Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, trim:

one 22-1/2" x 40-1/2" rectangle.
From Fabric B, cut:
one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 4-1/2" squares, then cut: two 1-1/2" x remaining WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" top/bottom panel borders.
one 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
ten 2-1/2" squares.
two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side panel borders.
From Fabric C, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty-two 2-1/2" squares.
From Fabric D, cut:
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty 2-1/2" squares.
From Fabric E , cut:
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-eight 2-1/2" squares.

## From Fabric F , cut:

three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-eight 2-1/2" squares.

From Fabric G, cut:
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: fifty-eight 2-1/2" squares.

From Fabric H , cut:
one 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles, then cut:
two 2-1/2" x remaining WOF. Subcut:
four 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
four 2-1/2" squares.
ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles.
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
four 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Step 1: Gather:
one 2-1/2" Fabric B square
three 2-1/2" Fabric C squares
five 2-1/2" Fabric D squares
nine 2-1/2" Fabric E squares
thirteen 2-1/2" Fabric F squares
sixteen 2-1/2" Fabric G squares
two 2-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangles
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangles
Step 2: Arrange the squares and rectangles in five rows as shown.
Sew the pieces together to form rows, then press.
Nest the seams and sew the rows together. Make two side outer borders.


Step 3: Gather:
two 4-1/2" Fabric B squares
four 2-1/2" Fabric B squares
eight 2-1/2" Fabric C squares
ten 2-1/2" Fabric D squares
ten 2-1/2" Fabric E squares
eleven 2-1/2" Fabric F squares
thirteen 2-1/2" Fabric G squares
two 2-1/2" Fabric H squares
two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangles
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangles
one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangle
Step 4: Sew a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ square, 2-1/2" Fabric C square, 2-1/2" Fabric
 D square, 2-1/2" Fabric E square, 2-1/2" Fabric F square, and 2-1/2" Fabric $G$ square together in a row, then press.

Step 5: Sew a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $C$ square, $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ square, $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E square, 2-1/2" Fabric F square, 2-1/2" Fabric G square, and 2-1/2" Fabric
 H square together in a row, then press.

Step 6: Sew the Step 4 row to the top of the Step 5 row, then press. Sew a 4-1/2" Fabric B square to the left side as shown. Press.


Step 7: Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric B square, 2-1/2" Fabric C square, 2-1/2" Fabric D square, 2-1/2" Fabric E square, 2-1/2" Fabric F square, 2-1/2" Fabric G square, and $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangle together in a row, then press.

Step 8: Sew the Step 7 row to the bottom of the Step 6 row, then press.

Step 9: Repeat Step 4-8 to create a second unit, but this time reverse the order of the fabrics sewn to create a mirrored unit.


Step 10: Sew the Step 8 and Step 9 units to either end of the $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangle, then press.


Step 11: Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric C square, 2-1/2" Fabric D square, 2-1/2" Fabric E square, 2-1/2" Fabric F square, 2-1/2" Fabric G
 square, and $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H rectangle together in a row, then press.

Step 12: Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric D square, 2-1/2" Fabric E square, $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square, 2-1/2" Fabric G square, $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
 Fabric H rectangle, and 2-1/2" Fabric G square together in a row, then press.

Step 13: Sew the Step 11 row to the top of the Step 12 row, then press.


Step 14: Repeat Steps 11-13 to create a second unit, but this time reverse the order of the fabrics sewn to create a mirrored unit.


Step 15: Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric G square to the top of a $2-1 / 2$ " Fabric F square, then press.


Step 16: Sew the Step 13 and 14 units to either side of the Step 15 unit. Press.


Step 17: Sew the Step 10 unit to the top of the Step 16 unit. Press to complete the top border. Repeat Steps 3-17 to make the bottom border.


## Assemble the Quilt

Step 18: Sew the side panel borders to the sides of the Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom side panel borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 19: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
