

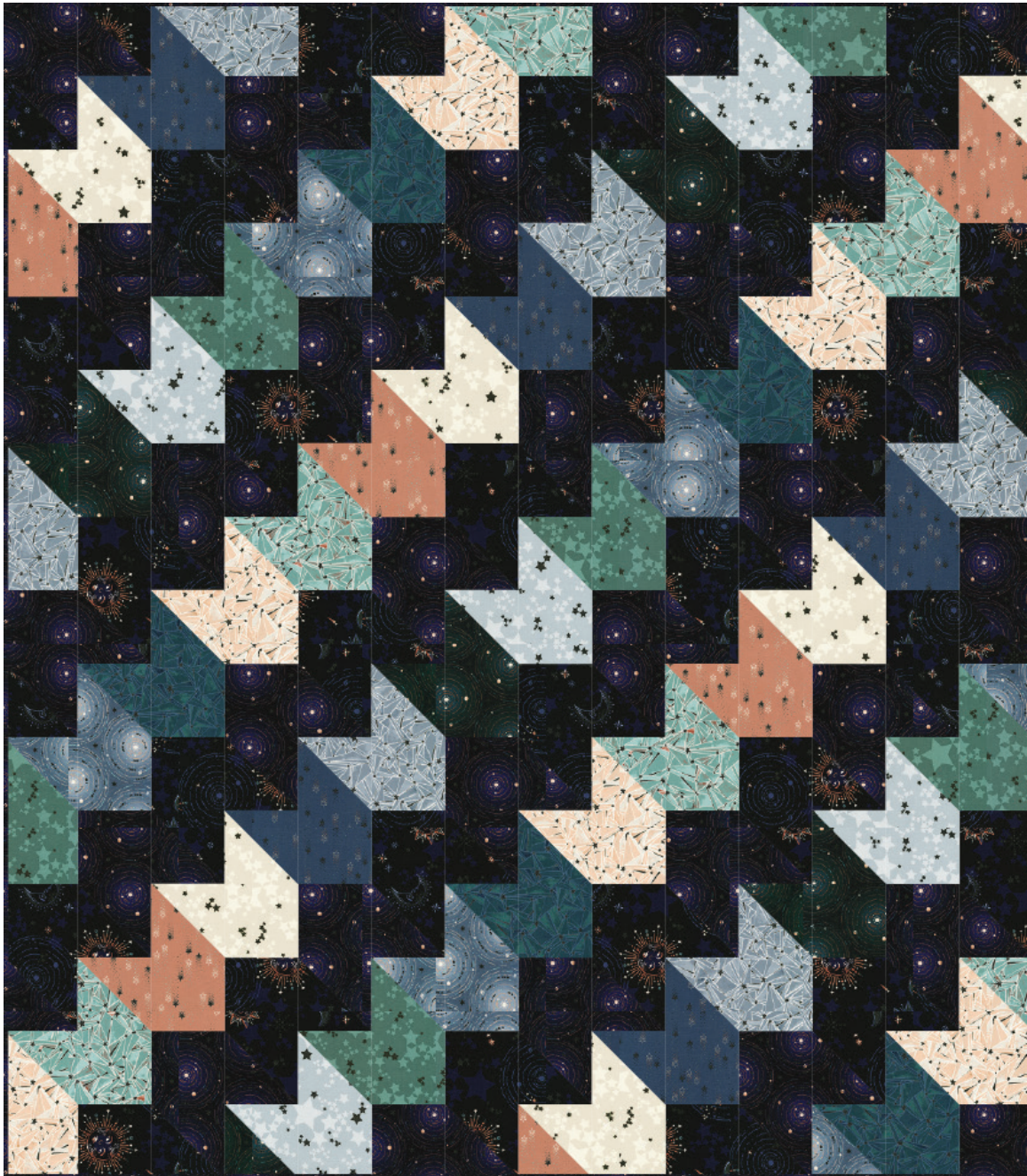

Finished quilt measures: 56" x 64"

















****Note:** Fabrics N-P in the bundle are not used in the quilt.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

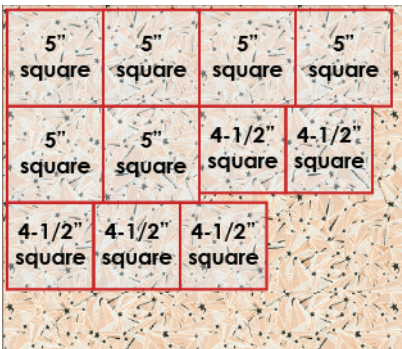
From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:

four 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-eight 5" squares for the HSTs

four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

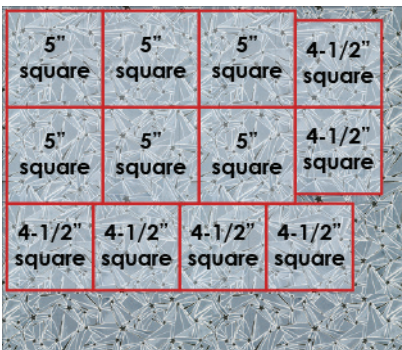
twenty-eight 4-1/2" squares



From each of Fabrics C, F, J and M, cut:

five 4-1/2" squares

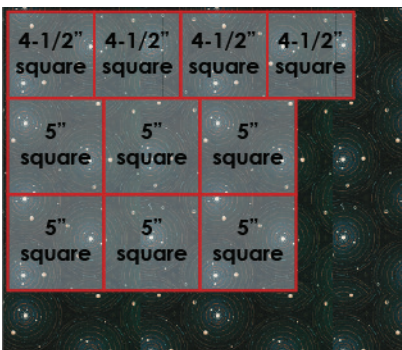
six 5" squares for the HSTs



From each of Fabrics D, G, and H, cut:

six 4-1/2" squares

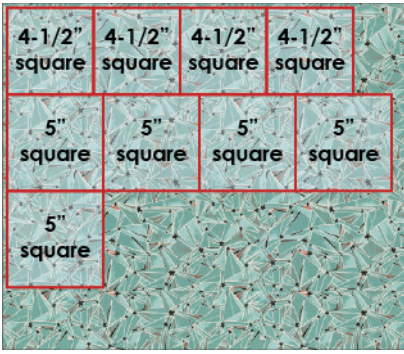
six 5" squares for the HSTs



From each of Fabrics E and I, cut:

four 4-1/2" squares

six 5" squares for the HSTs

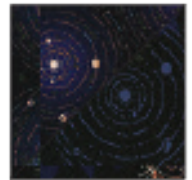


From each of Fabrics K and L, cut:
 five 4-1/2" squares
 five 5" squares for the HSTs

From the Binding Fabric, cut:
 seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 5" Fabric A square with a 5" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make fifty-six A/B HSTs.



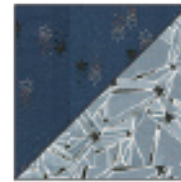
Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:



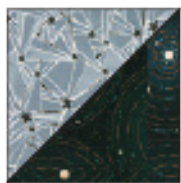

Assemble the Quilt



Step 3: Arrange the blocks into sixteen rows of fourteen blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 4: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 5: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
