

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

thirty-three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

- thirty 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" sashing strips
- three 2-1/2" x 74-1/2" vertical sashing strips
- two 2-1/2" x 70-1/2" top/bottom borders

From each of Fabrics B and C, cut:

one 14-1/2" x 32-1/2" rectangle

From fifteen of the Roll Up prints, cut:

two 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips. See Quilt Assembly Diagram for specific prints used.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Quilt

Step 1: Gather:

the Fabric B rectangle
one strip of each of the fifteen prints
fifteen Fabric A strips

Sew together to form the left column.
Press toward the A strips.

Step 2: Gather:


the Fabric C rectangle
one strip of each of the fifteen prints
fifteen Fabric A strips

Sew together to form the right column.
Press toward the A strips.

Step 3: Sew the two columns together, sewing a 74-1/2" Fabric A strip between the columns and to the left and right edges. Press.

Step 4: Sew the 70-1/2" Fabric A strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!



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
