Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, cut:

six 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty-two 6-1/2" squares
six $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom outer borders two 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" side outer borders
thirteen 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two hundred forty-eight 2 " squares. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.

From each of Fabrics B, C and G, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 3-1/2" squares
From each of Fabrics D-F and $H$, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 3-1/2" squares

## From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips

## Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Place a 2" Fabric A square in the upper right corner of a Fabric B square, right sides together. Note the orientation of the marked diagonal line. Sew on the marked line, then trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Repeat on the lower left corner with another 2 " Fabric A square.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 for all 3-1/2" Fabric B-H squares.

Step 3: Gather four completed Step 2 units, all made from Fabric B. Arrange as shown, noting the orientation, and sew together to form
 a four-patch. Press the seams in opposite directions for the rows, then nest the seams and sew the two rows together. Press. The block should measure 6-1/2" square.

Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make a total of:

five Fabric B Blocks

five Fabric C Blocks

four Fabric D Blocks

four Fabric E Blocks

four Fabric F Blocks

five Fabric G Blocks

four Fabric H Blocks


Step 5: Arrange the completed Step 4 Blocks and the 6-1/2" Fabric A squares into nine rows of seven blocks. Note the fabric placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 7: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
Step 8: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
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
