-1/2" x 13-1/2".

Repeat to make a second block like this.



**Step 2:** Sew a 2" x 25-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of a Fabric B panel block. Press toward the strips. Sew a 2" x 20-1/2" Fabric D strip to the sides of the block. Press toward the strips. The block should measure 28-1/2" x 20-1/2".

Repeat to make a total of four blocks like this.



#### Assemble the Rows

**Step 3:** Sew a 8" x 13-1/2" Fabric E rectangle to the left and right edges of a Fabric A panel block. Press. This is Row 1.



Repeat to make Row 4.

**Step 4:** Sew a 2" x 20-1/2" Fabric E block sashing strip between a Fabric B and Fabric C panel block. Press. This is Row 2.



Repeat to make Row 3, noting the difference in where the Fabric B and Fabric C blocks are placed.

#### Assemble the Quilt



**Step 5:** Sew Rows 1-4 together, sewing a 2" x 58-1/2" Fabric E row sashing strip between each row. Press.

**Step 6:** Sew the side Border 1 strips to the sides of the quilt. Press. Sew the top/bottom Border 1 strips to the quilt. Press.

**Step 7:** Sew the side Border 2 strips to the sides of the quilt. Press. Sew the top/bottom Border 2 strips to the quilt. Press.

**Step 8:** Sew the side Border 3 strips to the sides of the quilt. Press. Sew the top/bottom Border 3 strips to the quilt. Press.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
