### Notes Before You Begin


- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!
- Print the templates on pages 6-10 out at 100%, tape templates 2 and 4 together along the red lines and trace all of them to template plastic. Cut out along the seam allowance line.


# **Cutting Instructions**

- Trace and cut the templates out from each fabric as instructed below. For half of the fabrics you will reverse Templates 2 and 3, so be sure to follow the diagram.

#### Fabrics B, D, F, H, I, K, L, M, P, Q


- Cut templates as shown below.
- Cut 2" x 18" strips from fabrics D, F, I, K, L, M and P, then cut into two rectangles 2" x 9".






#### Fabrics A, C, E, G, J, N, O, R, S, T

- Cut templates as shown below.
- Cut 2" x 18" strips from fabrics A, C, E, G, N, O, R, S, T then cut into two rectangles 2" x 9".





#### Fabric U

(Label each strip with the length for easier assembly later)


- Cut three strips 6-1/2" x WOF, then:
  - From one strip cut a strip 6-1/2" x 10" and a strip 6-1/2" x 31".
  - From one strip cut a strip 6-1/2" x 7", 6-1/2" x 9", and 6-1/2" x 24".
  - From one strip cut a strip 6-1/2" x 15".
- At the end of each strip, cut a 60° angle as pictured.




- Cut three strips 6-1/2" x WOF, then:
  - From one strip cut a strip 6-1/2" x 17" and a strip 6-1/2" x 27".
  - From one strip cut a strip 6-1/2" x 10" and a strip 6-1/2" x 27".
  - From one strip cut a strip 6-1/2" x 22" and TWO strips 6-1/2" x 9".
- At the end of each strip, cut a 60° angle as pictured.



- Cut one strip 6-1/2" x WOF, then cut into two strips 6-1/2" x 22".
  - Cut 60° angles at each end of the strips as indicated below.






## Assembly Instructions

- Following the chart below, sew a 2" x 9" strip to each side of a Template 1 triangle. Trim the strips to be even with the bottom of the triangle and to extend 1/4" above the top point of the triangle.

- Assemble the pieces into rows following the diagram below, then sew the rows together, making sure to match the same seams that are matched on the diagram.
- Once the quilt top is together, trim the sides to be even with the narrowest row.

The letter corresponds to the fabric and the number corresponds to the template. You will have a few extra pieces, so feel free to play around with the layout and make it your own!
