

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 4-1/2" x 33-1/2" side outer borders two 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" top/bottom outer borders From the remainder of one strip, cut: one 3-1/2" square

From Fabric B, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twelve 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric E, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-eight 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric F, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty-six 3-1/2" squares


From Fabric G, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 3-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Quilt



Step 1: Arrange the Fabric A-G squares into eleven rows of eleven. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

Step 3: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

Step 4: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
