3/4 yard for binding

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

**For Dusty Blue Colorstory see Alternate Cutting at the end of the pattern.**

*Tip: To organize cuts for faster block sewing, place cuts in stacks with the following labels: A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, B1, B2, B3, B4 and B5. Fabric A pieces will be used for all blocks, so there is no need to stack it by block.*

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

seven 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- twenty-four 3" squares for the A Blocks
- twenty-four 3" squares for the B Blocks
- twenty-four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the B Blocks

eight 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- seventy-two 3-1/2" squares for the A Blocks
- twenty-four 3-1/2" squares for the B Blocks

six 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, in pairs. Then trim to yield:

- two 2" x 51-1/2" top and bottom inner borders
- two 2" x 68" side inner borders

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- twenty 2" cornerstone squares

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- two 5-1/2" squares, one each for Block A1 and A3

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

- four 3-1/2" squares for Block A4

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- twenty 3" squares: eight for Block B1, eight for B6 and four for A4

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

two 5-1/2" squares: one each for Block B1 and B5

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

two 5-1/2" squares: one each for Block A2 and B4



**From Fabric E, cut:**

two 5-1/2" squares: one each for Block B2 and B6

three 3" x WOF strips: Subcut:

twenty-four 3" squares: twelve each for Block B3 and B5

eight 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles: four each for Block B3 and B5

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip: Subcut:

eight 3-1/2" squares: four each for Block B3 and B5

**From Fabric F, cut:**

two 5-1/2" squares: one each for Block B3 and A5

**From Fabric G, cut:**

one 5-1/2" square for Block A4

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block A3

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" squares for Block A3

**From Fabric H, cut:**

five 5-1/2" squares: one for Block A6 and four for Block A4

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 3-1/2" squares: four each for Block B1 and A5

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 3" squares: twelve for Block B1 and four for Block A5

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B1

**From Fabric I, cut:**

eight 5-1/2" squares: four each for Block A2 and A5

**From Fabric J, cut:**

four 5-1/2" squares for Block A1

**From Fabric K, cut:**

four 5-1/2" squares for Block A6

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for Block B2

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block B2

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B2

**From Fabric L, cut:**

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for Block B4

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block B4

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B4

**From Fabric M, cut:**

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty 3" squares: twelve for Block B6 and eight for Block B3

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B6

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block B6

**From Fabric N, cut:**

four 5-1/2" squares for Block A3

**From Fabric O, cut:**

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 3-1/2" squares: four each for Block A1 and A6

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 3" squares: four each for Block A1 and A6

**From Fabric P, cut:**

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-eight 3" squares: four for Block A2, eight for B2, eight for B4 and eight for B5

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block A2

**From Fabric Q, cut:**

sixteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-one 2" x 15-1/2" sashing strips

**From Fabric R, cut:**

four 8-1/2" x length of fabric strips.

set side for the four outer borders

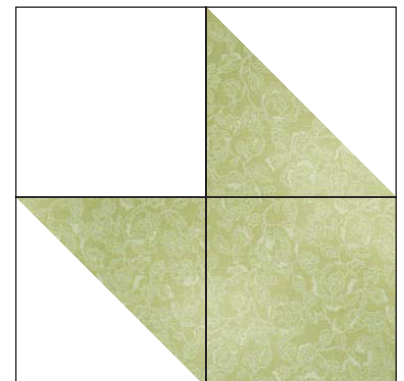
**From the binding fabric, cut:**

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the A Blocks

**Step 1:** Pair each 3-1/2" print square with a 3-1/2" Fabric A square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one fabric. Sew 1/4" away on both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangle blocks. (HSTs) Press toward the print fabric. Trim to 3" square, if needed. Repeat to make eight HSTs per block.

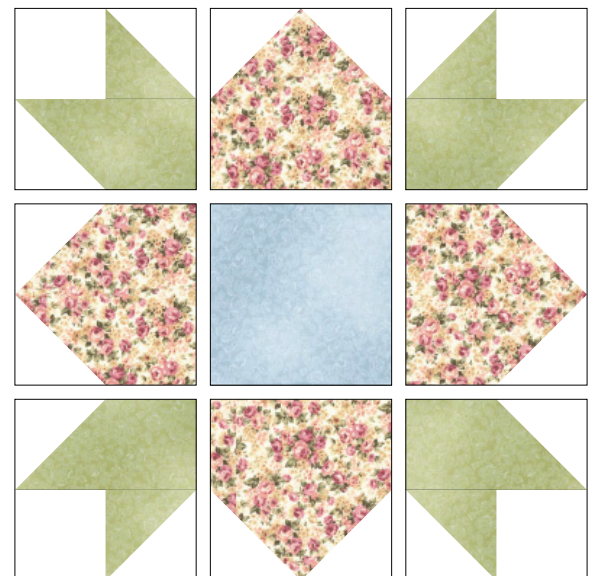
**Step 2:** Assemble a four-patch unit with two HSTs from Step 1, one matching 3" print square and one 3" Fabric A square. Note the orientation of the HSTs in the diagram. Press the seams away from the HSTs. The four-patch should measure 5-1/2" square. Repeat to make four four-patch units per block.



**Step 3:** Place a 3" Fabric A square RST with one of the four matching 5-1/2" squares. Align the raw edges at one corner and mark along the diagonal as indicated in the illustration. Sew on the marked line. Trim excess fabric away, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam toward the triangle. Repeat with a second 3" Fabric A square at an adjacent corner. Repeat to make four units per block.



**Step 4:** Arrange the center square, Step 2 and Step 3 units together in three rows of three units, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together, pressing the unit seams toward the Step 3 units. Press the rows seams open. Repeat to make Blocks A2-A6, each 15-1/2" square. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement for each block.



## Assemble the B Blocks

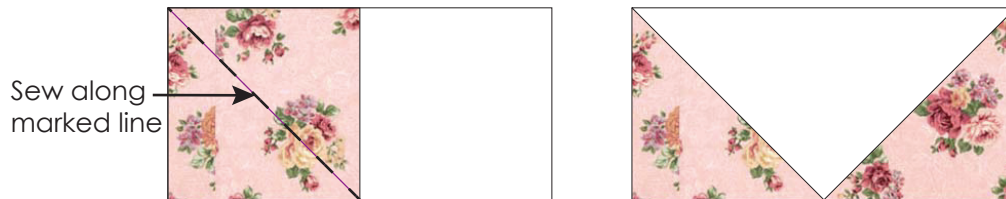
*Note: This assembly is specific to Block B1, but the process is the same for all B units.*

**Step 1:** Pair each 3-1/2" Fabric A square with a 3-1/2" Fabric H square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one fabric. Sew 1/4" away on both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangle blocks. (HSTs) Press toward the print fabric. Trim to 3" square, if needed. Repeat to make eight HSTs per block.

**Step 2:** Assemble a four-patch unit with two HSTs from Step 1, one 3" Fabric H square and one 3" Fabric A square. Note the orientation of the HSTs in the diagram. Press the seams away from the HSTs. The four-patch should measure 5-1/2" square. Repeat to make four four-patch units per block.



**Step 3:** Place a 3" Fabric H square RST with a 3" x 5-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Align the raw edges at one end and mark along the diagonal as indicated in the illustration. Sew on the marked line. Trim excess fabric away, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam toward the triangle. Repeat with a second 3" Fabric H square at the opposite end of the rectangle. Repeat to make four flying geese units.



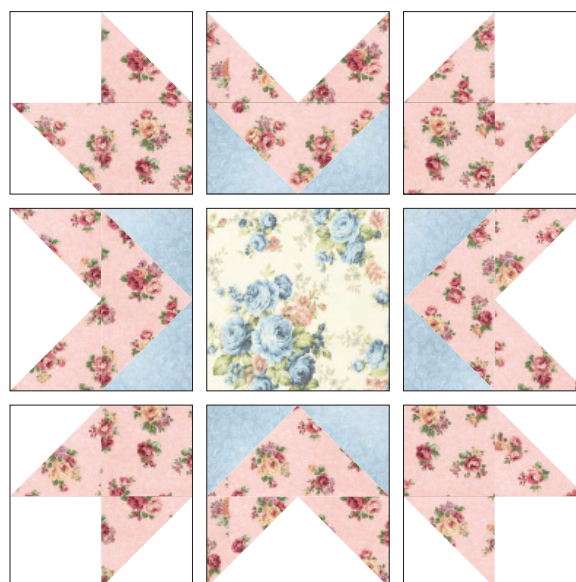
**Step 4:** Repeat Step 3 using the Fabric H rectangles and Fabric B squares.

**Step 5:** Sew one Step 3 and one Step 4 (flying geese pairs) unit together along the longest sides, noting the orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram. Repeat to make four units.

**Step 6:** Arrange the center square, Step 2 and Step 5 units together in three rows of three

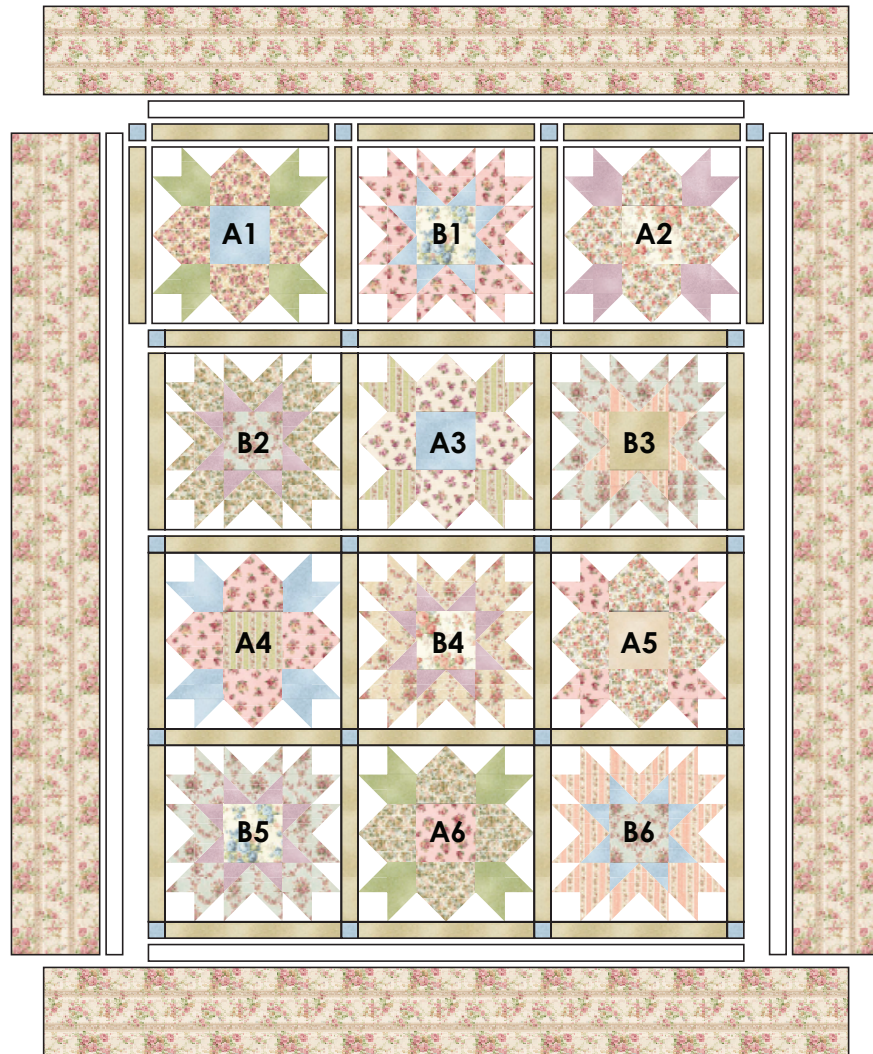


units, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together, pressing the unit seams toward the Step 5 units. Press the rows seams open. Repeat to make Blocks B2-B6, each 15-1/2" square. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement for each block.





## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 1:** Arrange the A and B Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

**Step 2:** Gather four cornerstone squares and three sashing strips. Sew each row together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five sashing rows.

**Step 3:** Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

**Step 4:** Sew the 2" x 51-1/2" inner borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the border. Sew the 2" x 68" inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the border.

**Step 5:** Center and pin on 8-1/2" wide outer border to the side of the quilt center. Trim the excess and sew to the quilt. Press toward the border. Sew the remaining side, top and bottom outer borders in this way. Press toward the border.

Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!



## Alternate Cutting for Dust Blue Colorstory

*Tip: To organize cuts for faster block sewing, place cuts in stacks with the following labels: A1, A2, A3, A4, A5, B1, B2, B3, B4 and B5. Fabric A pieces will be used for all blocks, so there is no need to stack it by block.*

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

seven 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 3" squares for the A Blocks

twenty-four 3" squares for the B Blocks

twenty-four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for the B Blocks

eight 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-two 3-1/2" squares for the A Blocks

twenty-four 3-1/2" squares for the B Blocks

six 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, in pairs. Then trim to yield:

two 2" x 51-1/2" top and bottom inner borders

two 2" x 68" side inner borders

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twenty 2" squares for cornerstones

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-four 3" squares: eight each for Block B1, B3, and B6

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" square for Block B6

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

eight 3" squares: four each for Block A1 and A4

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 3-1/2" squares: four each for Block A1 and A4

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

one 5-1/2" square for Block A1

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

nine 5-1/2" squares: four for Block A4, four for A6 and one for A2

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block B3

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B3

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for Block B3

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

four 5-1/2" squares for Block A3



**From Fabric H, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" square for Block B6

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

eight 3-1/2" squares: four each for Block B5 and B6

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eight 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles: four each for Block B5 and B6

twenty-four 3" squares: twelve each for Block B5 and B6

**From Fabric I, cut:**

5-1/2" square for B1

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block A5

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" squares for Block A5

**From Fabric J, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

five 5-1/2" squares: four for Block A1 and one for A3

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block B4

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B4

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for Block B4

**From Fabric K, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 5-1/2" squares: one each for Block B3 and B5

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block B1

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B1

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for Block B1

**From Fabric L, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

five 5-1/2" squares: four for Block A5 and one for B2

**From Fabric M, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

five 5-1/2" squares: four for Block A2 and one for B4

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block B2

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Block B2

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for Block B2

**From Fabric N, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" square for Block A4

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

four 3-1/2" squares for Block A2

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty 3" squares: four for Block A2, eight for B4 and eight for B5

**From Fabric O, cut:**

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 3" squares for Block B2

**From Fabric P, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

one 5-1/2" square for Block A5

From the remainder of the strip, cut:

eight 3" squares: four each for Block A3 and A6

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 3-1/2" squares: four each for Block A3 and A6

sixteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-one 2" x 15-1/2" sashing strips

**From Fabric Q, cut:**

four 8-1/2" x **length of fabric** strips.

set side for the four outer borders

**From the binding fabric, cut:**

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips
