## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty-three 3-1/2" squares
thirty-two 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
twenty 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
three hundred twenty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs
one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 2" squares

#### From Fabric B, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 3-1/2" squares two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" top/bottom inner borders two 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" side inner borders

#### From Fabric C, cut:

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: five 3-1/2" squares

two 3-1/2" x 56-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

two 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" side outer borders

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs

#### From each of Fabrics D and E, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

five 3-1/2" squares

two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs

#### From each of Fabrics F-Q, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs

#### From each of Fabrics R-U, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

three 3-1/2" squares

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 2-1/2" squares for the HSTs

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 2-1/2" Fabric A square with a 2-1/2" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2" square. Repeat to make forty A/B HSTs.



#### Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:








twenty-four A/U HSTs

#### Assemble the HST Pairs

**Step 3:** Divide the A/B HSTs into two even stacks. Sew together in pairs as shown, with half of the pairs having both triangles pointing to the left, and half of the pairs having both triangles pointing to the right.





**Step 4:** Repeat Step 3, making two styles of HST pairs for each fabric. Half will point to the left and half will point to the right.

#### Assemble the Quilt



**Step 5:** Arrange the HST pairs, print squares and Fabric A pieces as shown, to form the quilt. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the units together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 7:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
